

## 2025 One Town, One Product Next Gen program kicks off in Cavite with ACT session

The 2025 OTOP (One Town, One Product) Next Gen program officially commenced on May 28, 2025, with the Assessment, Consultation, and Triage (ACT) facilitated by the Office of the Provincial Cooperatives Development Officer (OPCDO), at the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Session Hall, Trece Martires City. The activity

marked the beginning of a comprehensive product development journey for 20 selected entrepreneur-beneficiaries from the province of Cavite.

The ACT session served as a vital platform for participating entrepreneurs to engage in one-on-one consultations with representatives from key government agencies, including

the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOPHL), and the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA). In addition, they had the opportunity to work with a professional outsourced designer who will guide them in enhancing their product

branding and packaging.

A seminar on Design Trends was also conducted, where participants learned about the stages of creating impactful logos, labels, and packaging—essential elements for making their products market-ready and globally competitive.

# Kadiwa opens in Cavite police camp

IMUS CITY, Cavite (PIA) — The Cavite Police Provincial Office (PPO) joined the Department of Agriculture and local agricultural offices in supporting farmers and local entrepreneurs by launching its own Kadiwa ng Pangulo store inside its headquarters at Camp BGen. ## Group Enrollment Program, Isinusulong ng PhilHealth

Isinagawa ng PhilHealth Regional Office IVA ang serye ng oryentasyon ukol sa group enrollment na dinaluhan ng mga HR practitioners at kinatawan ng mga LGUs, National Government Agencies at iba pang pribadong institusyon. Ang Group Enrollment Program o GEP ng PhilHealth ay isang alternatibong paraan para sa mga organisadong grupo, National Government Agencies na mapadali ang pagbibigay ng PhilHealth coverage sa mga Job Order Contract Workers, seasonal employees o ang mga walang tinatawag na employer-employee relationship sa ilalim ng batas.

Batay sa PhilHealth Circular 2017-0008, mandatory ang coverage ng mga indibidwal na directly hired Job Orders (JOs) at Project Based Contractors (PBCs) sa gobyerno bilang miyembro ng PhilHealth sa ilalim ng Informal Economy. Sa ilalim din nito, binibigyan ng kapangyarihan ang mga employers na magbawas at mag-remit ng premium contributions nga mga naturang empleyado bilang Individually Paying Members o Self Earning Individuals sa ilalim ng Group Enrollment Scheme.

Ang mga Local Government Agencies, National Government

Agencies at pribadong institusyon na nagpakita ng intensyon na sumali sa implementasyon ng Group Enrollment Program ay kinakailangan na magsumite ng mga sumusunod na dokumento:

1. Pirmadong Memorandum of Agreement or Letter of Commitment at
  2. Non-Disclosure Agreement
- Matapos, makapagpa-rehistro, magi-isyu ng PhilHealth Organized Group Number (POGN) na mag-sisilbing pagkakailanlan ng kanilang grupo. Ang POGN din ang gagamitin sa pagpaparehistro o renewal ng mga taong nakalista sa programa at pagbabayad ng kanilang premium contributions.

Lahat ng Pilipinong indibidwal na hindi kasapi ng National Health Insurance Program ay maaaring mai-enroll sa Group Enrollment Program na hindi limitado sa mga sumusunod:

1. Contract of Service (COS), Job order and Project-based personnel
2. Miyembro ng mga micro-finance institutions at iba pang organisadong grupo
3. Self-earning individuals
4. Professional practitioners
5. LGU constituents na nabibilang sa may mababang sahod, barangay health workers, nutrition scholars at iba pang

Sa pagpaparehistro, ang mga group partners ay kinakailangang magsumite sa PhilHealth ng listahan ng kanilang nais isali sa programa kalakip ang napunan na PhilHealth Member Registration Form (PMRF) at mga kaukulang dokumento.

Sa mga kaso na may mga indibidwal na may intensyon na mag withdraw ng kanilang pagiging miyembro, ang mga group partners ay dapat agarang ipahayag ang kanilang pag withdraw at magpasa ng Group Enrollment Withdrawal Form.

