

## Cavite MSMEs interested in vacuum-freeze drying tech

A good number of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) have expressed interest in vacuum-freeze drying technology as an innovation to their businesses, Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Secretary Fortunato de la Peña announced on Friday.

In a taped report, he said at least 60 have attended a virtual seminar on the use of vacuum-freeze drying facility



**Sec. Fortunato de la Peña** that the DOST has organized last September 2.

The participants were from the food enterprises, cooperatives,

farmer associations, and government sectors, he said.

"Preservation, longevity of shelf life, and hygroscopicity or water-absorptivity which allows for easy reconstitution are among the advantages of this technology," de la Peña remarked.

According to him, the resource person talked about how the vacuum freeze-drying

**MANILA – The Department of Tourism (DOT) and Maynilad on Thursday partnered to promote proper wastewater management in Metro Manila, particularly in tourist destinations in the water firm's service area.**

In a virtual ceremony, the DOT and Maynilad Water Services, Inc. signed a memorandum of understanding on "Maynilad Kubeta PH X It's More Fun in the Philippines" initiative that would award the Seal of Good Toilet-keeping to 24 tourist destinations such as parks, historical sites and restaurants in the region. For establish-

ments to be conferred the Seal, their restrooms must be consistently clean and well-maintained and equipped with basic fixtures and amenities, including a working faucet and flush, soap and toilet paper.

They also have to be compliant with government regulations on wastewater management via regular desludging of septic tanks, connection to Maynilad's sewer network, or operation of law-compliant sewage treatment facilities.

Maynilad President and CEO Ramoncito Fernandez is optimistic this campaign would bring conversations about prop-

er wastewater management to the mainstream and make people realize the shared responsibility of preserving the environment.

"Almost every Filipino knows what the term kubeta means, it's also catchy enough to make the listener sit up and want to know what the campaign is about. The word kubeta evokes a sense of discomfort, pangalan pa lang mabaho na (the name doesn't 'smell' good) -- that's exactly the intent of the program to create the kind of discomfort that leads to an increase in awareness and eventually malasakit (concern)," she said.

"The simple act of knowing and caring where the water goes when we flush a toilet is a step in that direction," he added.

The DOT will name the nominees which will be subject to both document and physical audits led by Maynilad's wastewater management team. Only those who will pass the stringent audit process will be awarded the Seal that can be renewed annually.

The DOT said the campaign seeks to underscore the importance of keeping toilets clean and comfortable for tourists and the general public and the need to comply with relevant laws and regulations.

collaborate with Maynilad for this campaign. This is very timely as the current health crisis highlights the critical importance of sanitation and hygiene," said Tourism Secretary Bernadette Romulo-Puyat.

"[P]romoting quality, clean, and safe toilets in tourist destinations will also contribute to our efforts to gradually restart tourism activity in our country for tourism, public toilets are crucial. These should not be only clean but also safe and comfortable for tourists to use. Simple as it may seem, but toilets could make or break a tourist's travel experience," she added.

The campaign is in line with the Asean Public Toilet Standard, which aims to ensure that public toilets at tourist destinations in the region are clean, provide comfort and safety, and practices proper waste management.

The Seal of Good Toilet-keeping is the newest component of Maynilad's 2016 Kubeta PH campaign, an integrated information, education and communication campaign that aims to spur positive action from various stakeholders on wastewater management.

Maynilad's service area includes the cities of Manila (all but portions of San Andres and Sta. Ana), Quezon City (west of San Juan River, West Avenue, Edsa, Congressional, Mindanao Avenue, the northern part starting from the Districts of Holy Spirit and Batasan Hills), Makati (west of South Super Highway), Caloocan, Pasay, Parañaque, Las Piñas, Muntinlupa, Valenzuela, Navotas, and Malabon, all in Metro Manila; and the cities of Cavite, Bacoor, and Imus, and the towns of Kawit, Noveleta, and Rosario, all in the province of Cavite.source: (PNA)JPR

process preserves the nutrient content of fruits or vegetables, compared to other drying methods, such as air-drying or sun-drying.

"The speaker, Dr. Adelisa Dorado, an associate professor at the University of the Philippines - Los Baños, also identified long duration of

processing time and high operating cost as the disadvantages of this technology," he added.

Meanwhile, dela Peña said the Cavite Provincial Agriculturist Office expressed interest in adopting the technology for its assisted farmers' association. The DOST-Calabar-

zon acquired a vacuum freeze-drying equipment, currently housed in the Calabarzon Food Solutions Hub in Laguna, for use of the Association of Laguna Food Processors and other food enterprises in the region in developing and commercializing food products, he said. source:(PNA)

## DEPED OPENS 1,869 SCHOOL CLINICS – SEC. BRIONES

The Department of Education (DepEd) recently kicked off the celebration of One Health Week by simultaneously inaugurating 1,869 school clinics around the country as part of the School Dental Health Care Program (SDHCP).

“We find it necessary to still provide these services to learners and personnel to address the high prevalence of dental caries and other health problems during the time of the pandemic,” Education Secretary Leonor Briones said.

Spearheaded by DepEd Bureau of Learners Support Ser-

vices-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), the SDHCP refurbished 1,706 out of the 1,869 clinics, with 1,068 equipped with newly installed dental chairs, medical consultation rooms, tools, and medical supplies.

was the simultaneous symbolic ribbon-cutting of different school clinics live streamed via Zoom accompanied with messages from all Regional Directors.

## 9 na mangingisda huli sa “illegal fishing” sa Ternate

The Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) apprehended nine fishermen for illegal fishing off Ternate, Cavite on Thursday, Sept. 16.

In an incident report, the PCG said the nine fishermen were caught conducting actual trawl fishing in the waters of Ternate, Cavite.

Upon the initial investigation, the Coast Guard said the motor-banca was also found to be registered as “Ate

Janna” but was marked as “Heneral Luna” on its bow.

The apprehended skipper is identified as Rafilo Mina, a resident of Tanza, Cavite. Meanwhile, the authorities has yet to identify the 8 crew members.

The PCG said the apprehended motor-banca was impounded for violating the Municipal Ordinance No. 2 series of 2011 Sec. 51 “Fishing without a license and

permit” and Municipal Ordinance No. 2 series of 2011 Sec. 52 “Commercial fishing in municipal waters.”

The nine apprehended fishermen will also face charges for violation of Municipal Ordinance No. 2 series of 2011 Sec. 57 “Use of active gear in municipal waters and other fishery management areas” and Municipal Ordinance No. 2 series of 2011 Sec. 65
