MANILA – Speaker Martin Romualdez said the socialized housing projects under the Marcos administration's flagship Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program have improved significantly, with high-quality amenities made affordable to Filipinos.

During the site inspection of the 4PH San Mateo, Rizal Housing Project, Romualdez said the housing site not only provides decent and affordable shelter for underprivileged Filipino families, but also improved living conditions through amenities commonly found in upper-income subdivisions or condominiums, such as a swimming pool, clubhouse, and basketball court.

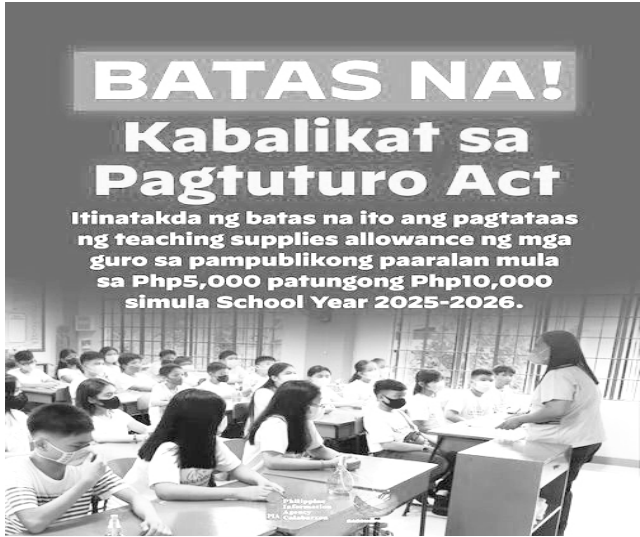

ORDER

On May 8, 2024, petitioner through counsel filed this instant petition alleging among others that (a) it was petitioner's late grandmother JUANA who cause the registration of her original birth certificate in San Juan, Eastern Samar where they were originally residing; (b) said birth certificate was inexistent leading petitioner to ask her other relatives of the fact of the registration of her birth since she has no record; (c) her inquiries with the NSO yielded negative results; (d) knowing the importance of the said documents and feeling depressed because she has no birth certificate, petitioner sought the delayed registration of her birth in Bacoor where they transferred residence in the year 1983; (e) in registering her birth, petitioner does not know her exact birth year so she used the year 1983, and other details were also provided by the petitioner from what she was told by her relatives; (f) recently, when she secured a copy of her birth certificate, the document she was given was her original birth certificate registered by her grandmother, which was also secured through late registration; (g) prior to this discovery, petitioner has been using the Certificate of Live Birth she secured; (h) petitioner now has two (2) birth certificates and several entries in the two documents were conflicting. Petitioner sought the cancellation of her second birth under Local Civil Registry Number 2020-5760 since she cannot anymore secure a copy of the same and to retain the one originally registered by her grandmother.

Finding the petition to be sufficient in form and substance, the same is set for initial hearing on **SEPTEMBER 20, 2024** at 10:30 in the morning at 2nd Floor, New Hall of Justice, Evangelista St. Brgy. Poblacion, Bacoor City, Cavite at which date, place and hour, any interested person may appear and show cause why said petition should not be granted.

Petitioner is directed to cause the publication of the copy of this Order at his expense once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Cities and Province of Cavite at least thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled date of hearing. Petitioner is likewise directed to furnish with copies of the petition and its annexes the Office of the Solicitor General, the Office of the City Prosecutor of Bacoor, the Local Civil Registrar of Bacoor City and the Philippine Statistics Office and to submit proof of compliance thereof.

The Sheriff of this court is ordered to post copies of this Notice in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Bacoor, particularly in the Barangay Hall where the petitioner resides, in the main entrance of the City Hall Building, and the Hall of Justice of Bacoor City.

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, City of Imus, Cavite — The Cavite Police Provincial Office (PPO) arrested a total of 8 Wanted persons during its daily manhunt operation on June 4, 2024. The arrests include: Regional level Most Wanted Person arrested by warrant personnel of Cavite CCPS and identified as alias “Rodolfo” 73 yes old, want-

ed for the crime of Rape and Attempted Rape with no bail recommended. City level- MWP arrested by personnel of Tagaytay CCPS at Brgy Kaybagal and identified as alias “Rampie” 43 yearss old, wanted for the violation of Sec 16 Article III of RA 6425.

This significant arrest was complemented by the capture of six other wanted persons across

the province. PCOL ELEUTERIO RICARDO JR., the Provincial Director, emphasized the Cavite PPO's relentless efforts against wanted individuals.

Local gov't improves health services in Batangas Provincial Jail

BATANGAS CITY – The Provincial Health Office (PHO) here has begun conducting monthly medical missions inside the Batangas Provincial Jail (BPJ) to prevent the transmission of infectious diseases among persons deprived of liberty (PDLs).

In an interview on Tuesday, Dr. Rosalie Masangkay, assistant department head at the PHO, said almost 1,000 PDLs benefited from their medical mission during the last week of May.

Masangkay said the recent scorching temperatures also contributed to the urgency of improving health services within the province's main detention center.

