PUSHING THIEF, DEAD IN BUY-BUST

A man allegedly drug pusher and motorcycle thief has been killed after allegedly confronted with police in a buy-bust operation. In Rosario, Cavite.

Recognized murdered Arcie Surin alias RC married, male, relative, jobless, and resident of Brgy Wawa 2, Rosario, Cavite.

According to the PNP's Anti-Illegal Drug Campaign, on 11 January 2021, around 7:00 pm in Barga Sapa III, Rosario Cavite, the

TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

This morning Jan 13, the Mayor's League will meet to discuss how to ease the lives of daily commuters in the province:

1. Ang fare matrix sa PUB/PUJ ay nasa jurisdiction ng LTFRB. It is to the best

of my knowledge that the current fare matrix was a response to the previous limited number of passengers allowed during the ECQ/GCQ.

Now MGCQ operators are almost at full capacity every day (we also receive a lot of reports that they are beyond capacity and PUB / PUJ are crowded during rush hour, which is against the social distancing rules of the IATF).

Tomorrow I will be doing a letter to the authorities to sort out this current fare matrix. It is the RIGHT of the commuter and the DUTY of the LTFRB to review the current pricing system in place.

I repeat, PUB / PUJ is under LTFRB. We will do our sworn duty to appeal and represent the people of the province. Expect us not to stop contacting them so we can fix civil rights.

2. Very important discussion also about the cost of tricycle fare.

A. Today's fare is at P25 for the first 1.2 km. Before the pandemic, fare was only at P10- 12 but up to 3 According to IATF, it's okay to be 2 per ride so it's worth lowering the cost to the same. I think P13- 15 per passenger is enough.

B. I know the most difficult thing for people is the night commute. What the operator is doing is having a " negotiated " price that sometimes reaches P100. This is wrong and unjust.

C. The Mayor's control included obliging a certain percentage of operators with overnight travel. The " negotiated " system is not allowed to be implemented and it should be " fixed " price according to the consultative meeting between the Mayors and the Operators.

DEPED STRENGTHENS EFFORTS IN PEACE-BUILDING THROUGH EDUCATION

As classes resume for School Year 2020-2021, the Department of Education (DepEd) continues building a culture of peace and resilience in conflict-affected and vulnerable communities to ensure learning continuity and to protect the learners and personnel's rights, welfare, and neutrality during armed conflict situations.

Spearheaded by DepEd – Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) in partnership with UNICEF Philip-

ines, the Documentation of Good Practices on Schools and Communities in Armed Conflict Situations was developed to showcase selected case studies of notable peace-building practices and initiatives on establishing and maintaining learners and schools as zones of peace. "We are firm with our commitment to protect the rights and welfare of our learners through the issuance of the national policy framework on learners and schools as zones of peace.

This policy ensures the creation of safe, inclusive, and conflict-sensitive learning environments," Secretary Leonor Magtolis shared.

"Our children and our schools are not objects of attack nor zones of battle; but rather, they are instrumental in building and sustaining a culture of peace in our country," Undersecretary for Administration Alain Del Pascua added.

The practices are reflective of the three building blocks of DepEd Order

No. 32, s. 2019 or the National Policy Framework on Learners and Schools as Zones of Peace or LSZOP, namely (1) Education for Peace, (2) Peace for Education, and (3) Crisis Management through Education in Emergencies (EiE).

DRRMS Director Ronilda Co said that the crafting of the framework was heavily informed by actual experiences of how the schools and communities adapted and even flourished in the face of the realities

and hardships of armed conflict. Furthermore, the research presented measures to strengthen learning from the cases such as (1) supporting upstream work on the development of an evidence-based national policy framework and guidelines to protect schools and learners in conflict-affected areas, and (2) informing the downstream work on the integration of DRRM practices and peace-building in the professional development of school heads, teachers and

education practitioners in specific school divisions and districts affected by armed conflict.

"We hope that this study contributes to making our schools safer, more secure, and child friendly. Educators, community members, parents, and students can work together towards a better world where all people live safely and free from fear," UNICEF Philippines Representative Oyun-saikhan Dendevnorov ended.

amit ba o hindi (We will pick up from among them, such as those who went on vacation, those who went home, or those who went on emergency leave. We will test them to determine whether they used illegal drugs during those periods)," he said.

Sinas noted that the random drug testing order covers police officers, police non-commissioned officers, cadets, non-uniformed personnel, and job order employees.

Earlier, a job order employee of the PNPA was identified as the source of illegal drugs of the graduating cadet who earlier tested positive for drug use.

The suspect was identified as Diosdado Reyes, 25, a stay-in mess hall worker, as the source of illegal drugs used by Cadet 1st Class John David Macagba, who tested positive during a random drug test.

Citing reports from PNPA acting director, Brig. Gen. Rhoderick Armamento, Sinas said Macagba admitted that he bought PHP3,000 worth of shabu from Reyes.
