importance of good oral hygiene and proper tooth brushing practices among the children.

In the opening re- marks, Mr. Leonardo Car- gullo, TCES District Su- pervisor, and Mrs. Reby Nuestro, TCES Principal, delightfully welcomed the dental team, convey- ing their genuine grati- tude for the time and effort they spent in extend- ing the services to their locality.

The program commenced with the talk

of Dr. Raymundo Par- nala, presenting brief oral health educa- tion and demonstrat- ing proper tooth brush- ing. He, then, inculcated the sig- nificance of brush- ing the teeth three times a day for a healthier smile.

Following was the distribution of dental kits to 40 school children by Cavite Public Health Dentists, conduct- ing an actual tooth brush- ing exercise as part of the cele-

BIR URGES TAX PAYERS: AVOID THE RUSH, PAY BEFORE APRIL 15...

TRECE MARTIRES CITY - Revenue District Office (RDO) No. 54-A of the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) is urging individual and corporate taxpayers to file and pay their 2023 Income Tax Returns (ITR) early or before the April 15 deadline. The Revenue District Officer of RDO No. 54-A stressed that the April 15 deadline which is Monday will not be extended, unless an announcement will be given before the said date. "We are advising our taxpayers not to wait for the last day to avoid the inconvenience of rushing and surcharges will be collected from late filers," the RDO explained. She added that individuals deriving income from the practice of professions like doctors are still required to file ITR.

She came out with the explanation to correct misconception that this groups of taxpayers need not file returns if the annual income does not reach the next tax exemption threshold of P250,000 as provided for in the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion (TRAIN) Law. The RDO pointed out that professionals, like businessmen, are required under the Tax Code to file ITRs regardless if they declare profit or loss. Otherwise,

they will be penalized for non-filing.

"Maraming taxpayers dito sa ating District. And I believe they are law abiding Citizens. Our taxpayers are cooperating naman, and they are paying taxes due to the government. This we know, because we continuously go out of our way to talk to them, inform and educate them about our tax laws, updates, and their obligation as good and productive citizens of our country. They are really supportive and cooperating in our campaign of our district office. Thank you po sa lahat ng ating taxpayers," The RDO said.

Centers program celebrates its 6th anniversary this February, Go's efforts have established 159 Malasakit Centers nationwide, assisting around ten million Filipinos, as the Department of Health reported.

As the chairperson of the Senate Committee on Health and Demography, Go also highlighted the critical role of Super Health Centers in alleviating hospital overcrowding, enabling early detection of diseases, and delivering essential healthcare services to communities, particularly in areas lacking sufficient medical facilities.

Through the collective efforts of the DOH, led by Dr. Teodoro "Ted" Herbosa, local government units, and fellow lawmakers, sufficient funds have been allocated under the DOH for the construction of more than 700 Super Health Centers for the years 2022 to 2024. In Cavite, 12 Super Health Centers were funded. Go, vice chairperson of the Senate Committee on Finance, has likewise supported various road improvements in the cities of Cavite, Dasmarinas, General Trias, Imus, and Tagaytay; rehabilitation and improvement of the municipal fire station in Noveleta; rehabilitation of covered courts in various barangays in General Trias City; acquisition of ambulance units for the local government of Indang and Trece Martires City; and improvement of a sports facility in Cavite State University in Indang.

Batangas governor targets expanded healthcare services

BATANGAS CITY – The provincial government here will expand free healthcare services as part of its flagship Health, Education, Livelihood and Protection (HELP) program.

In an interview on Tuesday, Batangas Gov. Hermilando Mandanas said the national government's existing health ini-

tiatives, such as Republic Act No. 11223 or the Universal Health Care Act and "Libreng Laboratoryo, Konsulta, at Gamot Para sa Lahat (LAB for ALL)," will be leveraged to bolster provincial efforts.

He said the provincial government is poised to hire more employees, purchase additional diagnostic equip-

ment and acquire new ambulance units for all district hospitals.

Additionally, Mandanas said his administration is expanding the delivery of more free medical services and free medicines to financially struggling Batangueños.

The governor admitted, however, that expanding healthcare services has been putting

a strain on the provincial government's coffers.

Mandanas made a case for the full implementation of the Supreme Court's Mandanas-Garcia ruling, which allocated more money to local government units (LGUs).

He emphasized that the landmark ruling was intended to strengthen financial decentralization by giving LGUs a

larger share of the taxes collected by national government agencies.

On Feb. 8, the governor inaugurated a new provincial healthcare facility in Bauan, intended to deliver services to the over 90,000 residents of this first-class municipality.

The new facility is equipped with laboratory services that cover

clinical microscopy, immunology and serology, complete blood count and blood chemistry, according to the Provincial Information Office.

During the same event, he said that the Lab for All caravan launched by First Lady Liza Araneta-Marcos in the province last year has been extremely helpful. source:(PNA)

Bong Go helps fire victims in Bacoor City and Kawit, Cavite as he calls for enhanced fire prevention awareness at the grassroots

Senator Christopher "Bong" Go, an adopted son of CALABARZON, emphasized the importance of improving fire prevention awareness in grassroots communities as he extended help to those affected by fire incidents in Kawit and Bacoor City, Cavite, on February 12 and 13.

Go's Malasakit Team performed relief operations at the Binakayan National High School Evacuation Center in Kawit and Barangay Aniban II covered court in Bacoor City. They aided a total of 124 households who received grocery packs, water containers,

snacks, vitamins, shirts, and balls for basketball and volleyball. There were also select recipients of a bicycle, a pair of shoes, and mobile phones.

In a video message, Go told the beneficiaries that the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) is implementing a ten-

advanced fire-fighting equipment, recruiting additional firefighters, and offering specialized training, among other measures.

"Sa mga biktima ng sunog, huwag ho kayong mag-alala. Sabi ko nga sa inyo noon, ang gamit ay nabibili. Ang pera ay kikitain, subalit 'yung perang kikitain ay hindi po nabibili ang buhay. A lost life is a lost life forever," Go underscored.

"Ang importante po magtulungan tayo. Sino pa ba ang magtutulongan kung 'di tayo lang po mga kapwa Pilipino? Kaya po nandirito kami ngayon para tulungan kayong lahat sa abot ng aming makakaya," he added.

Go then encouraged residents seeking additional support, especially for health concerns, to visit the Malasakit Centers located at the General Emilio Aguinaldo Me-

morial Hospital in Imus City and Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoor City.

Institutionalized under Republic Act No. 11463, or the Malasakit Centers Act of 2019, which Go principally authored and sponsored, these Malasakit Centers simplify access to government services for indigent patients, covering medical costs.
