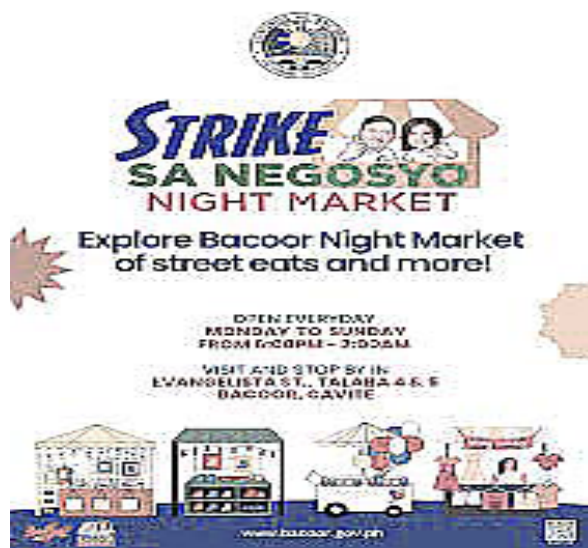

PH salt industry seen as a significant economic driver

The Department of Agriculture (DA) sees the potential of the Philippines' salt industry in boosting the local economy, promote sustainable livelihood, and as an income-generating opportunity for the Filipino people.

Being an archipelagic country, the possibilities of the salt industry for the Philippines' overall economic performance are endless, however, it has been greatly affected during the height of the pandemic.

Thus, the government is working dou-

ble time to improve the state of this integral part of the Philippine agriculture and economy.

Different national government agencies led by the DA are working closely in maximizing ways to improve the systems for the local salt industry and enable the sector to be self-sufficient.

The DA's Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) shifts its focus to conducting various research and development activities alongside the provision of technical assistance to local salt makers.

Last March 10, 2023, the DA-BFAR formally launched the Development of Salt Industry Project (DSIP), one of the several programs designed to narrow the gaps within the industry and the actual commodity production.

Aimed to increase and improve the production of quality salt, DSIP also known as "Oplan Asin: Pasiglahin, Sariling Atang Asin!" actually began in 2022, in collaboration with the National Fisheries Research and Development Institute (NFRDI).

Apart from these

ongoing programs, the agricultural department will also look into the expansion of production areas and development of technologies including evaporation systems and the use of various machinery to accelerate the production of salt.

The department also takes into consideration the development of the facilities for processing, more marketable packaging, and value-adding for marginal salt makers.

As an advocate for sustainable livelihood programs, Senator Loren Legarda pushed for the passage of Senate Bill No. 1870 or an Act Strengthening and Revitalizing the Development of the Salt Industry in the Philippines which, according to her will address the challenges and gaps of making the industry competitive in the local and international markets, as well as create more conducive jobs for salt farmers.

"Salt is not just an important food commodity for us all. The industry has been an integral part of the Philippine economy because it sustains many Filipinos through countless employment opportunities that continue to shape communities. We must not turn a blind eye to this equally important aspect of our society," Legarda said.

She added that salt farmers should be given priority through financial and technical assistance that can promote sustainable salt production. These can be through machines, new technologies, and

Apart from the candlelight ceremony, HIV testing and seminar on the diseases were conducted. The employees were also provided free reproductive health items.

In January 2023, the DOH HIV and ART registry logged 1,299 new cases enrolled to the treatment.

Of the total cases, about 644 or 50 percent are 25 to 34 years old; 410 or 32 percent are 15 to 24 years old; 209 or 16 percent are 35 to 49 years old; 32 or two percent are 50 years old and above; and four are less than 15 years old.

PH Navy christens
2 newly-acquired
Israeli missile boats

MANILA – The Philippine Navy said the arrival and christening of the two brand-new missile capable Shaldag Mark V (Acero-class patrol gunboats in the PN service) on Monday will greatly boost the service's capability to protect its littoral zones.

The littoral or nearshore is the part of a sea, lake, or river that is close to the shore.

Christening of these two vessels, which were also known as the fast attack interdiction craft missiles (FAIC-Ms), took place at the Naval Shipbuilding Facility Wharf at Fort San Felipe, Cavite City.

"Senate President Hon. Juan Miguel Zubiri witnessed the event as keynote speaker and initiated the traditional breaking of (a) sacrificial bottle on the FAIC-Ms. He was joined by PN chief, Vice Admiral Toribio Adaci Jr., and other AFP (Armed Forces of the Philippines) senior officials, as well as relatives of the vessels' namesakes," Navy spokesperson Captain Benjo Negranza said in a statement.

The FAIC-Ms were christened BRP Gener Tinangag (PG-903) and BRP Domingo Deluana (PG-905). "Said FAIC-Ms, which are part of the nine platforms contracted with Israel Shipyards, arrived from Israel on board the general cargo ship M/V Mick (last April 11) They were unloaded with the assistance of BRP Mamanwa (LC-294) and proceeded to the naval shipyard in Cavite for a series of tests and crew training," Negranza earlier said.

The PN spokesperson added that these ships are a welcome addition to the Navy's capability to secure vital choke points, key sea lines of communication and littoral areas of the country.

Five more are expected to be delivered within the next two years.

The namesake of these vessels are both members of the Philippine Marine Corps and awardees of the Medal of Valor like the first two FAIC-Ms who were commissioned into service last November.

These FAIC-Ms are the BRP Nestor Acero (PG-901) and BRP Lolinato To-ong.