"We are monitoring those with maintenance

medication to see if their condition improves or worsens. We are treating several skin infections because of the extreme heat recently but there is no skin disease that is contagious," she said.

Masangkay assured that her team will conduct regular medical and dental checkups, medicine distribution, and laboratory tests to prevent any infectious disease transmission in the jail facility.

She said the provincial government wants to reassure the family of the PDLs that the provincial government is taking good care of them while inside the facility.

"We are thankful that Batangas Governor Hermilando Mandanas and Provincial Jail Warden Atty. Genaro Cabral for their sup-

port to our recommendation to build an infirmary to effectively treat our sick PDLs. The moment an inmate comes in... we give them a check up," Masangkay said. She said the improved health services also include giving "special diets" to all sick PDLs to boost their recovery and ensure their nutrition.

Masangkay shared that essential medicines and vitamins are also provided for free by the provincial government to cure seasonal diseases like fever, cough, and colds, among others.

Additionally, a dental mission is conducted every quarter and a free laboratory test such as chest x-ray, electrocardiogram, blood

chemistry, and urinalysis is organized twice a year, she said.

Meanwhile, Joseli to Eguia, administrative officer of Batangas Provincial Jail, said this support from the PHO is very crucial to preventing infectious diseases since the facility is overcrowded.

"Right now, the number of our PDL is 944 with 864 male and 80 female. Our population is crowded because based on previous reports, its capacity is only 450," he said.

Eguia revealed that a new detention facility is already being built in Barangay Malainin, Ibaan, Batangas to help decongest the BPJ. source:PNA)

SEN. REVILLA’S ‘KABALIKAT SA PAGTUTURO ACT’ SIGNED INTO LAW TODAY BY PBBM

President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos, Jr. (PBBM) has signed yesterday June 03 2024 the 'Kabalikat sa in Pagtuturo Act' principally authored and sponsored by Senator Ramon 'Bong' Revilla, Jr.

This legislative measure aims to honor the hard work and dedication of public school teachers by institutionalizing and increasing their annual teaching allowance.

"I'm truly overwhelmed when I learned that my Kabalikat sa Pagtuturo Act has been approved by President Ferdinand 'Bongbong' Marcos, Jr. And I'm grateful, Sir, for your approval of my bill," the lawmaker expressed.

"On top of this, the President has earlier signed my proposed amendment to the Centenarian Law and disapproval of the 'No permit, no exam' policy," he added.

"This new law is the fulfillment of our teachers' request for additional allowance for expenses for a more effective teaching," Revilla explained.

"This is truly a monumental day for our dear teachers. They will already reap the sweet fruits of our labor since we started championing this 5 years ago," the solon added.

Provided in this statute, teaching allowance of public school teachers will be increased from P5,000 to P10,000 starting School Year 2025-2026.

"At present. teachers are receiving a teaching allowance called 'chalk allowance' of P5,000 annually. But due to skyrocketing prices, this chalk allowance is no longer enough. Oftentimes, the teacher spends his/her own money to buy these teaching materials. More than chalk and other classroom supplies for blended modality in teaching, the teachers now need internet connection, electricity, laptop, and others for a more effective teaching," the senator explained.

According to historical data, public school teachers have been receiving a meager allowance for the actual conduct of teaching.

uted among 55 locations.

Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DH-SUD) Secretary Jerry Acuzar said this is in addition to the thousands of housing units under construction in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao, including 20 ongoing projects in "various stages of construction and development".

Romualdez said the national government remains on track with its original target of building 1 million housing units every year until President Marcos' six-year term ends in 2028, so as to fill the 6.5 million housing backlogs.

Congress will ensure that funds will be available to DHSUD's projects, even if govern-

ment financing institutions like Pag-IBIG had pledged PHP250 billion for the BBM socialized housing programs, he said.

Interest subsidy funding Romualdez also vowed that in future national budgets, the House would include funding for the interest subsidy for beneficiaries of the 4PH program to reduce the prices of housing units and monthly amortization costs.

"I assure you on the part of the House of Representatives, As Speaker of the House, I will guarantee that this interest subsidy will be appropriated in the succeeding national budgets of the republic," he said.

The DHSUD said

housing units to be sold under the 4PH program will be more economically priced than other residential units in the market in keeping with the price ceiling imposed by the government for affordable housing.

Housing loan borrowers who will avail of units under the 4PH program through a Pag-IBIG Housing Loan will enjoy an even lower interest rate than what Pag-IBIG Fund currently provides, which is already considered the lowest in the market, according to DHSUD.

DHSUD will subsidize up to 5 percent of the loan's outstanding interest rate, allowing borrowers to pay a reduced interest rate on their loans. source:(PNA)



In 1988, they only received P100 allowance, P200 in 1989-1992, P300 in 1993-2007, P500 in 2008, P700 in 2009-2011, P1,000 in 2012-2014, P1,500 in 2015-2016, P2,500 in 2017, P3,500 in 2018-2020, and P5,000 in 2021 to present.


