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DILG IV-A FINISHES ITS PROVINCIAL ROLL-OUT OF THE RLIP PROGRAM

DILG IV-A successfully finishes its roll-out activity of RLIP (Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation of LGU Infrastructure Projects) to all the five provinces in the region.

The roll-out started last July 29, 2022, in the Province of Quezon, followed by the Province of Batangas and Laguna last August 3, Cavite and Rizal last August 4, and HUC Lucena last August 5, 2022.

This activity aims to inform all LGUs, DILG Field Officers, and Provincial Offices about the implementation of RLIP, including its guidelines, needed forms, and encoding process in the Subay-BAYAN-RLIP portal.

In line with the Republic Act No. 11639 or the FY 2022 General Appropriations Act (GAA), DILG launched the RLIP program to monitor and evaluate LGU infrastructure projects funded under the 20% Development Fund.

Moreover, present during the activities were representatives from different LGUs, Provincial Offices, and DILG Regional Office IV-A, who will work hand-in-hand to implement this program successfully in CALABARZON.

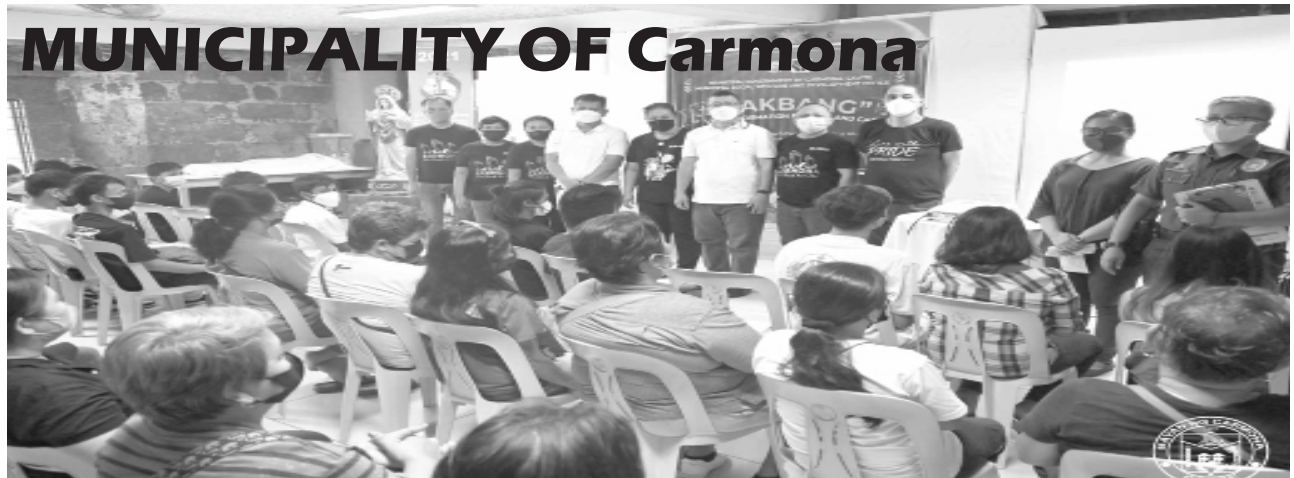

19 drug suspects busted in Rizal, Cavite provinces

LUCENA CITY—Police arrested 19 alleged drug pushers and seized more than P656,000 worth of shabu (crystal meth) in buy-bust operations Wednesday

and Thursday in Rizal and Cavite provinces. The Region 4-A police reported that anti-narcotics agents in Taytay, Rizal collared at 3:10 a.m. on August 11, Joselito King

and Nelson Porlaza in Barangay Sta. Ana. The authorities confiscated nine sachets of meth weighing 44 grams with a Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) value of P299,200 and a motorcycle believed to be used by the suspects in their illegal drugs trade.

At Barangay 40 in Cavite City, anti-illegal drug operatives nabbed at 7:05 p.m. on August 10 Jimel Lucasan, Mick Enrique Mateo, and Rommel Saquilayan.

The trio yielded six sachets of shabu with a DDB value of P170,000. At H-2 village in Dasmarinas City, the police busted around 10 p.m. Randy Alcaraz, Angelito

Namangcayao, Sadam Adin, and Ricky Trinidad. Seized from them were five sachets of meth worth P69,000 as per DDB valuation.

On Wednesday night, Bacoor City police arrested Antonio Sanchez, E.R John Acojido, Sotero Balais, Janine Elarmo, Angelo Alforte, Jerome Estocado, Joselito Cabarne, Ibnes Miyu, Michelle Talbo, and Armando Balidio in two operations.

The cops recovered P118,000 worth of shabu from the suspects. All suspects were detained and face charges of violating the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002.

equipped with several computer/laptops, projectors, servers and other IT equipment. The Center is also venue for ICT diagnostic examinations, International Computer Driving License Examinations and for provision of Digital Literacy and Capacity Building Activities. The Center has already served 180 clients/visitors as of July when it reopened after Covid restrictions. It was recommended for DICT to partner with other government agencies and solicit ICT donations to cater to their expanding centers and beneficiaries.

The Sangley Airport

being a military airport, is also being used for civil aviation after the completion of Phase I development. The airport registers 407 flights of military and cargo traffic per week. The Phase II development has just started in March 2022. It involves the construction of two-units hangar, two-units pump station, staff house, site development of airstrip including embankment, drainage, relocation and reclamation works. Target completion of the project is in May 2023. Project implementation issues include the delayed demolition of six existing structures of the Philippine Air Force in the airport premises.

