

ALL PUBLIC HOSPITALS, HEALTH FACILITIES ON 'CODE WHITE' ALERT

The Department of Health (DOH) has placed all public hospitals and health facilities on "Code White" alert to ensure their readiness, together with their personnel, to respond to any potential health emergencies, notably heat-stroke, during the Lenten season.

The status of high readiness started on April 13 and will stay until Easter Sunday.

"Let me say that the Department of Health has declared Code White on all our hospitals. That means they are ready for all the incidents that can happen for people traveling for this Holy Week," Health Secretary Teodoro Herbosa said in a press briefing in Malacañang.

PhilHealth pays PGH P22.8-M benefit claims for heart attack patients

MANILA — The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) has paid the Philippine General Hospital (PGH) PHP22.8

million for the first batch of its claims for Ischemic Heart Disease - Acute Myocardial Infarction (IHD-AMI) benefit package.

In a news release on Monday, PhilHealth President and Chief Executive Officer Edwin Mercado said the payment is part of the

state insurer's commitment to bring life-saving health services closer to every Filipino through "prompt claims reimbursement."

PAL launches e-wallet

MANILA — Flag carrier Philippine Airlines (PAL) launched on Monday its own e-wallet, which would allow passengers to store multiple e-cards into a single account.

Electronic cards such as Miles, travel credits, compensation or vouchers, and e-gift cards may be consolidated in the PAL e-wallet.

"We are proud to launch and offer the PAL e-Wallet, the latest addition to our offerings that highlights our efforts to continuously upgrade the passengers' digital experience," PAL vice president for Sales and Distribution Justin Warby said in a statement.

Warby added the user-friendly feature benefits travelers who prefer

paperless transactions and real-time updates in one click.

The e-wallet is an alternative payment method for purchasing PAL tickets and ancillaries, excluding travel insurance and upgrades.

It also features auto-currency conversion upon adding e-cards, the built-in expiration logic for e-card utilization that ensures passengers get the full value of e-cards by prioritizing expiring ones, and the name check feature for adding travel credits.

Senator pushes 60kph speed limit after deadly Commonwealth crash

MANILA — Senate Majority Leader Francis "Tol" Tolentino on Monday urged authorities to strictly enforce the 60-kilometer-per-hour (kph) speed limit on major thoroughfares following a recent deadly crash along Commonwealth Ave. in Quezon City.

Tolentino introduced the 60 kph speed limit in 2011 while serving as chair of the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA). The rule has since been expanded to

this, we imposed the 60 kph speed limit during my term as MMDA chairman," Tolentino said in a news release.

A speeding passenger jeepney lost control and collided with two other vehicles, killing two passengers and injuring 16 others on Sunday along Commonwealth Ave.

bursements."

The benefit package covers up to PHP523,853 of the patient's treatment cost. It can be availed of from all accredited public and private health facilities, Levels 1 to 3, with the capacity to deliver the necessary services.

As of March, the IHD-AMI package has benefited at least 77 claims for heart attack patients at the PGH.

PGH Medical Director Dr. Gerardo Legaspi commended the

improvement of healthcare services for IHD-AMI.

Bishops to consecrate nation to Divine Mercy

The nation's Catholic bishops will consecrate the Philippines to the Divine Mercy on April 27 as part of the Church's observance of the Jubilee Year 2025.

Cardinal Pablo Virgilio David, president of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines, announced the initiative in an April 11 letter addressed to fellow bishops and the Catholic community.

He described the consecration as a "collective response of faith and hope" amid what he called grave challenges facing the country and the global community.

These, according to him, include the threat of global conflict, widespread corruption, the erosion of truth, and increasing opposition to Church teachings on life and family.

"This nationwide consecration will be a profound expression of our trust in the Divine Mercy—a trust that remains our final refuge in these times of uncertainty and trial," David said.

The consecration will take place during



all Masses across the country on Divine Mercy Sunday, which falls on the second Sunday of Easter. The Prayer of Consecration to the Divine Mercy will be recited in place of the General Intercessions.

The cardinal encouraged all dioceses, parishes, religious communities, and Catholic institutions to participate in the spiritual initiative.

"Together, let us entrust ourselves, our Church, and our nation to the boundless mercy of God, confident that in

His mercy we will find the healing, renewal, and hope we so deeply need," he added.

Divine Mercy Sunday was established by Pope John Paul II in 2000 during the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun and mystic whose visions inspired the devotion.

It has been celebrated annually on the second Sunday of Easter since 2001 and has become a significant day of prayer and devotion for Catholics worldwide.

cañang on Tuesday.

