233K domestic workers in Calabarzon to get pay hike

MANILA - More of 233,909 domestic workthan 200,000 domestic workers in Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon) will benefit from the wage increase recently approved by the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board (RTWPB), the Department of Labor Employment (DOLE) said Saturday.

ers in the region would benefit from the PHP1,000 salary increase that will take effect on Feb. 19, or 15 days after the publication of the DOLE order.

Wage Order No. RB-IVA-DW-04 was approved on Jan. 22 and published in the newspaper on Feb. 3.

Under the order, In a statement, the new monthly minimum the department said a total wage rates for domestic

workers under the livein arrangement will be PHP6,000 for cities and first-class municipalities and PHP5,000 for other municipalities.

Of the 233,909 domestic workers, 28 percent or 65,408 are "stayin." The last wage order for domestic workers in the region was issued on June 15, 2022, and became effective on July 15, 2022. source:(PNA)



DTI intensifies action against illegal vape sales to protect consumers

The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) has further intensified its monitoring and enforcement operations against violators of Republic Act No. 11900 or the "Vaporized Nicotine and Non-Nicotine Products Regulation Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

With its heightened enforcement operations, the DTI covers both physical and online stores, confiscating over 18,000 non-compliant vape products valued at approximately 5.5 million pesos.

Dedicated protecting consumers, particularly minors, from illegal vape sales, the DTI has so far issued notices of violations (NOVs) and show cause orders The DTI also flagged vio-

lators who used cartoons (SCOs) to 269 physical stores, mandating anime, manga, animated characters, youth influthem to submit a written explanation within 48 encers, and personalities. More than 200 formal hours from their receipt of SCOs and NOVs. Meanwhile, the Department's online monitoring unit has inspected over 66,000 online vape stores as of January 2024. Out of the monitored firms, close to 61,000 were issued

Dengue cases decrease by 24% DOH says...

TRECE MAR-TIRES CITY - Dengue cases nationwide decreased early this month, according to the Dapartment of Health. The DOH said it recorded 2,024 dengue cases from Jan. 1 to 13, which was 24,40 percent lower compared to 7,274 from Dec.17 to 31 and 8,629 from Dec. 3 to 16. Fourteen deaths or a case fatality rate of .25 percent were reported during the same period. however, the Provincial Health Office (PHO) of Cavite still reminds Cavitenos to take the necessary precautions to avoid the decease.
