

# PTRI to establish more bamboo textile fiber innovation hubs

The Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) will establish at least three more Bamboo Textile Fiber Innovation Hub (BTFIH) until 2024, adding to the current three hubs, its chief said Friday, May 19.

PTRI officer in charge Julius Leaño said one would be launched in Lagangilang, Abra this year.

In 2024, PTRI will establish a BTFIH in Maramag, Bukidnon and another in Pangasinan, but Leaño said they have yet to determine which town.

The latest was launched in Maragondon, Cavite on May 3, while the first two are located in Naguilian, La

Union and Cauayan, Isabela.

Leaño said bamboo fibers could be used for clothing and home textile.

For nonwovens, this could be used for shoes, bags, and acoustic insulation, among others.

"Bamboo has at least 35 percent textile fiber recovery compared to other sources of fiber, which barely have only 2

### CSG ATTENDS AND RAISED CONCERNS ON INDANG SB'S ORDINANCE SEEKING REVISION OF TRICYCLE FARES



Represented by CSG VP Regine Terrenal, the CSG attended the public hearing presided by Councilor Ronald Bernarte to discuss the possible increase in tricycle fares in the municipality on May 18.

The lady Vice President reiterated that the implementation must be pro-commuters and urges the officials to ensure that fare matrix would be installed in all tricycles in Indang.

The CSG also conveyed its concern to the proposed increase but understands that this is inline with the increasing prices of goods in the country. But, the CSG strongly opposed the 10-15php increase in the fares.

VP Terrenal also cleared to the SB Members that student discount must still be implemented on holidays, weekends, and on class suspensions, given that there are still student activities on weekends. The officials have ensured that as long as the students have their student ID as proof, they can avail the discount.

Lastly, VP Terrenal manifested directed to PNP Indang to strengthen police visibility at night to ensure safety of Kabsuhenyos.

# PH has still more untapped gas fields enough to meet needs – DOE

The Philippines has still many potential gas fields that remain unexplored to provide for the energy requirements of the country, an official of the Department of Energy (DOE) said on Saturday. Undersecretary Sandy Sales of DOE's Energy Resource Development and Oil Management said the country's oil and gas exploration is still open to interested investors to tap these potential power sources.

"Marami pang mga lugar, hindi lang po Malampaya, ang may-

roong mga potential para sa malalaking gas deposit," Sales told a news forum in Quezon City. Sales, however, noted a case pending before the Supreme Court regarding the issue of income tax involving the Malampaya gas project which discouraged potential investors.

"Ito iyong kaso ng income tax ng mga service contractor. Hanggang ngayon, hindi pa ito nare-resolve at nagiging malaking 'overhang' sa mga potential investors," Sales said.

The taxation issue of upstream petroleum investors spawned from an interpretation by the Commission on Audit (COA) that the income tax payment of the Malampaya consortium should not have been charged as part of the 60 percent royalty share of the Philippine government.

The consortium is currently composed of Prime Energy Resources Development, UC38 LLC, and PNOC Exploration Corp.

Sales said the government is supportive

of upstream exploration and production of oil and gas despite the country's full commitment to decarbonization.

"The path to decarbonization ay hindi iisa. What works for other jurisdictions does not necessarily apply to the Philippines," Sales said.

"Sa ibang lugar, sinasabi nila na kailangang isara ang coal plant. Iyon ang kanilang path. Pero sa atin, pareho tayo ng gustong puntahan pero iba ang ating tatahaking landas. Kasi iba ang sit-

percent. It is abundant and robust across the country and it is a sustainable textile fiber source," he told the Philippine News Agency (PNA).

Having a BTFIH, he said, enables a community to process bamboo into raw bamboo textile fiber (BTF) and eventually make this ready for textile processing.

"The technologies are simple, deployable, and scalable. The machines can also be fabricated locally for more massive and extensive deployment," Leaño said.

The raw BTF is priced at about PHP250 per kg., compared to about PHP10 per kg. of bamboo, he said, adding that the BTFIH would enable more material transformation and value addition.

Meanwhile, according to PTRI, the BTFIH Cavite would ensure that bamboo textile fibers would be available for subsequent processes to produce textiles.

"The PTRI will use these fibers to spin yarns that will be available for use by the weavers of Maragondon, Cavite," it said.

The hub was also funded by the Philippine Council for Agriculture, Aquatic and Natural Resources Research and Development through the project, "Field Verification of the Bamboo Textile Material Production and Treatment Technology."/source: (PNA)

During last year's presidential election, only 626,000 out of the 1.6-million registered overseas absentee voters were able to cast their ballots--equivalent to only 39 percent voter's turnout.

Comelec Chairman George Erwin Garcia in a statement released on Wednesday said there is no need for a new law to authorize internet voting for registered overseas absentee voters, since the poll body "promulgate rules and regulations and consequently, implement other means of overseas voting that are more reliable, secure, and efficient."

During the 18th Congress in January 2021, it was

Tolentino who first appealed to the poll body to devise a more convenient way for OFWs--Filipino seafarers in particular--to exercise their respective voting rights. The senator then noted that Filipino seafarers have been deprived of their right to vote in the past elections since they are at sea most of the time.

While the current process allows seafarers to vote by going to the nearest embassy or consular post during the 30-day voting period, Tolentino stressed that most seafarers are at sea for six months, which is the usual duration of their respective contracts.

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. recently signed the renewal of Service Contract (SC) No. 38 for the Malampaya Deep Water Gas-to-Power Project.

Sales said to produce the remaining gas reserve after 2024, the government has to sign the contract renewal for the said project.

"It's about 80 to 140 BCF (billion cubic feet) that would have been stranded if the contract was not renewed. In the renewal agreement, it is also required that the consortium conduct near field appraisal and development. This is to add reserves and increase the production of the Malampaya field," he said.

"Initially, based on technical review, potentially there is an additional 210 BCF that can be developed close to the existing Malampaya field. So this would require drilling of wells and substantial subsea work to tie back the new production wells into the existing Malampaya production facilities. So this is a firm commitment as part of the renewal agreement," the DOE official pointed out.

The Malampaya Project is seen to reduce the country's dependence on oil imports and ensure a more stable supply of cleaner energy from an indigenous source./ (PND)
