

BACCOOR CITY EXPLORES UNIFIED CARD SYSTEM INSPIRED BY MAKATIZEN CARD

Bacoor City, January 27, 2025 - Mayor Strike B. Revilla met with representatives from the Makati Management Information System (Makatizen Card) today at the Office of the Mayor to discuss the possibility of creating a unified Bacoor card system, inspired by the successful Makatizen Card program.

The meeting, orga-

nized by the City Administrator Office headed by Atty. Aimee T. Neri, focused on exploring the potential of implementing a similar system in Bacoor, aiming to streamline access to city services and support for Bacooreños. Led by Ms. Mara Janella Sagutin, the Makatizen Card team shared insights into the program's design, implemen-

tation, and benefits.

Mayor Strike B. Revilla expressed his vision for a unified Bacoor card, despite the city's limited budget compared to Makati, to create a system that mirrors the Makatizen Card's efficiency and accessibility. The Mayor believes that such a system would significantly improve the delivery of services and

support, making it easier for Bacooreños to access city programs and assistance.

The meeting served as a crucial step in exploring the feasibility of implementing a unified Bacoor card system. The City Government is committed to exploring innovative solutions to enhance service delivery and improve the lives of its constituents.

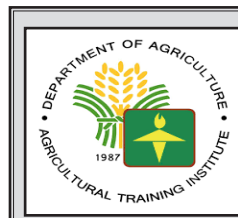

DSWD expands aid for maternal health

QUEZON CITY, (PIA) — The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) has announced a significant expansion of cash aid aimed at supporting pregnant women and mothers with children aged 0 to 2 years, a move that has garnered strong praise from a Navotas City solon.

Representative Toby Tiangco emphasized the critical importance of maternal and child health during the first 1,000 days of life, stating, “I welcome the administration’s efforts to expand the benefits under the 4Ps program, especially since this directly supports mothers.”

The DSWD’s new initiative, part of the F1KD program, will provide a monthly health grant of P350 to female beneficiaries of the 4Ps program who are preg-

nant or have young children.

This initiative is expected to benefit approximately 80,000 mothers.

“Receiving this monthly assistance is a significant help in ensuring that mothers remain healthy throughout their pregnancies and after childbirth,” Tiangco noted, highlighting that the aid is crucial for safeguarding the well-being of both mothers and their newborns.

Moreover, Tiangco pointed out that the DSWD’s efforts align with the administration’s commitment to combat stunting and malnutrition, which are pressing public health issues.

“It is vital that poverty does not become a barrier to protecting our mothers and their infants,” he said, re-

PhilHealth: Peritoneal dialysis benefit rate reaches almost P1.2M

MANILA – The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) has expanded the Z Benefit package for Peritoneal Dialysis (PD) with a rate reaching almost PHP1.2 million.

In an advisory Tuesday, the state insurer said the extended package covers different modalities of renal replacement therapy based on age.

“Nais naming hikayatin ang paggamit ng peritoneal dialysis para sa pasyente na may (We want to encourage the availment of peritoneal dialysis for patients with) Chronic Kidney Disease Stage 5,” PhilHealth president and chief executive officer Emmanuel Ledesma Jr. said.

“Ang PD ay isang mabisang opsyon bukod sa hemodialysis, hindi lamang upang bigyan ng awtonomiya at kakayahang pumili ang aming miyembro sa modality ng paggamot, kundi upang tiyakin ang kalidad ng buhay at malayang paggalaw ng mga pasyente (It is an effective

option aside from hemodialysis, not just to provide autonomy and flexibility for members in choosing the treatment modality but also to promote the quality of life and mobility of the patients),” he added.

PD is a kind of dialysis where the patient’s peritoneal membrane or lining of abdominal organs and body surfaces inside the abdominal cavity is used as an artificial kidney, according to the National Kidney and Transplant Institute.

For adults, the PhilHealth covers continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis (CAPD).

These benefits have been set at PHP389,640 and PHP510,140 depending on the PD solutions a patient requires per day. These packages increased by up to 89 percent from the previous PHP270,000 per year.

For pediatric patients, CAPD and automated peritoneal dialysis are now offered. These are set at PHP510,000 and PHP765,210,

while coverage for APD ranges from PHP763,000 to PHP1.2 million.

PhilHealth Circular No. 2024-0036 states that patients with chronic kidney disease stage 5 using this kind of RRT must register first in the PhilHealth Dialysis Database and comply with the guidelines on being a member.

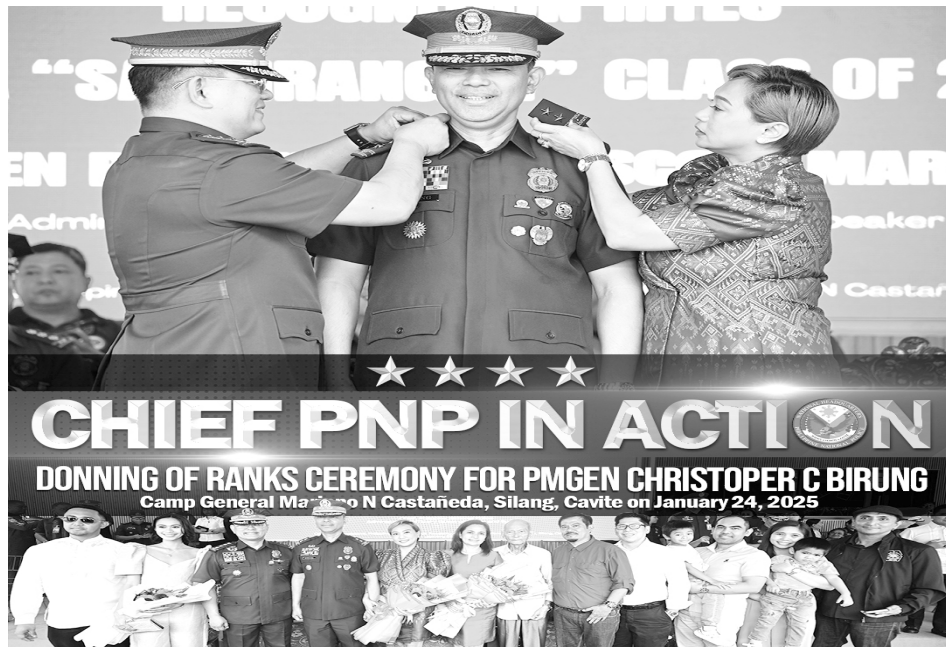
Patients must also observe the treatment plan, including the follow-up visits.

Selling or sharing of PD solutions given to patients is strictly prohibited.

Contracted providers or health facilities are prohibited from charging extra fees for essential health services.

However, they can charge for services and amenities not included in the list of health services covered by the package.

Concerned patients may avail of this package from any of the 51 accredited PD providers nationwide. (PNA)

between the media and justice in fostering transparency, accountability, and informed communities.

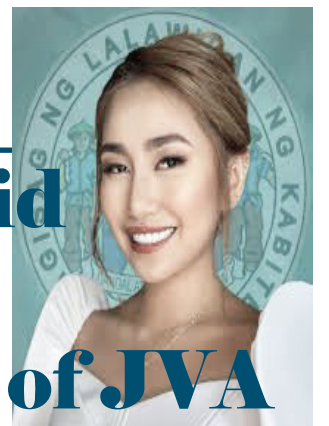
