

PRESIDENT DUTERTE VOWS TO ERADICATE CORRUPTION IN PHILHEALTH

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte vowed to go after corrupt Philippine Health Insurance Corp. (PhilHealth) officials saying he would spend his two remaining years in office eliminating corruption at the state-run insurance corporation.



In a televised public address morning, President Duterte said he himself would endorse the cases to be filed against corrupt PhilHealth officials, stressing he would affix his signature in endorsing cases against them.

The President said the PhilHealth should

be thoroughly investigated and those responsible must be prosecuted.

DOH CALABARZON IMPLEMENTS CODE STRATEGY FOR BRGY AFFECTED BY COVID-19

The Department of Health (DOH) – CALA-BARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) this week started implementing the "Coordinated Operations to Defeat Epidemic" or CODE strategy to 30 barangays with the highest confirmed or active cases of COVID-19 in the region.

According to Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo, under the CODE COVID-19, each barangay will be closely monitored and ensure their accessibility to isolation facilities, including birthing facility, laboratory and dialysis center. The number of workers in each barangay will also be accounted for including the presence and assistance of Barangay Health Emergency Response Team

(BHERT) and the Philippine National Police.

"Once these are all in place, we will begin the massive swab testing immediately sa mga identified barangays. Magkakaroon tayo ng active case finding at magha-house-to-house tayo to check kung mayroong mga taong may covid symptoms sa kanilang mga bahay. Kapag mayroong nagpositibo na miyembro ng isang pamilya ay kailangang i-lockdown ang bahay at walang palalabasin upang hindi makahawa pa ng iba. We will isolate residence who are positive with COVID-19 including their close contacts." he stated.

Janairo added that the swab testing for residents of identified barangays will be free of charge.

The CODE strat-

egy will involve close coordination between DOH representatives, the local government units and the communities to ensure that communities are properly prepared as they return to GCO

"Dito ay magfo-focus tayo sa barangay level and we will address it through a more stringent enforcement of health protocols including localized lockdowns, curfews, staying at home and lesser social interactions to prevent the spread and transmission of the virus."

As of August 20, 2020, there are 15,292 COVID 19 cases in CALA-BARZON and 10,086 are active cases. There are 4,789 recoveries with 420 deaths reported.

Of The five prov-

inces, Laguna has the highest reported cases with 5,857 followed by Cavite with 3,492 and Rizal with 2,922. Batangas has 2,263 and Quezon with 761 cases.



27 Pangasinense students stranded in Cavite return home

LINGAYEN, Pangasinan – Some 27 senior high school graduates recently stranded in Silang, Cavite have reunited with their families after the provincial government of Pangasinan facilitated their return to the province.

In a statement , the Provincial Information Office (PIO) said the students were composed of 14 males and 13 females who graduated from St. Mary of Banneux (The Sisters of Mary) school.

"They were not allowed to go home to Pangasinan since the start of the lockdown in March. Several of them stated that they have been away from their home months before the declared quarantine periods," the PIO said.

The students were fetched on August 23 by the provincial government's shuttle buses from Cavite to their respective homes, it added.

"Inclusive of the free transportation, the locally stranded individuals were treated with meals and family packs," the PIO said.

It said the students were not allowed to be visited by their family members but the institution did not totally block their communication.

"The parents or guardians of the students were allowed to connect with their sons and daughters via scheduled phone calls using the institution's communication lines (for students who do not have cellular phones). With stricter administrative policy, the students were not allowed to go out of the school premises at all to safeguard their health and ensure their safety," the PIO said.

Bishops warn against push for revolutionary gov't

The push for a revolutionary government by supporters of President Rodrigo Duterte will only bring "chaos" than improvement, Catholic bishops warned.

Caritas Philippines national director Bishop Jose Colin Bagaforo of Kidapawan said that "not only that it is inciting to sedition, it is at best will ruin the government".

"Declaring a revolutionary government will only bring chaos to an already beleaguered administration," Bagaforo said.

"It will not solve the problems we are facing but instead use the Filipino people as pawns to justify vested interests," he said.

Echoing Bagaforo's statement, Bishop Broderick Pabillo, the apostolic administrator of the Manila archdiocese, said the proposal is "unjust and immoral".

"That is seditious.
That is being a traitor to the country," Pabillo said over Church-run Radio Veritas.

The bishops instead urged the government to focus on pressing matters such as addressing the coronavirus health crisis.

health crisis.

"(They) should focus
on the pandemic, the ongoing

health crisis in the country instead of setting up a revolutionary government," Archbishop Martin Jumoad of Ozamiz said.

For his part, Bishop Ruperto Santos of Balanga said that the proposal is not only unconstitutional "but an open admission that the present government is a total failure

"They want to change the government just to install the same government officials. There is no sense, void of human reason. It is just like the maxim same dog different collar," he said.

