BAYANIHAN SA CAVITE: Compañero Alan boosts morale of Gen. Trias BHW

Amid the uncertainties and unprecedented challenges in the health sector, former Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano commended the medical frontliners in becoming the “silver lining,” the most reliable force that many Filipinos have depended on for almost a year. With their continuing service to our kababayans, former Speaker believes that they deserve the best, not only now in the time of the pandemic, but all year round. He assures them

During the arrival ceremony, Transportation Secretary Arthur Tugade said the project began 19 years ago but had “zero percent” of its right-of-way (ROW) certified as “free and clear” by an independent consultant in 2016 despite the ROW acquisition receiving its budget from Congress in 2007.

“Under the Duterte administration, we pushed and pushed hard. That is why today, we see the steps of the whole realization of this project – partial operability within this year, by

accepting the trains and the cars,” Tugade said.

The project is a partnership among the DOTr, the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), the Light Rail Transit Authority, the Light Rail Manila Corp., Mitsubishi Corp., Spanish rolling stock manufacturer Construcciones y Auxiliar de Ferrocarriles (CAF), and CMX Consortium.

In the same event, Japanese Ambassador Kazuhiko Koshikawa pledged to work closely with the Philippine government, citing the December 14 commitment made by Japanese Prime Minister Suga to support President Rodri-

DSWD intensifies program for Safer Internet Day for Children

"Bagong Normal: Ligtas na Internet for All", is this year's theme for the online observance of 'Safer Internet Day for Children Philippines,' which will be held on the second week of February.

The event will highlight promoting understanding among the general public of the current anti-child pornography and child online protection efforts and initiatives being done by the government.

Likewise, the Inter-agency Council Against Child Pornography (IACACP) together with the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), lined up activities for the celebration, which include the presentation



of the newly signed Child Online Safe Guarding Policy under RA 10929 or the Free Internet Access in Public Spaces Act.

This activity will be led by Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) in coordination with the IACACP. Representatives from different stakeholders will be invited, such as parents group, ISP group, social media platforms such Facebook, Google, and

Tiktok for a panel discussion to substantiate information relevant to the protection of children from online sexual abuse and exploitation

On February 5, 2018, President Rodrigo Duterte signed Proclamation No. 417 declaring the second Tuesday of February every year as 'Safer Internet Day for Children Philippines,' aimed to strengthen the campaign to eradicate child pornography in the Philippines. The proclamation is provided in the 1987 Constitution which says the government shall "promote and protect" the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being of the youth.(ARR/PIACentral-IDPD)

The Seminar on Organic Agriculture for the Youth was participated by 30 youth from various barangays in Nagcarlan. Municipal Mayor Lourdes Arcasetas, Municipal Agriculturist Angelina Salamat and ATI CALABARZON Center Director Marites Piamonte - Cosico graced the activity. On her closing message, Center Director Cosico challenged the youth to have the passion in agriculture. After the training, the participants received starter kits composed of vermicast, carbonized rice

hull, haras, molasses, bokashi, water sprinkler and vegetable seeds. "Dito (sa seminar na ito) ko nayakap yung food sustainability at organic farming. Participants were provided with lectures, showcase of organically grown vegetables in the locality and starter kits including assorted vegetable seeds, seedling tray, molasses, vermicast, carbonized rice hull, haras and water sprinkler. DENR chief sets closure of all open dumpsites this year

Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Secretary Roy Cimatu has ordered all the agency's Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) regional directors to step up efforts against open dumpsites in their respective areas of jurisdiction, noting that Republic Act 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) prohibits these facilities.

"This is my directive to them: All open dumpsites must be closed by the end of March this year!" he announced Tuesday in a message for the RA 9003's 20th anniversary celebration.

He said a review of RA 9003's implementing rules and regulations are already underway "to make way for better and bigger sanitary landfills". RA 9003 said sanitary landfill is a waste disposal site that's "designed, constructed, operated and maintained in a manner that exerts engineering control over significant potential environmental impacts arising from the development and operation of the facility."

"Open dump shall refer to a disposal area wherein the solid wastes are indiscriminately thrown or disposed of without due planning and consideration for environmental and health standards," RA 9003 noted.

Upon assuming DENR's top post, Cimatu prioritized solid waste management as he observed RA 9003 was neither promptly nor fully implemented despite the country's increasing waste generation.

"We have so much catching up to do," he said. No-nonsense implementation of RA 9003 already resulted in increased closure of open dumps, establishment of more materials recovery facilities and sanitary landfills as well as further development of LGUs' respective 10-year solid waste management plans, he noted.

"I'm honored to report that we have gained significant ground," he said. The campaign against open dumps has particularly been relentless, Cimatu continued. "As of yesterday (Jan. 25) at 7 p.m., report that reached our office indicated that we have thus far closed a total of 38 open dumpsites in the regions," he said. Majority of regions were able to each close around two dumpsites, he noted.

"The report also states that Region IV-B was able to close 17 dumpsites while Region VI was able to close five," he said further. Cimatu acknowledged much of such accomplishment was inspired by DENR Undersecretary Benny Antiporda's efforts to close open dumps in Bataan, Pampanga and Cavite provinces.

"His aggressive yet decisive move is being followed by our EMB regional directors nationwide," he said. Antiporda assured DENR will "excelerate" or excel and accelerate efforts to implement RA 9003. "In the next two years, we commit to work even harder," he said in his message for RA 9003's 20th anniversary celebration. Aside from closing open dumps, he said DENR will help further promote the development of sanitary landfills nationwide, practice of waste segregation at home and improvement of garbage collection. There'll be house-to-house campaigns as well to promote solid waste management among communities, he noted. "Yes, we can do it!" he added. "And we must do it! Let us all manage our garbage towards a cleaner, healthier and progressive Philippines." (PNA)

DOH targets 1.5M children in CALABARZON for measles & polio vaccination

CALABARZON--The Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) is targeting to vaccinate about 1,524,327 children in the region on the upcoming nationwide "Measles-Rubella and Oral Polio Vaccine Supplemental Immunization Activity (MR OPV SIA) Phase 2 Campaign from February 1-28, 2021.

The regional office will be targeting 290,588 children in the province of Batangas, 380,067 in Cavite province, 306,619 in Laguna, 236,913 in Quezon and 310,140 in Rizal.

"The regional office, our LGU partners and the vaccination teams are ready to do their tasks and reach the target children including those in far-flung communities located in the mountains," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"Mas madali natin ngayong mababakunahan ang mga bata dahil karamihan sa kanila ay nasa kani-kanilang mga bahay at bawal silang lumabas dala ng kasalukuyang pandemya. Kaya't madali nating magagawa ang pagbabakuna laban sa polio at measles."

Janairo added that additional manpower will be deployed in every municipalities to ensure that all target children from 0-59 months old will receive their vaccine shots.