Ang premium contribution sa ilalim ng Group Enrollment Program ay naaayon sa PhilHealth Circular 2020-0005 na base sa idineklarang kita ng miyembro sa pamamagitan ng group partner.

Ang mga group partners ay regular na ebi-bill sa pamamagitan ng pagbibigay ng Statement of Premium Account (SPA) na maaaring monthly, quarterly, semi-annually at annually. Ito ay maaaring bayaran sa mga Local Health Insurance Offices o Accredited Collecting Agents na awtomatikong papasok sa indibidwal account ng mga miyembro.

Ang mga indibidwal na gagamit ng benepisyo ng PhilHealth ay bibigyan ng Certificate of Premium Payment na maaaring mag-ing batayan kung updated ang kanyang kontribusyon sa PhilHealth.

Sa kasalukuyan, mayroon nang 42 group partners at 1,210 miyembro sa ilalim ng Group Enrollment Program. Sa mga grupo o organisasyon na nais mapabilang sa GEP, maaaring makipag-ugnayan sa alingmang tanggapan ng PhilHealth sa inyong lugar. ### (JDB)

### Pagbabayad ng estate tax, hanggang June 14 pa

Muling panlamig ng Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) ang palugit sa pagbabayad ng estate tax o buwis sa mga ari-ariang di natitinag tulad ng lupa, hanggang sa Hunyo 14, 2025.

Ayon sa BIR, ang ari-ariang naiwan ng yumaong mahal sa buhay dapat nang asikasuhin at ayusin ng mga naiwang tagapagmana at bayaran ang kaukulang buwis. Ang mga tagapagmana ay may obligasyong legal.

Sa bisa ng Republic Act No. 11213, inilunsad ang Estates Tax Amnesty para bigyan ang mga pamilyang naiwan ng kaluwagan sa pagbabayad ng buwis.

Sakop ng Amnestiya ang mga buwis mula sa mga ari-ariang natitinag man o di na- matitinag na iwan ng mga yumao noong o bago sumapit ang ang Mayo 31, 2022.

Ayon pa rin sa BIR, ang estates tax ay buwis sa net state o kabuuang halagang naiwan ibawas ang mga utang at bayarin.

Ito ay katumbas ng anim na porsyento (6%) ng net estate o minimum na P5,000 at dapat ng nababayaran sa loob ng isang taon matapos ang pagkamatay.

Dapat samantalain ng mga tagapagmana ang palugit ng BIR. Ayusin na po natin ang mga iyan para walang problema.

May panahon pa naman, kung kikilos ay kaya iyan bago matapos ang palugit.

## DHSUD: 4PH gets commitments of 50K housing units

MANILA — More than 50,000 housing units have been committed by private developers to the recalibrated Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program, the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) said Monday.

In a news release, the DHSUD said these developers — Raemulan Lands Inc., (RLI), 8990/Deca Homes, and Fiesta Communities Inc. — are engaged in horizontal socialized housing developments.

The RLI Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Ei-

leen Uy Doyle has vowed to allot 35,656 units in the provinces of Pampanga, Cavite, Bulacan and Laguna, while Fiesta chief executive officer (CEO) Christopher Ryan Tan committed at least 6,387 units and 8990/Deca Homes president and CEO Vincent Sotto pledged 9,498.

DHSUD Secretary Jose Ramon Aliling said these commitments indicate that the 4PH Program is on the right track with the inclusion of horizontal developments.

"This will surely boost the private sector's confidence in the program," he said.

"We will continue to explore all feasible modalities under recalibrated 4PH, not only to address a wider market, but more importantly, as our way of listening to clamor from stakeholders," he added. Top DHSUD officials are now crafting the guidelines for the new concept, Aliling said, as he vowed to sustain and improve the 4PH, including fully-digitized services to ensure fast and comfortable actions.

