## In CALABARZON... Medical hub in Laguna city to give free dialysis to kidney patients

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna – Kidney patients in this city will soon have access to free dialysis, diagnostic, and laboratory services when a new medical facility becomes operational in about six months.

Mayor Ross Rizal announced on Monday that the new hospital may be opened to patients as early as October, barring construction delays.

The new state-of-the-art facility is located along Bacnotan Road Barangay Real, adjacent to the Main City Hall Building, and will offer a range of essential services once

fully operational.

The ground floor will host the long-awaited dialysis center, while the second floor will accommodate the diagnostic and laboratory center.

"With an unwavering commitment to the well-being of our citizens, the city government has allocated a substantial PHP100 million for the construction of this landmark building," Rizal said.

The mayor also thanked in advance the Sanggunian Panlalawigan (City Council), which he said will allocate additional funds for equipment and fixtures, ensuring the

seamless operation of these essential centers.

He also welcomed contributions from national agencies and philanthropic institutions, underscoring the collaborative effort required to realize the city's healthcare vision.

Meanwhile, a representative from M.T. Maluanag Construction Services, the project contractor, emphasized the spaciousness of each floor, totaling 1,624 square meters, and highlighting the meticulous planning behind this transformative project. source: (PNA)

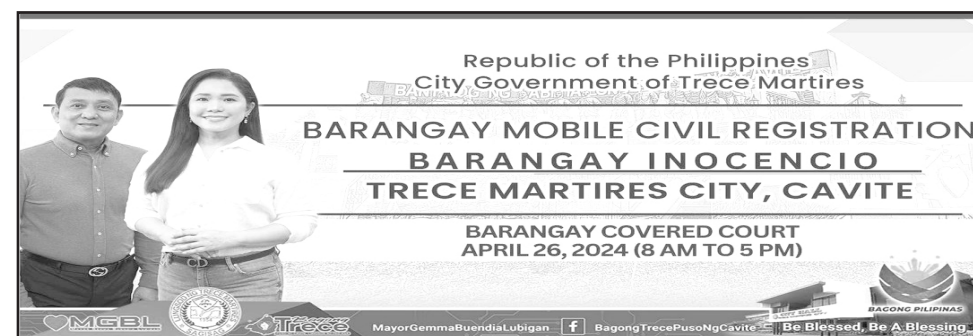

## Cayetano, nais mabigyan ng agarang tulong ang mga biktima ng kalamidad

Batid na maraming hamon ang kinaharap ng mga biktima upang makabangon mula sa likas o gawang-tao na mga kalamidad, isinusulong ni Senador Alan Peter Cayetano ang kanyang panukala na mabigyan ng agarang tulong ang mga pamilyang nawalan ng kanilang ari-arian at kabuhayan dahil sa kalamidad.

Ayon kay Cayetano, dapat makatanggap ng tulong pinansyal mula sa Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) ang mga indibidwal na apektado ng likas o gawang-tao na mga kalamidad tulad ng baha, bagyo, sunog, o lindol.

"This measure proposes to strengthen

the 4Ps [Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program] Law to aid our kababayan placed in unfortunate situations without their fault, such as in disasters," aniya sa kanyang Explanatory Note sa Senate Bill No. 302 o 4Ps for Disaster Victims Act.

Formal niyang inihain ang panukala noong July 18 ng nakaraang taon. Sa April 23 (Martes), pag-uusapan ng Committee on Social Justice, Welfare, and Rural Development ang panukala.

Kaugnay nito, kinakailangan na magbigay ang DSWD ng agarang tulong sa mga biktima ng sakuna na nawalan ng ari-arian o kabuhayan.

"Ang DSWD, bibi-

gayan ng immediate financial assistance ang mga pamilyang apektado ng bagyo, lindol, or whatever natural calamity. Then within 15 to 30 days ia-assess y'ung economic status ng pamilya," sabi ni Cayetano.

Sa ilalim ng panukala, agad na maipapatala sa programa ng 4Ps ang mga biktima at tatanggap ng buong benepisyo. Agad ding maging benepisyaryo at makatanggap ng kumpletong benepisyo sa loob ng isang taon ang mga indibidwal na naapektuhan din ang ari-arian ngunit hindi gaano naghirap.

