# GCQ in NCR extended ; Cavite, Laguna and Rizal in Region 4-A under GCQ with heightened restrictions

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte on Monday, June 14, 2021, approved the extension of the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) classification of the National Capital Region and Bulacan from June 16 to June 30, 2021. Some restrictions shall, however, be observed and applied in the abovementioned areas.

The IATF also placed the provinces of Laguna, Cavite, and Rizal in Region 4-A under GCQ with heightened restrictions from June 16 to June 30, 2021.

Other areas under GCQ from June 16 to June 30, 2021 are Baguio City, Kalinga, Mountain Province, Abra, and Benguet in the Cordillera Administrative

Region; Isabela, Nueva Vizcaya, and Quirino in Region 2; Batangas and Quezon in Region 4-A; Iligan City in Region 10; Davao del Norte in Region 11; General Santos City, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Cotabato, and South Cotabato in Region 12; and Lanao del Sur and Cotabato City in BARMM.

areas that shall be placed under the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) from June 16 to June 30, 2021 are the City of Santiago and Cagayan in Region 2; Apayao and Ifugao in the Cordillera Administrative Region; Bataan in Region 3; Lucena City in Region 4-A; Puerto Princesa in Region 4-B; Naga City in Region 5; Iloilo

City and Iloilo in Region 6; Negros Oriental in Region 7; Zamboanga City, Zamboanga Sibugay, Zamboanga del Sur, and Zamboanga del Norte in Region 9; Cagayan de Oro City in Region 10; Davao City in Region 11; and Butuan City, Agusan del Sur, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Sur in CARAGA.

All other areas shall be placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) starting June 16

**DASMARIÑAS--** The vaccine against COVID-19 has reached 38,848 residents from A1 to A3 Priority Group this month. Out of such number, 13,408 here have completed two doses of vaccine. Based on local government inventory, 740 doses of Astrazeneca vaccine and 2,243 doses of Sinovac vaccine are prepared for scheduled vaccinations at four vaccination sites in the city. Current members of A1 (healthcare worker), A2 (senior citizen), and A3 (persons with comorbidity) group are given priority to vaccination by the local government.

## KonsultaMD to widen reach as demand for telehealth rises

**MANILA –** Recognizing the rise in the demand for telemedicine, especially amidst the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) pandemic, telehealth service KonsultaMD announced Wednesday its plan to expand the app's accessibility to the public.

Access to KonsultaMD app can be availed at gas stations, malls, and also bundled with other brands soon, said KonsultaMD chief executive officer Cholo Tagaysay in a virtual presser.

"Don't be surprised if you see KonsultaMD in your next smartwatch," he remarked.

The KonsultaMD app offers 24/7 hotline or consultation with doctors. It is free among Globe post-

paid subscribers. Access can also be availed for as low as PHP60. Expanding where the access can be purchased would be for those who do not use digital payments.

KonsultaMD is among the 917Ventures' portfolio, which supports startups.

"Many people have been avoiding hospitals amid the pandemic," said 917Ventures managing director Vince Yamat in the same presser. With this, he noted that many have resorted to teleconsultation.

Consultations made through KonsultaMD have increased by 461 percent in 2020 compared to the previous year, 917Ventures reported. As such, Tagaysay said the platform

is hiring doctors every day to keep up with the demand.

Asked for his comment, Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Secretary Fortunato de la Peña also mentioned the importance of teleconsultation.

"Importante na ngayon ang telekonsulta. Lalo na sa mga pagkakataon tulad ngayon; lalo na sa mga nakatirang malayo sa doktor; sa mga may matalagalang sakit na hirap magbyahe ng pasyente (Teleconsultation is important, especially during this time. It is also important, especially for those whose residences are too far from the doctors, and for those who have lingering illnesses, and would be hard to be transported)," de la Peña told the Philippine News Agency.

The DOST, he said, had also launched telehealth projects. Among these include the RxBox biomedical device, which can capture medical signals

## CAVITE PNP's OVERNIGHT ANTI-CRIMINALITY OPS ARRESTED 42 AND 3,279 QUARANTINE VIOLATORS RECORDED

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City, Cavite- A total of 42 individuals were arrested and 3,279 GCQ were recorded on intensified overnight anti-criminality operations of Cavite Police on June 15.

Out of 15 buy bust operations conducted, 25 individuals were arrested in Dasmariñas City, Rosario, General Trias City, Cavite City, Bacoor City, Naic, GMA and Ternate, Cavite. Police confiscated a total of sixty two (62) pieces small heat sealed transparent plastic sachets containing white crystalline substance suspected as shabu, four (4) piece heat sealed transparent plastic sachets containing dried leaves suspected as marijuana, drug money and other drug paraphernalia.

In the campaign against wanted persons, four (4) persons were arrested by virtue of warrant to include Top 1 Most Wanted Person Manhunt Charlie- City Level for Violation of Special Protection of Children against Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act (Anti-Child Abuse Law) (5) B of RA 7610 in Tagaytay City. Three other wanted persons were arrested for Violation of Sec.11 Article II of RA 9165 in Kawit; for the crime of RIR in Damage to Property in General Trias City and for Violation of RA 9262 (Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children Act of 2004) docketed under CC no. B-2020-1335 in Bacoor City, Cavite.

