

# PREVENT COVID-19 VARIANTS, GET VACCINATED – DOH CALABARZON

The Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) again urged residents to get their Covid-19 shots in order to have additional protection against the various variants of the virus, especially the Delta which is the variant of concern because of its ability to spread faster and twice contagious than the original virus.

"The Delta variant is now the dominant

strain and it is best for everyone to get their Covid shots now as it has been proven that vaccines are highly effective in preventing severe illness and even death and it is our best defense against the virus," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo said.

"Let us do our part and put an end to this pandemic. For those who haven't got their vaccine, get your jab now and encourage your friends and family to do the same.

Unvaccinated people are more at risk than those who receive their shots." As of October 7, 2021, there are already a total of 7,202,685 individuals vaccinated in 598 active vaccination sites in various provinces.

**MANILA – Police and military personnel seized a cache of bomb-making materials in a joint operation in General Trias City, Cavite on Thursday Oct. 14.**

Citing reports from the Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG), Philippine National Police (PNP) chief, Gen. Guillermo Eleazar on Friday identified the suspects as Charlito Tenorio and Jay-Ar Suson, who were arrested in separate operations.

Tenorio was arrested in a buy-bust in Barangay Bacao 2, General Trias City, Cavite at 12:30 p.m. while Suson, the alleged mastermind, was arrested in a follow-up operation in Tayabas, Quezon at 5:30 p.m.

Tenorio yielded 750 kilograms of ammonium nitrate contained in 30 25-kilogram sacks and 1,000 improvised blasting caps, all loaded in a commuter van.

CIDG director, Maj. Gen. Albert Ignatius Ferro said the components of the confiscated explosives worth PHP200,000 were being negotiated for sale by the suspects.

Eleazar instructed Ferro to dig deeper into the activities of the suspects to identify all persons involved in their operations as well as their clients.

He added that these types of explosive materials are "commonly used for industrial purposes", but can also be used as components for improvised explosive devices.

"With this successful operation, we



The Lord is Coming, Today  
Wednesday, October 20, 2021

Jesus said to his disciples: “Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour when the thief was coming, he would not have let his house be broken into. You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come.” Luke 12:39-40

These words from Jesus should cause us to sit up and take notice. This parable, followed by the rest of today's Gospel, exhorts us to always be prepared for our particular judgment at the conclusion of our earthly life. There are various reasons these words should be heeded.

First of all, the obvious reason is that life for any of us could end at any time. We only need to recall various tragedies in which people have suddenly died from a car accident or from some other unexpected reason. Furthermore, there truly will be a specific moment in time when our Lord does return to earth for the Final Judgment. That moment will take place in an instant without any warning. It's easy to presume that this end of the world when our Lord “comes to judge the living and the dead” will not happen for hundreds or perhaps even thousands of years. But the simple truth is that it could be at any time, when those who are alive least expect it.

With that said, there is another important reason to always be prepared and ready to meet our Lord for our particular judgment. Even though our particular judgment will take place in a definitive way at the end of our life when we see our Lord face-to-face, we also encounter Him every day, all day, receiving daily rewards for our fidelity or judgment for our sins. It is useful to see this “hour you do not expect” as every moment of every day. If you can live every day with this ongoing expectation that our Lord is coming to you, today, then every moment can be turned into a moment of much grace.

Think about your day today. Does God want to come to you, to inspire you and to lead you to fulfill His holy mission today? Indeed He does. He has a specific mission for you today that will not be there tomorrow. He wants you to be aware of His presence right now so that you can respond to Him with much generosity.

Reflect, today, upon the importance of always being vigilant and attentive to God's presence in your life. He wishes to speak to you, day and night, so as to guide you into a life of true holiness. If you can build a habit of attentiveness to His continual comings, then you will truly be prepared for that final coming when you meet our Lord face-to-face.

My ever-present Lord, You do come to me day and night, speaking to me, inspiring me, and leading me. Please fill me with the gift of holy vigilance so that I will always be prepared to meet You and hear Your holy voice. May I learn to build a habit of responding to You always. And may I especially be prepared for that glorious moment when I am blessed to see You face-to-face. Jesus, I trust in You.

Pension loan, retirement benefit modules added in SSS portal



MANILA – The Social Security System (SSS) added the Pension Loan Program (PLP) and Retirement Benefit Modules in the ExpreSSS e-Learning (ExSSSeL) portal last June and September 2021, respectively, where 1.8 million retirement pensioners can access a more detailed information about the programs.

“We know the vulnerability of our pensioners to the Covid-19 (coronavirus disease 2019) virus. This is why the SSS gave them an opportunity to pursue an additional e-learning experience at the comfort of their homes, anytime and anywhere. With the flexible schedule, ExSSSeL portal will help our pensioners to gain more knowledge about SSS at their own pace and time. They can access it 24 hours a day, seven days a week. They can also take the exam to assess their understanding, which makes it a more enjoyable and rewarding activity,” SSS president and chief executive officer Aurora Ignacio said in a statement.

ExSSSeL is an online computer-based training about various SSS programs which was initially launched last November 2020 that aims to educate members, employers, and the general public through SSS module-based learnings. They can study these modules at their own convenience for free.

