DOH CALABARZON OPENS NEW FACILITIES AT STRH

Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) yesterday formally opened the new health facilities of the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital (STRH), one of the two apex hospitals of the region.

“When we renationalized STRH, we recognize the need for more health care services that will provide appropriate and effective health care services in the community. We also aspired to make it a development center for health in Cavite and later an academic and specialty training hospital in the region.” Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated in his message during the blessing and inauguration held at the STRH Compound in Bacoor, Cavite on October 8, 2020.

“And these developments and new facilities are just the start, ipapasok din natin dito ang mga specialty treatment services which will be cost effective sa ating mga kababayan dahil hindi na sila pupunta pa ng Manila para doon magpagamot kung available naman na dito,” he added.

He also revealed that the medical services of STRH will be joined together with those of Batangas Medical Center to complement and amplify the effectiveness of the health system, providing continuous availability of services from simple to critical conditions.

“We need to strengthen our hospital referral network systems to be able to respond efficiently to the health needs of the people.”

Among the newly opened hospital wards includes OB Covid ward, OB operating room, OB delivery room, respiratory ward, medical ICU and radiology.

A women and child protection unit and the Cavite healthcare provider network command center was also inaugurated including the telemedicine and teledentistry unit.

"Madaling mapakain ito dahil it's simple bread pero siksik sa nutrients dahil it is made of 50 percent flour and 50 percent squash puree," Doctor explained.

For its nutritional value, DOST Provincial Manager Arnold Santos attested that the enhanced nutribun has a new formulation and is made of natural, fresh squash.

"For every 169 grams of nutribun consumed, we can absorb 32 percent of calories needed by our body. It contains 264 grams of protein equivalent to 40 percent of what our body needs. It has six milligrams of iron equivalent to 40 percent and 223 milligrams of vitamin A which is equivalent to 60 percent of what our body needs," Santos told the Philippine Information Agency.

The healthy bread was also intended for the school-based feeding of the Department of Education and the supplemental feeding of the Department of Social Welfare and Development to help fight malnutrition.

Meanwhile, Provincial Director Natalia Dalaten of the Department of Trade and Industry said the collaboration of various agencies is a good linkage to promote the nutribun.

"Magandang i-link sa pamamagitan ng network ng iba't-bang ahensya ng pamahalaan because it's a good product. It's not just an ordinary bread because it sustains the nutritional value needed by our body and it is very affordable," Dalaten said.

For now, it can be bought at the 2nd floor of SM Center Dagupan as part of the Gawa'd Pangasinan Trade Fair and at the Nutridense facility in Brgy. Malanay, Sta. Barbara town.

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna – The Agricultural Training Institute in Calabarzon conducted a "Barangay Level Corn-Based Farming System" training, in coordination with the City Agriculture Office.

Among the participants of the face to face training are 32 corn farmers from barangays in Calamba City, namely, Alto, Mayapa, Buro, and Mapagong. Three additional farmers attended through a virtual platform.

datory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) Governing Board Chair Angelina Sandoval-Gutierrez were named JIB Chair and Vice Chair. Justices Callejo and Gutierrez will serve in the JIB for three years and two years, respectively. The JIB members are Court of Appeals Justice (Ret.) Sesonando Vilion, Sandiganbayan Justice (Ret.) Rodolfo Ponferrada, and Court of Tax Appeals Justice (Ret.) Cielito Mindaro-Grulla, who will serve for three years, two years, and one year, respectively.

They are expected to their take oath before the Chief Justice on October 19, 2020. Thereafter, they will be tasked to formulate the Internal Rules of the JIB which will be subject for approval by the SC En Banc.

Last July 7, the SC approved the proposed amendments to carry out the implementation of JIB, which will act on complaints against erring justices, judges, officers and employees of the Judiciary; On the other hand, the CPIO will conduct investigation on erring justices of the tertiary courts; and judges and personnel of the lower courts, including the Shari'a Courts; and the officials and employees of the Office of the Jurisconsult, Court Administrator, Deputy Court Administrator, Assistant Court Administrators and their personnel.

The reinvigoration of JIB and CPIO fulfills part

of Chief Justice Diosdado M. Peralta's Ten Point Program, which are to implement the JIB and strengthen the Office of the Court Administrator (OCA). The Ten Point Program can be narrowed down to four core areas — efficiency, integrity, security, and service.

During his first meeting with reporters covering the SC a few weeks after his appointment as the 26th Chief Justice in 2019, he renewed his commitment to continue purging the Judiciary of misfits and erring individual. He also reassured that he would strengthen OCA and implement JIB and forge a synergy between the functions of these offices through judicial audits, information gathering and sharing.

JIB and CPIO were created in 2018. However, these two separate units were put by the SC on the back burner as the Committee on the Implementation of the Judicial Integrity Board (CIJIB) called for a review of JIB's functions in order to harmonize and prevent duplicity with those of the OCA and other offices.

Hence, the Court resolved to approve the proposed amendments to Resolution in A.M. No. 18-01-05-SC dated October 2, 2018 and to Rule 140 of the Rules of Court, as amended.

JIB can receive administrative complaints or

disciplinary actions against either the Presiding Justices and Associate Justices of the appellate courts and Judges of the lower courts, as well as act on complaints or referrals as provided for in Rule 140 of the Rules of Court, the "Internal Rules" of the JIB as approved by the SC En Banc, as well as the SC Circulars, Administrative Orders or other issuances.