In various cases, 13 individuals were arrested for Trespass in Dwelling Incident in Bacoor City; Physical Injuries and Alarm and Scandal (Indiscriminate Firing) in Imus City; Alarm and Scandal/

Drinking in Public Places in Rosario; Trespassing Incident in General Trias City; Alarm and Scandal in Dasmariñas City and Grave Threat and Violation of RA 10591 in Tanza, Cavite. In the implementation of Community Quarantine Protocols, a total of 3,279 were recorded comprising the following data; 383 of them violated no face masks, 503 wore improper face masks, 1,295 without face shields, 672 wore improper face shields, 27 violated the social distancing, and 399 violated the curfew hours. Cavite Police gave warning to 2,761 violators, 388 paid fines and 130 undergone community services.

# Trece Martires health workers get cash incentive for topping Chikiting Ligtas vax program

TRECE MARTIRES, Cavite – The city health care workers received a cash incentive last Wednesday (June 9) as a reward for topping the Department of Health’s Measles-Rubella Oral Polio Vaccine Supplemental Immunization Activity (MR OPV SIA) or Chikiting Ligtas.

A total of 125 health workers, including Barangay Health Workers (BHW) and Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), received P3,000 from the local government unit.

The City Health Office recorded 17,920



residents vaccinated against polio and 15,146 individuals inoculated against measles and rubella under the initiative.

In a Facebook post, Mayor Gemma Buendia Lubigan said the city’s “health heroes” deserve the reward and

Pag-Asa program symbolizes the potential of a P10,000 cash aid “not as dole-out” but as an economic stimulus.

“Yun po ang gusto natin talaga. When you plant the seed at namunga, [sila] naman ang magtatanim sa iba. May transformation sa livelihood n’ya pati po sa puso n’ya,” he said, referring to del Rosario’s story.

(That’s what we really want to happen. When you plant the seed and it bears fruit in peo-

ple, they will be the ones who will plant the seed in others. There will be transformation not just in their livelihood but also in their hearts.)

“Isipin n’yo po, mula Aparri hanggang Jolo, kung lahat ng Pilipino may P10,000 eh ‘di lahat po ng sari-sari store, lahat ng karinderya [lalago],” he added.

(Just think of it: if every Filipino family from Aparri to Jolo has P10,000, then all variety stores and eateries will earn a lot

more.)

Leopoldo Salgado Jr., a performer from Cavite who also became a beneficiary of the program today, expressed his gratitude to Cayetano and the people behind the project.

“Maglalaan din ako kahit papaano sa puhunan kasi hindi pu-pwedeng ibayad mo lang nang ibayad kasi hindi din matatapos ‘yung problema,” he said.

(I will set aside some amount for capital because I can’t just use the money to pay my bills. That won’t solve my problems.)

Cayetano said he and his allies in Congress will keep trying to convince the Senate and the Executive Department to revise the cash assistance provision of Bayanihan 3 from P1,000 per person in two tranches to P10,000 per family.

“Even po ang ating leadership sa Congress ngayon ay agree na kumuha ng 200 billion at

saan kukunin para ibigay na ayuda. So ang good news po, ‘yung pong debate na lang ay is it 1,000 per person or is it 10,000 per family,” he said.

(Even our leadership in Congress now agrees with the allotment of P200 billion and where it will sourced from to give as assistance. So the good news is that the only thing we need to debate on is if the amount will be P1,000 per person or P10,000 per family.)

Cayetano was joined by Cavite 1st District Rep. Francis Gerald Abaya, Cavite 3rd District Rep. Alex Advincula, Cavite 6th District Rep. # Cayetano, allies' Sampung Libong Pag-Asa beneficiaries now over 2,000

June 13, 2021 Press Release

Fueled by the increasing number of previous beneficiaries coming forward to share their stories of renewed hope, former Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano and his allies last Friday (June 11) distributed P10,000 in cash assistance each to 500 new beneficiaries in Cavite under the Sampung Libong Pag-Asa program.

The beneficiaries came from at least eight different municipalities and cities in the province, all of whom were negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic in terms of livelihood.

Four hundred (400) of them were selected with the help of the local government, while the remaining 100 were chosen online.

The online entries were screened in real time based on their stories of struggles amid the ongoing crisis and verified through voice call.

From this group of beneficiaries, 10 online

viewers who commented on the "Ayuda Bayanihan Caravan" Facebook livestream held before the program as well as 2 frontliners who were visited at their homes during the pre-show, were given P10,000 in the first part of the program.

Together with the previous beneficiaries of the program from the other provinces and cities in the country, the P10,000 cash aid has helped a total of 2,048 families.

The "Sampung Libong Pag-Asa" campaign showcases a key part of Cayetano's economic recovery plan to assist Filipino families

with cash assistance to help them purchase their basic needs and revive their sources of income amid the ongoing pandemic.

Leni del Rosario, a vendor and a sari-sari store owner from Kawit, Cavite who had received P10,000 from a previous episode of the program, said she shared a portion of the cash aid with a neighbor who became a victim of a fire incident in their area.

"Iba na, pang kaya na — laban! Kasi medyo kumita na nang maayos, [naka-pagdagdag] ng aming konting appliances para pang-hanapbuhay," del Rosario said, thanking Cayetano and his group for the cash assistance.

(It's different now, I feel like we can make it! We earned a lit-



tle more because of the cash aid, and we were even able to buy a few more appliances for our livelihood.)