Binigyang-diin din ni Cayetano na maaari pang mas magamit ng gobyerno ang mga umiiral na programa tulad ng 4Ps upang agarang makatanggap ng tulong ang mga biktima ng kalamidad. "Dapat pwede nating magamit yung 4Ps para matulungang makabangon ang mga pamilyang apektado ng mga kalamidad, we should be able to enroll families into the program in times of disasters," wika niya.###

# GSIS pensioners urged to use online services amid heatwave

MANILA – Amid a heatwave warning, the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) urged on Monday pensioners to use online services for their convenience and safety.

PAGASA recently issued a warning regarding unprecedented temperatures reaching up to 46 degrees Celsius in 24 areas across the country.

In a news release, GSIS pensioners were encouraged to complete their renewal of active status or the Annual Pensioners Information Revaluation (APIR) through the GSIS's digital platforms, including the GSIS Touch Mobile App

which now has facial recognition technology.

This app allows pensioners to fulfill requirements from the comfort of their homes.

“Our pensioners are among the most vulnerable during these extreme weather conditions. By enhancing access to our online services, we ensure they can fulfill their requirements without compromising their health," president and general manager Wick Veloso said.

Pensioners can also opt for an online interview scheduled through designated GSIS email addresses.

The state pension fund said recently it has also set aside nearly PHP2.5 billion for emergency loans that could help members and pensioners affected by El Niño in Occidental, as well as the pertussis outbreak in the province of Cavite. (PNA)

for pounding the streets. When it comes to assuring the people, analog will always beat digital," he said.

The fight against crime, he said, is now a potent mix of gadgets and war rooms, and old-fashioned work by gritty police officers.

And to those who will join the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), the President said he expects them to maximize IT to improve their service deliveries while minimizing cost.

BFP officers should not be content with the current fire response time, but instead strive to make it faster, he said, stressing those who will serve in BJMP should not crow about jail improvements. Instead, they should come up with ways to lessen prison congestion, he added.

As he congratulated members of the 2024 “Layag-Diwa” Class, he urged them to let PNPA's core values of Justice, Integrity, Service, “be the wind that propels you forward.”

The chief executive also encouraged the graduates to put the nation above themselves, noting such values and principles define true public servants.

# Gov't targets I-M digital jobs by 2028

**MANILA – The government is working to create 1 million digital jobs by 2028 which could bring in PHP24 billion to fund public services and infrastructure projects, according to President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.**

"We're on a mission to create 1 million digital jobs by 2028, potentially bringing in PHP24 billion to fund various public services and infrastructure projects," Marcos said in a Facebook post Saturday.

The President made the announcement following his meeting with the Private Sector Advisory Council (PSAC) in Malacañang to discuss updates and their recommendations concerning the Digital Infrastructure Work Plans.

"With PSAC, we're aligning training programs with market demands, preparing our workforce, and opening doors to digital innovation and economic growth in

the country," he added.

In a statement issued Sunday, PSAC said Marcos ordered a "strategic focus" on creating 1 million digital jobs by 2028 during their meeting.

The President also advocated for the empowerment of the Inter-Agency Council for Development and Competitiveness of the Philippine Digital Workforce, which will spearhead public-private partnerships essential for targeted skills development and training programs.

The inter-agency council is the primary planning, coordinating, and implementing body of Republic Act No. 11927, or the "Philippine Digital Workforce Competitiveness Act," which is enacted to enhance the skills and competitiveness of the Philippine workforce in the digital age.

Another significant development tackled during the meeting is the implementation of

the 10,000 Digital Civil Servants project, which will begin with the foundational training of some 40 participants in Singapore, who will lead a larger training cohort in the Philippines to significantly boost the capabilities of the government's digital services.

## Broader internet coverage

During the meeting, Marcos also directed the prioritization of Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas

(GIDA) in the expanding connectivity services to bridge the digital divide.

In line with this, Energy Secretary Raphael Lotilla introduced a security and rationalization program for protecting submarine cables and transmission lines, which is crucial for ensuring uninterrupted digital connectivity, especially in regions prone to land reclamation activities.

The PSAC also vowed to develop a detailed proposal for "na-