“Our warnings for na effects of heat illness especially for people going to hot areas like the beaches. So, very important, stay protected,” he said.

Based on DOH’s color codes, Code White Alert refers to the readiness of hospitals, particularly, general and orthopedic surgeons, anesthesiologists, internists, operating room nurses, ophthalmologists, and otorhinolaryngologists (eye, ear,

nose, throat specialists) to respond to emergencies at any time.

Herbosa strongly advised those going outdoors to use sunscreen, remain hydrated, and avoid long exposure to sun and heat.

Herbosa said individuals experiencing extremely high body temperature should cool down immediately. He said symptoms of heat-related illness include severe thirst and cold sweats.

“Kapag hindi

mo nakorek iyon, mag-ko-collapse ka. So, it’s important early on na mag-cool down ka. If you’re thirsty, you drink plenty of water,” Herbosa said, stressing those who lost consciousness should be immediately treated.

“If you feel weak, fatigue... next step after thirst is iyong heat fatigue or heat weakness, (pumunta) ka na sa shade or mag-aircon ka,” he said.

The elderly and children are prone to ex-

PRO Calabarzon Steps Up Holy Week Police Presence with OPLAN RONDA CALABARZON

The Police Regional Office CALABARZON, under the leadership of Regional Director PBGEN Paul Kenneth T Lucas, has intensified security operations across the region in observance of Holy Week.

The deployment of personnel under the enhanced public safety campaign, OPLAN RONDA CALABARZON—which stands for “PRO 4A’s Revitalized Patrol Operations and Neighborhood Watch to Deter Crimes and Public Safety Incidents through Aggressive Police Presence” is part of the broader Ligas SUMVAC 2025 program.

As of April 15, 2025, 6:00 AM, a total of

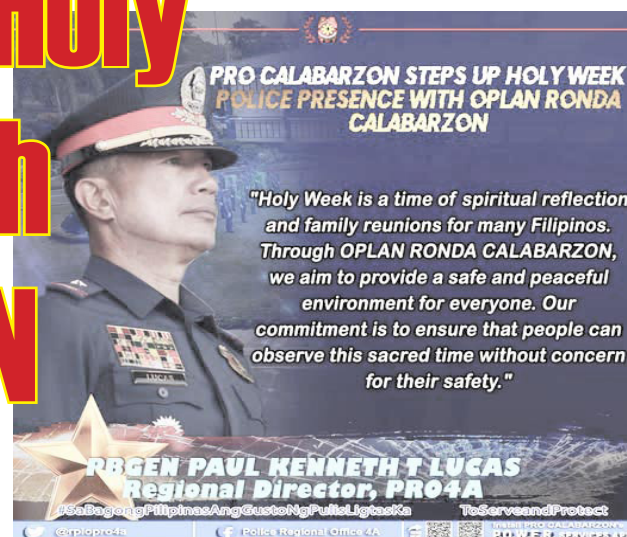
5,365 police personnel and 525 force multipliers from the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), other government agencies, and Barangay Peacekeeping Action Teams (BPATs), along with 2,145 members of advocacy groups, have been deployed to support the operation. This extensive coverage addresses the expected increase in public activ-

ity and travel during the Holy Week observance.

PBGEN Lucas said, “Holy Week is a time of spiritual reflection and family reunions for many Filipinos. Through OPLAN RONDA CALABARZON, we aim to provide a safe and peaceful environment for everyone. Our commitment is to ensure that people can observe this sacred time without concern for their safety.”

As part of OPLAN RONDA CALABARZON, Police Assistance Desks (PADs) will be established at places of worship, major

transportation terminals, seaports, tourist areas, and other public gathering locations. These desks will serve as immediate access points for the public to seek assistance or report emergencies. Additionally, law enforcement personnel will be conducting random drug tests, alcoholic breath tests, and driver’s license checks to ensure road safety and prevent accidents. Safety inspections will also be carried out on public buses and amusement rides to guarantee the well-being of passengers and park-goers.



PRO 4A has identified 1,088 critical areas for heightened security, including 243 places of worship, 246 major roads, 92 transportation hubs, 208 commercial establishments, and 299 other areas of public convergence. These locations will be given priority patrol coverage and rapid-response units to address any incidents immediately.

The OPLAN RONDA CALABARZON will also see the

implementation of mobile patrols, checkpoint operations, and the coordination of real-time information sharing with local government units (LGUs) and volunteer groups. This comprehensive security strategy is designed to prevent crimes, assist the public, and ensure smooth traffic flow throughout the Holy Week.

In addition to on-the-ground efforts, PRO 4A is collaborating with the
