The inauguration of the newest facility at C5 Extension Road coincided with the birthday celebration of former Senate president Manny Villar.

DOH-Calabarzon rolls out telemedicine program

IMUS CITY, Cavite -- The Department of Health in Region 4-A (Calabarzon) rolled out Monday its telemedicine program which aims to improve health service delivery in identified geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas (GIDAs) of the region.

DOH Calabarzon director Eduardo Janairo said the program, dubbed Medical Call Consultation (MCC), would provide better medical treatment and care to patients through the use of advanced Information and Communication Technologies (ICT).

"Dahil sila ay mabibigyan na mismo ng serbisyo sa kanilang lugar at hindi na nila kailangang tumawid ng dagat at maglakad ng ilang bundok upang makapunta sa pinakamalapit na ospital (Because they will be served in their area, without the burden of crossing the seas or walking through mountains just to get to the nearest hospital)," Janairo said.

The MCC service involves the deployment of voice telehealth kits (mobile phones) with features such as free calls to the landline on nominated area code, broadband, KonsultaMD License, access to 24/7 licensed Filipino doctors, medical advice and primary care guidance, medicine e-prescriptions.

It would also gather patient data to facilitate follow-up and continuous care through the documented call consult with the assistance of a barangay health worker to achieve continuity of care.

Through the service, Janairo said patients would not be burdened financially as their health cases would be closely monitored.

The project had its pilot run from February to June 2019 in 10 barangays in Quezon province and recorded a total of 286 calls from residents with cases of cough, colds, edema/skin lesions/skin rash, shoulder and back

pain, fever and dizziness/headache, among others.

The DOH-Calabarzon and Innove Communications Inc. signed a memorandum of agreement on Monday for the project.

Innove would pro-

vide 180 voice telehealth kits for the rollout implementation of the project, designed in two phases -- from December 2019 to December 2021 for phase 1 (80 units) and April 2020 to April 2022 for phase 2 (100 units). (PNA)

46 provinces receive inbred rice seeds under RCEF

Forty-six out of the 57 target provinces have already received 341,203 bags (20kg/bag) of inbred rice seeds under the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF) Seed Program as of recent data release by the Department of Agriculture-Philippine Rice Research Institute (DA-PhilRice).

The 46 provinces, which make up 81 percent of the accomplishment, include 282 municipalities and cities with high-potential for competitiveness in rice production.

"The provinces

have been identified based on the size of area harvested, yield level, cost of production, and share of irrigated area. These municipalities and cities have an annual area planted of more than 500 hectares for dry season 2019-2020," said Agriculture Secretary William Dar.

Seed distribution is ongoing to cover the remaining 11 provinces including 703 municipalities/cities. The remaining 1,766,805 bags of seeds are scheduled for distribution this 2019-2020 dry season. DA-PhilRice has already

contracted out 97 percent of the seed requirement for this cropping period.

"The two-million bags of certified seeds will translate to planting around one million hectares of rice land which can contribute to increasing the yield up to six tons per hectare in high-yielding provinces by 2024," Dar said.

City in the program launching. She urged the parents to give their full support to the program to improve the nutritional status of their children. Likewise, Ms. Nora de los Santos, City Social Welfare and Development Officer reminded the parents to avoid giving their children artificial drinks. The City government provided playpen, educational materials, building blocks and rubber mats during the launching. On the other hand, Ms. Brendalyn Salazar, Social Welfare Officer IV of the PSWDO gave a brief orientation of the program from identifying a CDC with high prevalence of underweight children, initial weighing, deworming and monthly reweighing to monitor and evaluate the progress weight of the child. Aside from the supplementary feeding, mothers' class sessions will also be conducted among the guardians and mothers of the recipients. The 120-day MFP will start on January 6, 2020.

Revilla expresses gratitude to Malacañang for certifying 'Salary Standardization Law of 2019' as 'urgent'

Senate Committee on Civil Service Chairman Ramon Bong Revilla, Jr. today expressed his gratitude to Pres. Rodrigo Duterte after he certified the Salary Standardization Law of 2019 as "urgent."

The veteran legislator who principally sponsored the measure last week garnered the support of his fellow lawmakers in passing Senate Bill



1219 under Committee Report No. 26 jointly submitted by the Committees on Civil Service, Government Organization and Professional Regulation; and Finance.

Bong Revilla, in sponsoring the bill, expressed that it will address the issue of inequality in the previous Salary Standardization Laws where high-earning employees greatly benefitted while the majority of government employees receiving basic take home pay only received little increase.

The proposed Salary Standardization Law of 2019 is set to benefit more than 1.4 million government employees especially those under Salary Grade (SG) 11 to 19, comprising 79 percent of the total government employees, including teachers and nurses.

Under the proposed measure, the salary adjustment will be given in four (4) tranches beginning

January 2020. It will increase the basic salaries by a weighted average of 23.24 percent upon completion by 2023.

In effect, it will grant the highest increase ranging from 20 to 30 percent for employees with SG 10 to SG 15, and the lowest of 8 percent for government workers under SG 23 to 33. This means that the base pay of government employees under SG 11 to 19 will increase to as much as P 6,000 after the implementation of SSL within a span of four (4) years.

PhilHealth adopts state-of-the-art technology to fight fraud

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is now adopting state-of-the-art technology to bring its existing measures to detect and prevent health insurance fraud to the next level.

The agency is currently

working on a 'proof of concept' together with technology providers for 'liveness check' and 'identity authentication' solutions that will be rolled out in all its offices and participating health facilities in the year 2020.

"Liveness check will help us validate if the member or a dependent is still alive or has expired during confinement, while identity authentication should help us verify if they are who they claim to be," explained PhilHealth President and Chief Executive Officer Ricardo C. Morales during a recent simulation exercise with participating technology provider Galeleo and Element Artificial Intelligence Groups. "These technologies help ensure that only those claims of living members or patients are paid by PhilHealth," he added.

PhilHealth saw the need to institute biometric checks at the level of health facilities to ensure the integrity of hospital claims. The biometric check will include fingerprint scanning and facial recognition to capture different facial structures and landmarks such as eyes and facial contours to ensure the integrity of claims.
