and identity theft. As the first law signed by President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr., the SIM Registration Act aims to regulate the registration and use of SIMs by mandating all end-users to register their SIMs with their respective telecommunications networks before their activation. Abalos said the

implementation of the law will not only prompt accountability from all sides - the mobile users, the telcos, the government and authorities - but will also help the PNP to quickly locate offenders of crimes committed in anonymity through the use of electronic devices.

Section 4 of the IRR of the SIM Registration Act released by the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) provides that DILG, along with other government agencies such as DICT, NTC, DepEd, and telecom companies, shall "facilitate all SIM registrations tory (for businesses and in remote areas with limited telecommunication or internet access."

"Together with the LGUs, DILG will cooperate with DICT and the NCT to fast-track the establishment of registration facilities in geographically-isolated areas, which should be done within 60 days after Decem-