Bagaforo called on Filipinos to be more vigilant and make sure that "deceiving

plots" against democracy and people's welfare will be closely scrutinized.

The prelate also stressed the importance for Duterte to "truthfully disclose" his state of health.

"Not for his successor and critics to benefit from, but for Filipinos to be assured that we have a sound, fit-to-rule executive, able to carry-out decisions with the best of intentions for the Filipino people at heart." he said.

Some 300 people gathered at Clark Freeport in Pampanga on Saturday to call for the establishment of a revolutionary government to be headed by Duterte.





DILG: 437 local execs and conspirators face raps over SAP 1 anomalies

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) said 437 local elected and appointed public officials and their civilian co-conspirators are now facing criminal charges while 626 more are under probe by the PNP-CIDG for alleged anomalies in the pay-outs of the Social Amelioration Program

"Habang patuloy ang pangalawang yugto ng pamimigay ng SAP, puspusan naman ang ating pagsasampa ng kaso laban sa mga tiwaling mga opisyal at ng kanilang mga kasabwat. Sobrang nakakadismaya na nagawa pa nilang mangurakot sa ayudang nakalaan para sa sa ating mga kababayan na lubhang apektado ng pandemya," said DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año.

He said that of the 437 cases filed before the various Prosecutor's Office of the Department of Justice, 203 including a Municipal Mayor, City/Municipal Councilors, Barangay Captains, Barangay Kagawads, SK Chairmen and SK Councilors.

Another 102 are barangay and city personnel, including Barangay Secretaries, Barangay Treasurers, Barangay Health Workers, Home Owner's Association Officers, Purok Leaders, City/Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer, SAP Enumerators and Day Care Teachers while the remaining 132 were civilian co-conspirators.

The DILG earlier filed complaints against 50 barangay officials from among those currently being investigated with a prayer for their immediate preventive suspen-

The DILG Chief added that the majority of the cases filed were violations on Republic Act (RA) 3019 or An-

were elected public officials, ti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act; RA 11469 or Bayanihan Act; and RA 11332 or Law on Reporting of Communicable Diseases, among others.

"Ang laban natin sa korapsiyon ay kasing-tindi ng laban natin sa COVID-19, mahirap sugpuin pero hindi tayo susuko hanggang maparusahan ang mga tiwali," he said.

He lauded the efforts of the Philippine National Police-Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (PNP-CIDG) for vigorously investigating 336 SAP related-cases across the country.

Of the 336 cases, 240 were already filed with the Prosecutors Office, three are for case filing, six were endorsed to other agencies, 46 are under investigation or case build-up, and 41 were dismissed for lack of probable cause or insufficient evidence.

On a regional level, 50 cases were filed in Region

XII, 40 cases in Region VI, 33 cases in Region VII, 30 cases in Region IV-A, 26 cases in Region VIII, 24 cases in Region XI, and 21 cases in National Capital Region.

There are also 16 cases in Region V, 14 cases in Region 4B; 15 cases in Region I, 14 cases in Region II, 12 cases in Region 10; 12 cases in CARAGA, 10 in Cordillera Administrative Region; and two in Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM).

He acknowledged that a huge part of the success in going after these public officials are the members of the public who bravely filed complaints with the nearest PNP

Año is confident that there will be lesser complaints on anomalies now that the second tranche of the SAP is distributed mostly through electronic means.

Suspect was brought to Jose R Reyes Medical Center for physical and medical examination and subsequently brought to Sta. Cruz Police Station for custody and booking procedures pending the return of his warrant.

TESDA's TOTS project to benefit relocation site in Maragondontown

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) -- The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)-Cavite will launch the Turn-On-The-Sun (TOTS) project on August 28, 2020 in Maragondon town.

This is a five-day training for Basic Solar (off-grid) Lighting and Charging System for the benefit of the residents of Barangay Sta. Mercedes as well as identified personnel of the local National Police (PNP) and Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP). Said training will not only provide additional skills for the learners but also working solar lighting and charging system for their personal use.

TESDA, being the PRLEC (Poverty Reduction, Livelihood and Employment Cluster) Chair in the national level, under the directive of President Rodrigo Duterte, aims to develop self-reliant, resilient and sustainable communities through harmonized and culturally responsive development programs.

The identified PRLEC priority barangay for the province of Cavite is Barangay Patungan which is now known as Barangay Sta. Mercedes in Maragondon, that was also a priority barangay under the National Intelligence Coordinating Agency (NICA) in 2019.

A land dispute between the residents and a private corporation caused the relocation of half of the residents with the relocation area lacking in electricity, thus the launching of TOTS project.

Likewise, partner agencies in the PRLEC, such as Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) shall be providing training seminars for Cooperative organization and entrepreneural skills, among others.