Aliling has also issued a circular calling for the expeditious handling and disposition of homebuyers' complaints against developers.source: (PNA)

# Healthcare Services for PDL of BJMP Naic

The provincial government of Cavite's medical and dental mission was successfully conducted at the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) facility in Naic, Cavite on May 30, 2025, extending much-needed healthcare services to a total of 347 Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDLs).

The initiative was made possible through the request of the Vicarial Coordination Prison Ministry and San Isidro Labrador

percent are considered low literate (can read and write only), and 4.7 percent are illiterate (cannot read and write) within the same age group.

Garcia said the program also emphasizes data-driven instruction, with learners undergoing pre- and post-assessments to monitor progress. Teachers receive orientation and development training to ensure effective delivery of the CARE+1 modules.

“This is the current program underway in Calabarzon across all divisions and in selected

schools, after identifying learners with low performance in foundational learning. Remediation activities are being provided to support our learners,” Garcia added.

The CARE+1 program reflects DepEd Calabarzon's strong commitment to addressing learning gaps worsened by recent educational disruptions, focusing on critical reading and numeracy skills to equip students with improved competencies and greater confidence for the upcoming academic year. children must be supervised when playing with cats and dogs as they might do something that would trigger the animals to bite.

Under the Rabies Control Act, anti-rabies vaccines for cats and dogs are administered by local government units for free.

Private veterinary clinics offer them for PHP100 to PHP400.

“Iyong bakuna sa tao ay binibigay kapag nakagat o nakalmot o nadilaan ang ating mga sugat or mga tusuk-tusok sa ating balat ng mga hayop na aso or pusa (Vaccine is given to individuals who are bitten, scratched, or their wounds were licked by cats and dogs),” he said.

Human post-exposure prophylaxis reaches up to seven vaccines, which are available at public health centers, he added.

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation offers an animal bite package covering PHP5,850 worth of essential post-exposure prophylaxis. This includes rabies vaccine, rabies immune globulin, local wound care, tetanus toxoid, antibiotics and necessary supplies like syringes and antiseptics. (PNA)

# DOH records 32% drop in rabies cases nationwide

**MANILA –** The Department of Health (DOH) on Monday said 124 rabies cases were recorded nationwide from Jan. 1 to May 17 this year, a 32-percent drop from the 183 logged during the same period last year.

In a Bagong Pilipinas Ngayon interview, DOH Assistant Secretary Albert Domingo said Central Luzon recorded the most number of cases with

21, followed by Zamboanga Peninsula with 15 and Calabarzon with 12.

“Kahit maliit po iyong bilang, masaklap kasi iyong rabies kasi kapag nakagat ka ng hayop na may rabies at

nagkaroon ka na ng sintomas, mataas ho ang fatality rate (Even if the numbers are low, rabies is terrible because once you’re bitten by an animal infected with rabies and have symptoms, the

fatality rate is high),” he said.

The case fatality rate of rabies is 100 percent, and infections happen all year round because it is transmitted by cats and dogs infect-

ed by the virus.

Pet owners are advised to have their pets vaccinated so they cannot transmit rabies virus.

## DepEd’s CARE+1 program to bridge literacy gap in Calabarzon

The Department of Education (DepEd) in Calabarzon continues to strengthen learners’ literacy and numeracy skills, aiming to reduce the region’s remaining low literacy and illiteracy rates.

DepEd Calabarzon Chief Education Supervisor Elinor Garcia said the education department is imple-

menting the Cognitive Activities for Reading Enhancement + Numeracy (CARE+1), a summer intervention program to support students who need additional assistance in literacy and numeracy from grade school to senior high school.

“Grounded in science and mathemat-

ics, it reflects our commitment to data-driven, inclusive remediation directly aligned with the gap in comprehension and reading application revealed in the FLEMMS 2024,” Garcia explained during the Philippine Statistics Authority’s 2024 Functional Literacy, Education and Mass Media Survey Regional

Dissemination Forum.

The PSA Calabarzon revealed that 92.6 percent or nine out

of 10 individuals aged 5 years old and over residing in the region are basic literate or can read,

write with understanding and can compute.
