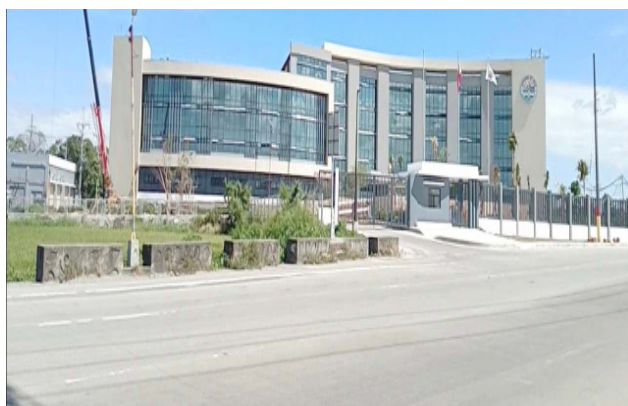

Forms filled up should be submitted to

the Barangay or the CCR office or submit via email at ccro.imus@gmail.com.

All applications will be subject for validation of non-registration or no record.

Required documents for the processing are: Baptismal certificate, medical record, marriage

PhilHealth registration required among college students

An official of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) on Thursday said college students are required to be registered with them or in any private health insurance before taking part in face-to-face classes.

In a televised public briefing, PhilHealth Vice President for Corporate Affairs, Dr.

Shirley Domingo, said the requirement came from the Commission on Higher Education and the Department of Health through a joint department order.

"Nakalagay po doon na iyong estudyante ay kailangan pong magkaroon ng PhilHealth registration o kahit anong katumbas na medical insurance para magkaroon

naman sila ng proteksiyon habang nagpi-face-to-face classes po sila (It stated that the student must have a PhilHealth registration or any equivalent medical insurance for them to have protection as they participate in face-to-face classes)," Domingo said.

While the PhilHealth is yet to have the exact number of college

students who have registered, Domingo noted that the agency continues to receive applications from their regional offices and some schools.

Under the national health insurance program, individuals under 21 years old are dependents of primary members like parents.

Be professional, don't act beyond bounds, PRRD to PNPA grads

MANILA – President Rodrigo Duterte on Thursday urged the graduates of the Philippine National Police Academy (PNPA) Class 2022 to maintain their professionalism by heeding the call of duty without acting beyond their legal parameters.

“You must maintain professionalism for you will soon take over its leadership and will be the role models of future Filipino law enforcers,” Duterte said during the graduation rites of the PNPA “Alab-Kalis” Class of 2022 in Silang, Cavite.

Duterte made the call, as he extolled the cops for being at the forefront in the fight against illegal drugs, criminality, and terrorism under his leadership.

He expressed

hope that the graduates would sustain the “same level of courage, determination and passion” as they join the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Bureau of Fire and Protection (BFP), and the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP).

He also told them to avoid acting beyond their legal parameters, reminding them that their mandate is to serve and protect the Filipino people.

“Although our war with lawless forces is far from over, I am proud to say that we have made great strides in improving the crime situation in the country,” Duterte said. “Always be reminded that the core of your profession is and will always be the welfare of our people.”

Legal assistance

Duterte, a lawyer, said he is willing to provide legal assistance to cops even after his term ends in 2022, so long as they are performing their duties within the bounds of the law.

He reiterated his “love” for the policemen who help maintain law and order in the country under his watch.

“Maski retired na ako (Even if I retire already), if you want my help, lalo na ‘yung masabit kayo in a legitimate operation, nandyan ako (especially those who will face charges after conducting a legitimate operation, I will be here for you). And maybe I will appear in court for you,” Duterte said.

Duterte told the graduates to refrain from “[going] out of [their] legal parameters.”

“Kung ano lang ang tama, ‘yun ang sundin niyo (I said do what is right),” he said. “Do not go out of your legal parameters, ‘yung tama lang na trabaho ng pulis pati alam niya ang obligasyon sa taumbayan (just do your job and fulfill your obligation to our fellow countrymen).”

Duterte, after his keynote speech, also issued an order giving pardon to PNPA cadets with outstanding punishments and demerits.

