

DILG monitoring five poll hotspots in Cavite province

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — At least five towns and cities in the province of Cavite identified as election hotspots are being monitored by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and security forces of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to suppress any election-related violence that may disrupt the peaceful conduct of the May 9 polls.

In a report of the Cavite News Today,

DILG Cavite Provincial Director Lionel Dalope revealed that the cities of Trece Martires and Cavite and the municipalities of Kawit, Rosario, and Amadeo are considered election hotspots in the province.

Dalope clarified that these localities fall under the yellow category, which is a much lighter classification. These areas have at least one election-related incident of intense political rivalry, presence of armed

groups, or imminent insurgency threat, according to Dalope.

"Iba-iba ang dahilan upang ma-classify na 'hotspot', kabilang na dito ay ang mga nagdaang karanasan o mga pangyayari sa mga lugar nila na maituturing na nagsasapanganib o kailangan bantayan para maiwasan ang anumang kaguluhan sa panahon ng eleksyon," Dalope explained.

Despite being tagged under the low-

est category of election hotspots, these areas are being strictly monitored by the security forces of the PNP to ensure the safety of both the pub-

lic and the candidates throughout the election period.

Asked about the alleged vote-buying in Silang town, Dalope said

that the incident is being confirmed by concerned authorities to make a formal investigation on the matter.

According to the provincial DILG chief, remaining 'apolitical' does not only apply to the PNP personnel but to all those who work for the civil service.

He reiterated that one of the duties and responsibilities of the PNP personnel is to maintain peace and order and to

PH introduces locally-made e-jeepney

MANILA – The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and the Electric Vehicle Association of the Philippines (EVAP) on Monday afternoon introduced the locally-made 23-seater electric jeepney (e-jeepney) via a demo run in Alabang, Muntinlupa."

This (e-jeepney) was made by the engineers of EVAP, while the research and development, prototyping was funded by the DOST for PHP4.9 million," DOST-Philippine Council for Industry, Energy, Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST PCIEERD) executive director Enrico Paringit told the Philippine News Agency.

He added that ToJo Motors has already committed to adopt the technology and manufacture the 23-seater jeepney. "(We also call on) other manufacturers (to be adopters)," Paringit said.

In his speech prior to the prototype's demo run, DOST Secretary Fortunato de la Peña, likewise, urged the industry to be involved.

"We urge our friends from the industry to work together in this journey towards energizing the transport sector for the successful adoption of e-vehicles. We call on our partners in government and in the private sector to come up with creative support mechanisms, like financing and leasing, so that manufacturing of the vehicle or its components could be more attractive for investors, and will eventually benefit the operators and drivers and the riding public," De la Peña said.

The DOST, he said, has been pushing for environment-friendly initiatives and alternatives.

"We believe that electrifying our country's transportation sector is one of the ways we can free us from the skyrocketing prices of fossil fuel and protect our environment at the same time," he said.

According to de la Peña, EVAP studied and developed battery charging and swapping systems using lithium-ion batteries, as well as a workable operations template that involves fleet operations and the collection of daily loan amortization.

The e-jeepney features low-carbon electric vehicle technology and production standards.

"Standardization of common parts and components are crucial to drive down costs, ensure safety and assure reliability," he said.

Paringit, meanwhile, acknowledged that the project would not be possible without the Filipino team assembling and supplying the e-vehicle parts and components.

Having the e-jeepney would help reduce the country's reliance on fossil fuels and improve the air quality in communities, Paringit added. (PNA)

Bong Go helps struggling households in Maragondon, Cavite; urges patients to prioritize health and avail services of Malasakit Centers

More pandemic-affected communities benefit from Senator Christopher “Bong” Go’s relief efforts as his team conducted a distribution activity for 1,000 indigents in Maragondon, Cavite last Wednesday, April 27.

In his video message, Go, who serves as Chair of the Senate Committee on Health and Demography, reminded the beneficiaries to look after their health and encouraged them to avail of the services of any of the two Malasakit Centers in the province if they need assistance with their hospital expenses.