The Philippine Rural Development Program (PRDP) sub-projects in Laguna are among the projects that were completed on time and exhibited good practices in project implementation. The 7.17 kilometers farm-to-market road (FMR) in Sta. Maria, Laguna is the longest

PRDP road project in the Region. The concreted road benefited six barangays that cater to rice and vegetable production. Meanwhile, the Level II Potable Water System in Cavinti, Laguna was the first PRDP project completed in the Region under the Original Financing. These two projects were efficiently implemented due to organized Municipal Project Management and Implementing Unit, close coordination between the concerned LGUs and project contractors, and timely resolution of project issues.

launched an OBE Command Center, where parents, teachers, and other sectors may raise their queries or concerns about the upcoming in-person learning.

"The department cannot do it alone, even with our partner agencies, the government can't do it alone, humihingi rin tayong tulong and cooperation sa mga parents para masigurong natin ang ligtas na balik-aral ng ating learners (we are asking for the help and cooperation of parents for us to make sure learners' safe back to school)," Poa said.

Safe learning spaces

The Department of Health (DOH) also insisted that vaccination plus adherence to minimum health protocols are the best way to be safe from the threat of Covid-19.

The plan of DepEd and DOH is to come up with a joint memorandum on vaccination and health protocols for safe in-person learning, where provisions on counseling and mobile vaccinations in schools will be specified.

Densing said the budget has also been allotted for face masks reserved for learners who might need these in schools.

The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) also assured they are just waiting for the approval of the budget to build additional classrooms to address possible overcrowding in some schools.

Besides ensuring safe spaces against Covid-19 risks, the Philippine National Police and the Department of Transportation also vowed to closely monitor public peace and order, as well as transportation availability.

The DepEd expects the majority of public schools to conduct face-to-face learning even before the mandatory in-person set up on November 2.

"Out of the more than 47,000 public schools, we expect that at least 90 percent will already be doing face-to-face. In the prior year, our experience is that 76 percent of all public

To date, the DepEd has only 37,000 teachers who are not yet inoculated against Covid-19, with around 20,000 of them expressing their willingness to get vaccinated.

Since the DepEd emphasized that there would be no discrimination against unvaccinated teachers, learners, and non-teaching personnel, the DOH said proper ventilation and staggered lunch breaks will be helpful.

DepEd Undersecretary and Chief-of-staff Epimaco Densing III also said the sanitary materials will be available on the school grounds.

"Yung mga panlinis ng kamay, sabon, alcohol, ay nandun po sa mga classroom (For handwashing, soap, and alcohol in the classrooms), we will be providing that. In fact, we have already downloaded additional MOOEs to our schools," he said.

The projects inspected are as follows: a) Batangas Port; b) Technology Empowerment for Education, Employment, Entrepreneurship, and Economic Development (TECH4ED) Project; c) Sangley Airport Development Project; and d) Philippine Rural Development Program sub-projects in Sta. Maria and Cavinti, Laguna.

The said projects were selected for field inspection to validate their physical accomplishments and good practices in project implementation. The implementing agencies include the Philippine Ports Authority Batangas, Department of Transportation, Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, Department of Information and Com-

munications Region IV-A and Department of Education Region IV-A.

The passenger terminal building (PTB) of Batangas Port was recently renovated through its port operator, Asian Terminals Incorporated. The PTB is a 600-square meter port passenger facility that can accommodate 4,000 passengers. It was considered as one

of the country's biggest passenger terminal. On the other hand, the monitoring team recommended to promote future developments for Phases 2 and 3 for the Batangas Port Container Terminal. Other recommendations include the implementation of online one-ticketing system and Park and Sail, and maximize the use of Batangas Live-

hood Center located at the port facility.

The Tech4Ed Project is a self-sustaining, shared facility providing access to ICT enabled services and relevant content to unserved and underserved communities. The TECH4ED Center of DICT in Batangas City is

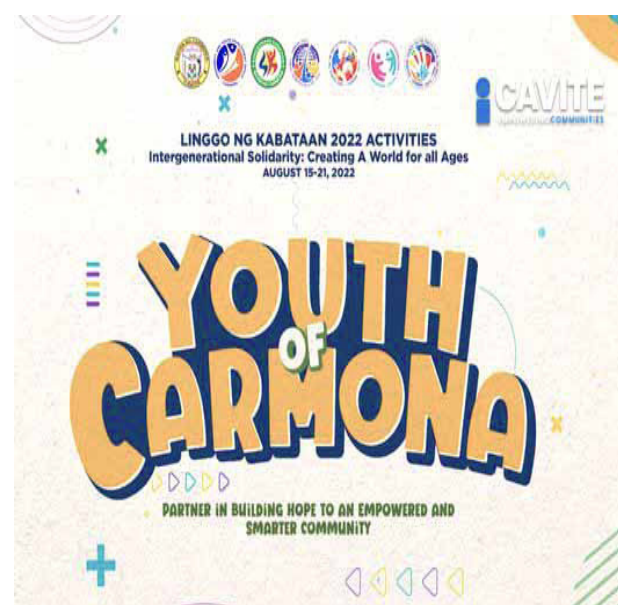


CARMONA-The Carmona Municipal Health Office successfully launched its HIV counseling and testing project last Wednesday, August 10.