House and lot for class valedictorian

Duterte also announced that the PNPA Alab-Kalis Class’ graduating valedictorian, Cadet Ernie Alarba Padernilla

from Passi City, Iloilo, will receive house and lot from the government.

“Your valedictorian, I am talking on behalf [of the government], may house and lot ‘yan (he will receive a house and lot),” he said.

Padernilla also received the Presidential Kampilan, Chief PNP Kapitan, Best in Forensic Science Award, and the

DOLE RELEASES P7.5M TUPAD WAGES TO DISTRICT 5 OF CAVITE

The Department of Labor and Employment Cavite Provincial Office (DOLE CPO) in coordination with the 5th legislative district of Cavite conducted a ceremonial release and payment of salaries to the beneficiaries of emergency employment assistance under the Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/ Displaced Workers (TUPAD).

The three-day ceremony was spearheaded by Officer in Charge (OIC) Assistant Regional Director (ARD) of DOLE – CALABARZON Atty. Nepomuceno A. Leaño II and DOLE CPO – OIC Engr. Joseph P. Gacosta. The ceremony took place over March 25, 29 and April 1 and was held at the covered court of Hon. Marciano Mapanoo Park in Carmona, Cavite. The first and second batches consist of five hundred ten (510) and four hundred thirty-three (433) beneficiaries respectively all coming from the municipalities of Carmona and Silang, while the third batch consists of nine hundred forty-eight (948) beneficiaries which came from the municipality of General Mariano Alvarez (GMA).



By virtue of the TUPAD program, DOLE CPO was able to award and provide emergency employment to one thousand eight hundred ninety-one (1,891) beneficiaries from the municipalities of Carmona, Silang, and GMA. Under the program, workers were required to render 10 days of work through social and economic community project. Prior to actual engagement in employment, the beneficiaries are provided with basic orientation, TUPAD ID and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in the form of T-shirt and hat. The workers are paid Php400.00 per day based on the highest prevailing minimum wage in CALABARZON amounting to Php4,00.00 for each beneficiary.

During the ceremony, DOLE CPO – OIC Engr. Gacosta reminded the beneficiaries that the Php4,00.00 salary should be received in full and without any deductions. He also said that the Department implements TUPAD yearly, however, it should only be availed once by a beneficiary so as to accommodate other beneficiaries.

OIC-ARD Atty. Leaño also echoed the same sentiment and made a remark that in order to facilitate a prompt payout, the Department brought its full force. Lastly, OIC -ARD Atty. Leaño added that though TUPAD is a project of DOLE, it is only made possible through the help and leadership of the local municipality leaders and the Department.By:JOSHUA NOEL C. BASSIG LEO III/MA. 21 years old who are registered through their parents simply need to show the PhilHealth Member Data Record (MDR) to their schools, Domingo noted.

"Kung hindi naman nadeklara as dependent sa mga magulang nila, so ang advice po natin sa mga magulang na mag-update ng kanilang membership at idagdag itong mga estudyante na ito as their dependents (If they're not declared as dependents by their parents, the parents are advised to update their membership and add the students as dependents)," she said.

Students who are 21 years old and above are encouraged to register directly to any of the Phil-

Health offices as primary members.

Since they are primary members, they will be given a PhilHealth Identification Number which they can use as primary contributors to pay online using the Phil-Health website. They can pay also in selected banks or in accredited collecting agents.

"Kung ma-expose sila sa Covid at mag-ka-Covid, then they can

avail of the Covid benefits. Kung ma-isolate sila sa mga community isolation units, mayroon tayong benefits doon, or – huwag naman po – pero in-patient benefits, mayroon din tayo (If they're exposed to Covid and contract the disease, they can avail of the Covid benefits. If they'll be isolated in community isolation units, we have benefits or in-patient benefits, we also have that)," Domingo said.source: (PNA)

DepEd suspends public school classes from May 2 to 13 due to Election '22

The Department of Education (DepEd) announced on Monday that all classes in public schools, from kindergarten to senior high school, will be temporarily suspended from May 2 to 13 to prepare for this year's national and local elections.

According to the DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2021, the two-week class suspension will be allocated for national election-related activities.

However, teachers are required to still report in schools during days that have no election-related duties or activities.

activities.

During elections, teachers serve as inspectors, and the public school classrooms are used as voting centers.