ExSSSeL portal can be done by these simple steps: select a module, register online, study the module, take the post examination, and lastly, wait for their e-certificates.

In selecting a module, members and interested individuals can choose from: Module 1 (Sickness), Module 2 (Maternity), Module 3 (Unemployment), Module 4 (Disability), Module 5 (Salary Loan), Module 6 (Pension Loan Program)and Module 7 (Retirement).

Users can also open multiple modules simultaneously. Members and other individuals can go to [http://bit.ly/ExSSSeL\\_Portal](http://bit.ly/ExSSSeL_Portal) to register.

After selecting a module, they will receive an online registration form via Google form for them to fill out.

However, portal users must be reminded that they can only get their e-certificate after obtaining a passing rate of at least 80 percent after the post-examination.

The e-certificate will be sent to their registered e-mail address within seven working days from the time the participant took the post examination and submitted the evaluation form.

As of Aug. 31, 2021, SSS issued a total of 9,643 e-certificates to ExSSSeL users who have successfully completed at least one module available in the portal.

Sickness Benefit is the most viewed Module with 15,413, followed by Maternity Benefit Module with 9,255 views.

“For those who already accessed the ExSSSeL portal, we are grateful to your support to our online learning portal and rest assured that we'll include another set of modules soon. We also encourage the rest of the learning enthusiasts, especially our members, pensioners, and employers, to explore the ExSSSeL Portal to be fully knowledgeable on the SSS benefits and privileges,” Ignacio said.



"Allow me to express my congratulations and appreciation to the Philippine Postal Corporation for issuing a series of special stamps entitled 'Salamat: Pagpupugay sa mga Alamat'. It is, however, an even greater honor to be included in the list of people who have been chosen by your esteemed corporation to be considered legends of our time. Let me express my profound gratitude for this great honor," Jaworski said as relayed by his son, who was part of the Ginebra lineup during his final playing years during the mid-90s.

The unveiling of the new stamps is part of PHLPPost's tribute to Philippine sports heroes as the agency celebrates the 75th anniversary of the issuance of the first mail stamp in the Philippines.

PHLPPost previously released a set of special stamps celebrating the successful Philippine team campaign during the Tokyo Olympics with gold medalist Hidilyn Diaz, silver medalists Nesthy Petecio and Carlo Paalam, and bronze medalist Eumir Marcial in the stamps.

This time, PHLPost expanded its tribute to Philippine sports heroes by adding Jaworski, who before steering the Tamaraws and the Gin Kings to multiple pro league titles was a vital member of the UE Red Warriors squad that won seven straight UAAP titles during the '60s and also a part of the national team.

"Never did I ever imagine that I would be put in the stamp of our beloved republic," Jaworski's statement added.

The 75-year-old PBA legend, who became a senator from 1998-2004 following his basketball retirement, could not be in attendance as he is recovering from a rare blood illness as Dodot revealed in an interview with Anthony Taberna.

"How I wish I could be there present with all of you today to personally thank you for this wonderful privilege and honor," Jaworski rued as his son further relayed.

Dodot, who would enter the political arena as well when he became a congressman in Pasig, then called for his father's fans to continue praying for his health to become better.

"We continue to ask for people to pray that he will get stronger and he will be back to his normal self soon," the younger Jaworski said.



In fact, 5,000-6,500 jabs we give every day hit because of the continuous increase in confidence of the Imuseño and the tireless efforts of our health care workers.

With improved numbers, we expect herd immunity in Imus by the end of November.

Marawi City in Lanao del Sur, President Duterte expressed hope that with the support of the public, the nation will overcome any challenge that may test its strength and the unity of its people.

“Let us therefore continue working as one to secure a better, safer, and more prosperous future for all of Marawi,” he said.

At the same time, he recognized the sacrifice and bravery of soldiers and police personnel who fought for several months to defeat Islamic State-linked Maute terrorist group who occupied the city.

“Let me again give recognition to our soldiers and police personnel, and local constituency for their bravery, sacrifice, and determination in defending and liberating Marawi City after five months of battle,” the President said. “I pray to God that it will never happen ever, ever again.”

The government, he stressed, is doing its best to expedite the completion of rehabilitation projects at the soonest possible time, noting it is committed to bring back the city's glory.

“And we will continue to foster cooperation among concerned stakeholders so that Marawi will be able to build back better and stronger,” he

said.

The chief executive also commended the hard work of the Task Force Bangon Marawi to accomplish the programs under the Bangon Marawi Comprehensive Rehabilitation and Recovery Program.

He pointed out that by rebuilding the lives of the displaced families, restoring damaged properties, and revitalizing disrupted socio-economic activities, the task force stayed true to its commitment as agents of progress and catalysts for real change.

Also during the event, President Duterte witnessed the distribution of Certificates of Title for permanent housing units from the National Housing Authority (NHA) and turnover of financial assistance from the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), among others.

He also inspected the newly constructed Jameo Mindanao Al-Islamie or the Grand Mosque, considered the biggest house of worship in Marawi City.

After announcing the liberation of the city from terrorism on October 17, 2017, the President issued Administrative Order No. 3 and created the Task Force Bangon Marawi (TFBM) to start reconstruction efforts.