Likewise, JIB was given exclusive jurisdiction over administrative complaints against (1) Court officials with Salary Grades 30 and 31, excluding those that are not within the jurisdiction of the JIB, regardless of the gravity of the offense; (2) First and Second Level Court Judges, including Shari'a District and Circuit Court Judges, charged with serious charges under Rule 140 of the Rules of Court; and (3) Court officials and or employees, with Salary Grades 27 to 29, regardless of the gravity of the violation of the "Code of Conduct for Court Personnel" and of the Civil Service Law and Rules.

If upon a preliminary assessment and evaluation of administrative complaints against all judges, however, it found less serious charges and light charges under Rule 140 of the Rules of Court, the JIB may refer and delegate the investigation of those administrative complaints to OCA. (SCPIO)

that will authorize PDEA's destruction of seized illegal drugs.

Carreon noted that through Guevarra's intercession, the "handling prosecutors" of the pending drug cases will have the "concurrence" to assist PDEA to file the appropriate motions in various courts.

While some motions were filed, Carreon said that PDEA still needs the "concurrence to the motion to conduct ocular inspections, taking of representative samples" and eventual issuance of court orders for the destruction of the illegal drug cases that are pending in the courts.

The said cases include pending cases or those archived and under automatic review.

Earlier, Guevarra said the President's directive to immediately destroy seized illegal drugs was under the context of Sec. 21(4) of RA 9165, which requires the trial courts to conduct an ocular inspection of the illegal drugs and paraphernalia, within 72 hours from the filing of the criminal information.

Afterward, seized items have to be destroyed, through the PDEA, within 24 hours after the inspection.

Under the law, a representative sample of the seized drugs will be retained for use

during the trial of the case.

"Thus, law enforcement agents must file the criminal complaints immediately so that the destruction of the seized drugs could proceed as early as possible," Guevarra said.

Carreon said that law enforcement agencies are faced with huge challenges related to the destruction of illegal drugs under their custody as the "Wheels of Justice" allow the defense counsels to file motions that temporarily delay the issuance of court orders.

Even with these problems, Carreon said that PDEA has relentlessly coordinated with the Prosecutors' Offices and various courts to resolve the issue.

In July, the Supreme Court reminded all regional trial courts to "strictly comply" with the requirements of Section 21 (4) of Republic Act 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 on the immediate destruction of confiscated illegal drugs weighing five kilograms or more.

The law provides that "after the filing of the criminal case, the court shall, within 72 hours, conduct an ocular inspection" of the confiscated, seized illegal drugs or precursor chemicals, and "through the PDEA shall within 24 hours thereafter

proceed with the destruction or burning of the same", provided, that a representative sample, duly weighed and recorded is retained.

Carreon, meanwhile, stressed that PDEA's relentless campaign against illegal drugs led to more arrests, confiscation of huge volumes of illegal drugs, and destruction of numerous drug dens.

Due to the intense illegal drug campaign of PDEA and the other anti-narcotics agencies from July 31 to Aug. 31, 2020, Carreon said over 600 drug dens known as "one-stop-shops" or places where drug personalities can buy illegal drugs and use it have been dismantled.

Meanwhile, a total of 20,165 out of 42,045 villages were cleared of drugs nationwide, based on the Real Numbers PH data presented since July 2016 up to August 2020.

These barangays have reached drug-cleared status after the issuance of a certification by members of the Oversight Committee on Barangay Drug-Clearing Program.

The agency assured that the health and safety of its agents are prioritized in anti-drug operations.

However, 14,171 villages have yet to be cleared. (PNA)

ONE TON OF ILLEGAL DRUGS TO BE DESTROY ON OCT 15 IN TRECE-PDEA

MANILA – The Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) is set to destroy at least one ton of illegal drugs in Trece Martires City, Cavite this Thursday.

In a Laging Handa briefing on Monday, PDEA spokesperson Derrick Carreon said this is in compliance with the order of President Rodrigo Duterte to immediately destroy seized contraband to avoid recycling by unscrupulous individuals.

"Kasalukuyan ang ating paghahanda dahil sa Oct. 15 po, sa darating na Huwebes ay nakatakda po tayong magsunog ng at least one ton of dangerous drugs sa atin pong destruc-

tion site sa Trece Martires, Cavite (We are preparing for the destruction of at least one ton of dangerous drugs in our destruction site in Trece Martires City, Cavite on Oct. 15)," Carreon said.

He added that around 540.06 kilograms of shabu involved in pending and archived cases are being rushed to be included in the destruction.

At present, Carreon said that some 2.82 tons of illegal drugs worth PHP15.189 billion are still under the inventory of the PDEA Laboratory Service.

Carreon admitted that the agency is still faced with challenges in complying with the President's directive to destroy all confiscated illegal drugs due to legal impediments.

He added that PDEA chief Wilkins Villanueva has already brought up the matter to Justice Secretary Menardo Guevarra in order to speed up the issuance of court orders

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 304-2020

An Ordinance Amending Section 4 of Provincial Ordinance No. 166, Entitled "An Ordinance Prohibiting Excessive Noise from Videoke/Karaoke Systems and Other Amplified Audio Devices within the Residential Areas and Along Public Streets/Road Sides in the Province of Cavite and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof"

During the public health emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the operation/playing of videoke/karaoke system and other amplified audio devices shall only be allowed from 5:00PM to 8:00PM.

PENALTY:

First Offense - A verbal order to cease or abate the loud sounds generated from the videoke/karaoke system or other amplified audio device immediately.

Second Offense – A fine Php500.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the court.

Third Offense – A fine of Php1,000.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days or both at the discretion of the court

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
