A man allegedly drug pusher and motorcycle thief has been killed after allegedly confronted with police in a buy-bust operation. In Rosario, Cavite.

PROVINCIAL UPDATE TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

This morning Jan 13, the Mayor's League will meet to discuss how to ease the lives of daily commuters in the province:

1. Ang fare matrix sa PUB/PUJ ay nasa jurisdiction ng LTFRB. It is to the best

of my knowledge that the current fare matrix was a response to the previous limited number of passengers allowed during the ECQ/GCQ.

Now MGCQ operators are almost at full capacity every day (we also receive a lot of reports that they are beyond capacity and PUB / PUJ are crowded during rush hour, which is against the social distancing rules of the IATF).

Tomorrow I will be doing a letter to the authorities to sort out this current fare matrix. It is the RIGHT of the commuter and the DUTY of the LTFRB to review the current pricing system in place.

I repeat, PUB / PUJ is under LTFRB. We will do our sworn duty to appeal and represent the people of the province. Expect us not to stop contacting them so we can fix civil rights.

2. Very important discussion also about the cost of tricycle fare.

A. Today's fare is at P25 for the first 1.2 km. Before the pandemic, fare was only at P10- 12 but up to 3 According to IATF, it's okay to be 2 per ride so it's worth lowering the cost to the same. I think P13-15 per passenger is enough.

B. I know the most difficult thing for people is the night commute. What the operator is doing is having a " negotiated " price that sometimes reaches P100. This is wrong and unjust.

C. The Mayor's control included obliging a certain percentage of operators with overnight travel. The " negotiated " system is not allowed to be implemented and it should be " fixed " price according to the consultative meeting between the Mayors and the Operators. Cont.on PAGE 3

## MORE RANDOM DRUG TESTS FOR PNPA CADETS, PERSONNEL AND EMPLOYEES-SINAS

Philippine National Police (PNP) Chief, Gen. Debold Sinas, said he wants more random drug tests to be conducted among cadets, personnel, and employees of the PNP Academy (PNPA) in Silang, Cavite in line with ongoing efforts to stamp out illegal drug users in the force.

In a chance inter-
