DENR Calabarzon recognizes private sector's role in advancing environmental causes

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna (PIA) — The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) IV-A continues mobilizing the private sector to help the government in its re-greening, reforestation, and cleanup efforts.

In an interview during the Usapang PIA radio program, DENR IV-A Regional Executive Director Nilo Tamera said that they recognize the corporate social responsibility of the private sector in the region in protecting the environment by conducting sustainable environmental programs.

According to Tamera, they have signed numerous memorandum of agreements with companies to adopt the National Greening Program sites piloted by the department and to be monitored and sustained by the private sector for years to come.

He also believes that the reforestation, tree planting activities, and clean-up drives being organized by various organizations in the region would help the government in minimizing the effects of climate change and global warming.

Tamera said: "Sa ating mga kaba-

bayan, huwag po nating hayaan na ang responsibilidad na para masawata ang (climate change) ay sa pamahalaan lamang. The regional executive also pointed out that public-private part-

nership and participation has become more essential since the changes in the environment affect everyone.

"In-encourage ko po ang lahat na sana lumawak ang ganitong adbokasiya, at ganitong process. Ang environmental conservation protection and development ay maging bahagi na po ng ating pang-araw araw na buhay natin kasi kagaya ng sinasabi namin palagi, Ikaw, Ako, Tayo ang Kalikasan. Ang ating laban para sa kapaligiran at likas na yaman ay laban natin para sa buhay," he added.

The Commission on Elections (Comelec) on Tuesday started the delivery of poll paraphernalia and other supplies to be used in the special elections in the seventh legislative district of Cavite province on Feb. 25.

"Election forms, supplies, and paraphernalia, including official ballots, as well as all automated elections system-related equipment will already be deployed to the provincial hub," said Comelec spokesperson John Rex Laudiano in a statement.

He added that the deployment of poll supplies will run until Friday.

The special polls were set to elect the new representative of the district after then congressman Jesus Crispin

Remulla was appointed as Justice Secretary.

Meanwhile, the poll body official reported that as of Tuesday, the deliveries to the municipality of Tanza have been finished.

"As of 11:23 a.m., February 14, 2023, deliveries to the Municipal Treasurer of all election forms, supplies and paraphernalia, including official ballots for the Municipality of Tanza had been completed," he said.

In a news release on
Tuesday, Senator Sher-
win Gatchalian cited the
report “Disrupting Harm
in the Philippines” of the
United Nations Interna-
tional Children's Emer-
gency Fund that showed
online sexual abuse and
exploitation of children
(OSAEC) among 20 per-
cent of internet users
aged 12 to 17 in 2021.

The study had
950 respondents.

“When scaled to
the size of the popula-
tion, it is revealed that up
to two million were sub-
jected to these harms,”
Gatchalian said.

In the 2022 Traf-
ficking in Persons Re-
port by the United States
State Department, the
Philippines retained its
Tier 1 Status, or meeting
just the minimum stan-
dards for the elimination
of trafficking. The re-
port identified persisting
needs, such as addition-
al personnel and training
on handling digital evi-
dence, and recommend-
ed increased support
for programs providing
specialized care for traf-

ficking victims, including
victims of OSAEC.

“Cracking down
on child traffickers entails
effective enforcement of
laws that took effect last
year,” Gatchalian said,
citing the Expanded An-
ti-Trafficking in Persons
Act of 2022 (Republic
Act No. 11862) and the
Anti-OSAEC and An-
ti-Child Sexual Abuse
or Exploitation Materials
Act (CSAEM or Republic
Act No. 11930) which he
both co-authored.

The Expanded
Anti-Trafficking in Per-
sons Act gives law en-
forcers additional tools to
pursue human traffickers
both online and offline.

Under the law,
internet intermediaries
such as social media
networks and financial
intermediaries will be li-
able for allowing the use
of their platforms for traf-
ficking.

The Anti-OSAEC
and Anti-CSAEM Act
also gives law enforcers
additional tools for the
surveillance and investi-
gation of OSAEC cases.

It increases the
responsibilities of social
media platforms, elec-
tronic service providers,
and financial intermedi-
aries, among others, to
block CSAEM materials
and cooperate with law
enforcers.

“Tungkulin natin

fall between 6 p.m. and 6
a.m. of the following day.
The premium is also
granted to incumbents of
Division Chief positions
and below or their equiv-
alent, who are designat-
ed as Officers-in-Charge
to executive/managerial
positions when they are
still bound to observe
the work hours between
6 p.m. and 6 a.m. of the
following day.

However, the
law does not cover gov-
ernment employees with
regular work schedule
falling between 6 a.m.
and 6 p.m.; those whose
services are required,
or are on call, 24 hours
a day, such as the uni-
formed personnel and

others as may be deter-
mined by the CSC and
the Department of Bud-
get and Management
(DBM); and workers un-
der job order or contract
of service.

The night shift
differential pay shall be
at a rate not exceeding
20 percent of the hourly
basic rate of the employ-
ee, as authorized by the
head of agency. In the
case of public health
workers, the rate shall
not be lower than 10 per-
cent of their hourly basic
rate. The amount neces-
sary for the initial imple-
mentation of the law and
rules shall be charged
against the existing ap-
propriations in case of

national government
agencies; for local gov-
ernment units, from their
respective funds subject
to the provisions of Sec-
tions 325 and 331 of the
Local Government Code
of 1991; and for GOCCs
and their subsidiaries,
from their respective cor-
porate funds.

CSC Chairper-
son Karlo Nograles said
that the law granting
night shift differential
pay is a much-deserved
additional benefit for em-
ployees who are relied
upon to keep govern-
ment operations running
24/7. “Malaki ang pas-
asalamat natin sa ating
mga medical personnel,
air traffic controllers, mga

nasa immigration, cus-
toms, emergency com-
munications, at marami
pang iba na nagta-tra-
baho sa night shift. Sila
ang mga lingkod bayan,
o lingkod bayani, na
sumisigurong tuluy-tuloy
ang pagbibigay ng ser-
bisyo ng pamahalaan,
mapa-araw man o gabi.”

He also thanked
the DBM for working with
the CSC in the crafting of
the IRR. “Alinsunod sa
isinasaad ng R.A. 11701,
naging katuwang po na-
tin ang DBM sa pagbuo
nitong IRR. I thank Sec-
retary Amenah Pangan-
daman and her team for
their relentless coopera-

CSC ISSUES RULES ON NIGHT SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL PAY FOR GOV'T WORKERS

The Civil Service Commission (CSC) promulgated the implementing rules and regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 11701, which grants night shift differential pay to government employees.

The law grants compensation premium to government employees, including those in government-owned or controlled corporations (GOCCs), who are occupying the positions/items of Division Chief and below or their equivalent, regardless of the status of their appointment, whose official working hours
