## PBBM designates De La Salle University Innovation Hub in Laguna as innovation ecozone

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. has officially designated a 50,000-square-meter parcel of land within the De La Salle University Science and Technology Complex in Biñan, Laguna, as a Knowledge, Innovation, Science and Technology (KIST) Ecozone.

Under Procla-

mation No. 985, the new zone will be known as the De La Salle University Innovation Hub, located at Leandro V. Locsin Campus, Laguna Blvd., Barangay Malamig, City of Biñan, Laguna.

The creation of KIST Ecozone aims to harness the potential of academic institutions in advancing research,

skills development, commercialization of R&D, and techno-entrepreneurship, particularly within state universities and colleges.

Executive Secretary Lucas Bersamin signed the proclamation on July 30.

The newly designated ecozone is sub-

# Calabarzon families get P157-M aid from DSWD

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna – The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office IV-A, has extended over PHP157.05 million in aid to families affected by the recent southwest monsoon and Typhoons Crising, Dante and Emong in the Calabarzon Region.

In a text message on Tuesday, DSWD-FO IV-A Public Information Officer Joseph Arceo said the assistance consisted of 222,996 family food packs and other essential items such as ready-to-eat meals, sleeping kits and hygiene kits.

The relief aid was distributed to 61 affected local government units (LGUs), including the provinces of Batangas, Cavite, Laguna, and Rizal, which reported a combined total of 269,823 affected families.

Arceo said that as of the 4 p.m. Aug. 4 report, 5,552 families remain in 142 evacuation centers, mostly in communities near Laguna Lake, where flooding has yet to subside.

Despite improving weather conditions, Arceo said the DSWD Field Office IV-A continues to work closely with LGUs to reach displaced families and those whose livelihoods were disrupted by the recent weather events.

"The DSWD reiterates its commitment to supporting local governments in disaster response and helping affected families recover from the impacts of these weather disturbances," Arceo added. (PNA)

The Provincial Government of Cavite, through the Office of the Provincial Cooperatives Development Officer (OPCDO), successfully concluded the 2025 BIZ iCREATE Training Program with its final session held on July 30, 2025, at De La Salle University-Dasmariñas. Facilitated by Dr. Aldrin P. Antivola, a Business Efficiency Advisor and Organizational Therapist, the training sessions held on June 23–24 and July 1–2 equipped participating entrepreneurs with essential skills in business planning, financial management, marketing, innovation, and sustainable practices.

For their final requirement, participants presented their individual Strategic Business Plans before a panel composed of Dr. Zandro M. Catacutan and Ms. Melody N. Plaza of Cavite State University, Dr. Leo D. Manansala of DLSU-D, and entrepreneur Mr. Allan G. Reclusado.

The presentations were followed by a graduation ceremony, where 16 entrepreneurs successfully completed the program.

# PANGILINAN WANTS DA'S EXTENSION SERVICES TO REACH PROVINCES

Senator Francis "Kiko" Pangillinan, who now chairs the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Food, and Agrarian Reform, is pushing for the strengthening and expansion of the Department of Agriculture's (DA) extension services to reach farmers in the provinces.

The senator lamented that currently, farmers couldn't access the DA's services because the agency only has regional offices.

"Ang extension service ay mali at pag hindi nakaugnay yung DA sa lupa, parang tanim (na) hindi tutubo. Kailangan nakatutuk," Pangilinan said. "Nais nating dagdagan ng extension service na programa hindi sa regional level. Dapat minimum hanggang probinsya."

The senator cited the state of farmers in Cavite, where his farm is also located.

"Kung kinakailangan nilang tutukan

ang ating extension service, paano na eh andon sila sa Lipa? Ang biyahe papuntang Lipa eh kulang-kulang tatlong oras," he said during a meeting last Thursday, July 31, with the Yakap at Halik Cooperative in Bailen, Cavite.

In a separate visit to Los Baños on Saturday, August 2, Pangilinan held the same discussions with a local farmers' cooperative, underscoring the need for government services to

Pag-IBIG Fund Chief Executive Officer Marilene Acosta emphasized that the agency's charter requires returning at least 70% of annual net income to members as dividends credited to their savings accounts.

"Pag-IBIG Fund is owned by its members — the Filipino workers. It is our duty to grow and

protect their savings," Acosta said. The agency serves millions of Filipino workers through savings programs and affordable home financing.

The record earnings position the fund to expand housing assistance while maintaining competitive returns for member savings, officials said. (JCO/PIA-NCR)

# Pag-IBIG Fund reports record P28B net income in first half of 2025

**MANILA, (PIA) —** The Home Development Mutual Fund posted its highest six-month earnings in 45 years, with net income surging 15% to P28.04 billion in the first half of 2025, officials announced Friday.

The government housing finance agency, known as Pag-IBIG Fund, saw gross income rise 12% to P44.39 billion from January through June compared with the same period last year.

The performance marks the strongest earnings period

since the agency's establishment in 1980, driven by increased collections and higher returns from housing and short-term loan portfolios.

**Investment returns drive growth**  
Investment income jumped 52%

year-over-year to P4.27 billion, accounting for nearly 6% of total gross income. The gains came from strategic investments in bonds, debt securities, money market instruments, equities and investment properties.

"This performance shows how excellently we are managing the funds that our members have entrusted to us," said Human Settlements and Urban

Development Secretary Jose Ramon Aliling, who chairs the agency's 11-member board of trustees.

The strong financial position supports the government's Expanded Pambansang Pabahay para sa Pilipino housing program, aimed at providing more Filipinos access to home ownership, Aliling said.