Go initiated the Malasakit Centers program in 2018 after personally witnessing how poor and indigent Filipinos across the country are having a hard time getting the medical attention they need mostly due to the expensive hospital services.

The Malasakit Center is a one-stop that brings together all government agencies that offer medical assistance programs, such as the Department of Social Welfare and Development, Department of Health, Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, and Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office.

Para po ‘yan sa mga poor and indigent patients, para po ‘yan sa mga Pilipino, lapitan niyo lang po ang Malasakit Center,” said Go, who primarily authored and sponsored the Malasakit Centers Act of 2019.

The Malasakit Centers in the province of Cavite are located at Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoor City and General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital in Trece Martires City. To date, there are 151 Malasakit Centers nationwide.

The senator then reminded the public to continue being cooperative and supportive of the government’s vaccination efforts. He also emphasized the need to continue adhering to the necessary health preventive measures to hasten the country’s return to normalcy.

“Mga kababayan ko, nandidiyan na po ang bakuna. ‘Pag nasa priority list na po, magpabakuna na

ho kayo para po protektado po kayo. Kung mahal n’yo po ang inyong mga pamilya, magpabakuna na po kayo. Ang bakuna po ang tanging susi o solusyon para unti-unti na tayong makabalik sa ating normal na pamumuhay,” Go remarked.

The senator’s outreach team enforced the necessary health and safety protocols during the relief operation at the Garita B Barangay Hall where they handed out meals and masks to the residents. In addition, they gave away bicycles, phablets and new pairs of shoes to select individuals. Apart from the assistance provided by the senator, representatives from DSWD extended financial aid through its Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation program.

As an adopted son of CALABARZON and Vice Chair of the Senate Committee on Finance, Go supported the acquisition and installation of street lights and solar street lighting system in various barangays in Maragondon.

He also supported

various road improvements in the cities of Cavite, Dasmarinas, General Trias, Imus and Tagaytay; rehabilitation of covered courts in various barangays in General Trias City; acquisition of ambulance units for the local government of Indang and Trece Martires City; rehabilitation and improvement of the municipal fire station in Noveleta; and the improvement of a sports facility in Cavite State University in Indang.

Ending his message, Go expressed his gratitude towards the local officials of the town for ensuring their constituents’ welfare especially amid the global health crisis.

national government's services and assistance programs more accessible to the neighboring communities.

In addition, Duterte highlighted that the provincial hospital will decongest all the other healthcare facilities in the region especially amid the major public health crisis that the country may face in future.

"As we try to respond to various healthcare challenges, we remain resolute in maximizing our capacities and utilizing everything. We have to save as many lives as we can," he stated.

The 125-bed capacity hospital will have three isolation rooms, 14 private rooms, 16 semi-private rooms, 14 wards with four beds each, and six wards with six beds each.

Also, Duterte in turn recognized the efforts of the local government units in the province in providing

accessible healthcare services, and other basic needs to the people.

"You have helped us realize our goal for healthier and more productive Filipino citizens... Elected officials should develop a more responsive and discerning character so they can govern the country for a genuine social change," he added.

Duterte said he is confident that the structure of the facility will move according to the approved timeline to ensure that it will serve the constituency at the soonest possible time.

The Provincial Government of Pampanga allotted a total of P200 million, augmented by an approved P500 million loan from Landbank, and another P50 million from the national government through Department of Health for the construction of the about 2,979-square meter structure. (MJSC/JLDC-PIA 3)

Ping wants end to revenge politics

MANILA – Presidential candidate Senator Panfilo Lacson said his miting de avance before the May 9 national elections will focus and highlight on promoting voter awareness and going beyond the cycle of revenge.

In a statement on Monday, Lacson's camp said they are still putting on the finishing touches for the grand rally in the senator's home province of Cavite and a city in Metro Manila.