"Similar to their predecessors in the Acero-class patrol gunboats of the (Philippine) Fleet's Littoral Combat Force, the two new platforms are now bearing the names of BRP Gener Tinangag and BRP Domingo Deluana," Philippine Fleet spokesperson Lt. Giovanni Badidles said.

The BRP Gener Tinangag was named after the Lance Cpl. Gener Tinangag, a assistant Marine rifleman, who rescued four of his wounded comrades and located the remains of the 1st Lt. John Frederick Savellano before being hit and mortally injured by a sniper during the Battle of Marawi in 2017.

Meanwhile, the BRP Domingo Deluana was named for Sgt. Domingo Deluana who was alongside 1st Lt. Lolinato To-ong in Maguindanao and provided suppressive fire to cover the medical evacuation of wounded fellow Marines until they were hit and killed by RPG blast during the campaign versus the Moro Islamic Liberation Front in 2000.

Coinciding with the christening of the two ships was the blessing ceremony for upgraded shipbuilding center of the PN, an integral part of the FAIC acquisition project with Israel Shipyards Inc.

The facility will facilitate the transfer of technology to boost the PN's shipbuilding capabilities. Three FAICs are expected to be constructed in this shipyard.

"These activities represent a great stride in the capacity and enhancement and capability of the PN, and a giant leap towards its vision of becoming modern and multi-capable to better protect our seas and secure the Filipino people," Badidles said.

The 32-meter long FAIC-Ms are high-speed vessels equipped with quick intercept ability, remote stabilized weapons, and short-range missiles that are capable of delivering precision strikes against larger hostiles and high-value targets on land and sea.

Four of the FAIC-Ms will be armed with non-line-of-sight (NLOS) missiles with pinpoint accuracy and a range of 25 kilometers

elaborated research and development studies to identify further and support the industry's changing needs.

Likewise, more improved policies should be considered, as well as a diverse collaboration between government agencies and stakeholders that will shepherd the formula-

tion and implementation of the Philippine Salt Industry Development Roadmap.

while the other five will be armed with Typhoon-mounted 30mm main cannons and .50 caliber heavy machine guns.

The acquisition of these FAIC-Ms is among the 2019 projects approved by former President Rodrigo Duterte under the Horizon 2 List of the AFP Modernization Program. The notice of award for the FAIC-M project, worth around PHP10 billion, was issued on January 5, 2021.

These are expected to replace PN's medium-sized patrol craft. The acquisition of these FAIC-Ms are completed, these vessels can interdict surface threats and launch NLOS missiles safely using the surrounding littoral areas as maneuver space and cover.

Earlier, Adaci said the Navy is planning to acquire at least 15 more Israel-made Shaldag Mark V missile boats, which are the basis of its Acero-class patrol gunboats.

He said the additional Acero-class gunboats would help them to meet their requirements in "patrolling the seas of the country".

Adaci also said the FAIC-Ms will be assigned to the Littoral Combat Force source: (PNA)

Group promotes HIV awareness in gov't agencies

MANILA – An advocacy group providing life-saving assistance to people living with human immunodeficiency virus (PLHIV) on Monday launched a program that aims to break the discrimination and stigma attached to HIV in government agencies.

Project Red Ribbon Director Ico Rodolfo Johnson told the Philippine News Agency (PNA) that their group wanted government agencies to have a safe, working environment and a safe space where people can talk about HIV as it affects not only the at-risk population but also every member of the society.

"By bringing the HIV services to government agencies, they will be made aware of the services of the Department of Health but also they will witness and feel the services so they can easily talk about HIV more freely, basically to normalize a conversa-

tion," he said.

Project Red Ribbon provides HIV awareness, prevention, testing, treatment, care and support services to improve the quality of life of PLHIV.

The program started with a candlelight ceremony in front of the Philippine Information Agency (PIA) building on Visayas Avenue in Quezon City.

The ceremony commemorates the hardships faced by PLHIVs and the people who have died from HIV.

Johnson said their group would have the same program at the Department of Health on May 15, the Department of Justice on May 22 and the Department of Social Welfare and Development on May 29.

DOH Assistant Secretary Beverly Ho, who also took part in the ceremony, encouraged everyone to get tested for HIV.

"Kase 'di po gaya nung 1980s na kapag nagkaroon ka ng AIDS, nasentensiyahan ka na, kamatayan na siya, ngayon, maganda na po 'yung mga gamot natin (Unlike in the 1980s when you have it, it's already a death sentence, now, we have good medicines). The side effects are lesser and many of our PLHIVs are living normal lives, they are able to go to work, go to school, with actually very little difficulty," she said.

HIV testing, anti-retroviral therapies (ART) for PLHIVs and pre-exposure prophylaxis medicines are provided free at social hygiene clinics and some treatment centers in local government units. The list of these centers and clinics can be found on the DOH website, she added.

"It is important where they are able to access medicines. There must be correct

counseling and they are monitored because there are times when there are side effects, so they can be helped by their healthcare provider how to adjust, if change of medicines is needed," Ho said.

She added that the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation also has a benefit package annually for PLHIV.

PIA Director General Ramon Cualoping III said the HIV situation could be caused by lack of discipline among people or lack of awareness on ways to mitigate the spread of the virus.

"So, here lies the role and challenge of the agency. Supposedly we are proud to say we have the largest footprint in the communications instrumentality of the Philippines, hence, it is our role to help spread awareness, disseminate the right information, to dismiss disinformation,"
