

PBBM signs laws expanding

capacities of state colleges

MANILA - President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. signed into law seven legislative measures to enhance and expand the capacities of at least seven higher education institutions (HEIs).

In a statement on Thursday, the Presidential Communications Office (PCO) said the new laws were signed on Dec. 20, 2023 and will take effect 15 days after its publication in the Official Gazette, or a newspaper of general circulation.

Under Republic Act (RA) No. 11968, Marcos granted the conversion of the San Isidro Satellite campus of the Leyte Normal University (LNU) in San Isidro, Leyte to a regular campus, to be referred to as the "LNU-San Isidro Campus."

The President also signed into law RA No. 11969, converting the Bataan Peninsula State University (BP-SU)-Bagac Extension Campus in Bagac, Bata-Cont.on PAGE5

MANILA - The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is set to adjust the rates of most of its benefit packages starting 2024.

PhilHealth must adjusts its rates in order for members to cope with the increasing cost of medical care, PhilHealth president and chief executive officer Emmanuel Ledesma Jr. said in a statement on Friday.

"We want our members to feel the value of their benefits which translates to meaningful financial risk protection. Dapat ramdam ng mga kababayan natin ang benepisyo nila sa PhilHealth (Our fellowmen must be able to feel their benefits from Phil-Health)," he added.

The state health insurer first implemented the case rate payment system in 2013, wherein it reimbursed a fixed amount for a specific medical condition or surgical case.

With the set adjustment, the case rates are likely to increase to a maximum of 30 percent across all cases, resulting to lower out-ofpocket expenses during hospitalization and even during outpatient care.

prescribe a cost-sharing mechanism wherein health facilities and the members will have fixed co-payment rates on top of what is being paid for by PhilHealth.

This way, health facilities will be more efficient in the use of resources to achieve desired health outcomes while members can predict how much they should pay for amenities and other extra services availed of beyond those provided in basic or ward accommodations.

Other strategies to control the untoward effects of this adjustment include measures to prevent insurance fraud and doctor moral hazard.

"This will be our way of controlling healthcare costs, in making member's expenses predictable, and in discouraging irrational use of healthcare services among facilities," Ledesma said.

The PhilHealth shall adopt a variable inflation adjustment across types of health facilities, which means that higher-level facilities shall

Keeping the wheels of justice rolling

MANILA - More than the resolution of high-profile cases, radical and long overdue reforms in the country's justice system highlight the first full year of the Marcos administration under the watch of Justice Secretary Jesus Crispin Remulla and the iudiciary with Chief Justice Alexander Gesmundo at

'Luffy' and immigration reforms

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has proven its firm resolve in ensuring that the Philippines would not be a haven for unscrupulous aliens evading prosecution in their homelands.

In the first quarter of this year, the deportation of Japanese fugitive Yuki Watanabe, more commonly known as "Luffy", made headlines. He is the alleged leader of a gang responsible for a string of violent robberies in Japan.

Watanabe ran the gang's operations online while detained at the Bureau of Immigration's (BI) fa- of law in these cases. cility in Taguig City, through mobile phones smuggled

Watanabe, along with three other Japanese nationals, were sent back to Japan.

Remulla vowed action against defense lawyers whom he said prepared "contrived" cases for their detained expatriate clients to prevent them from 111, in an Oct. 9 ruling, found former BI supervising being deported to their home countries.

The trumped-up cases involved bogus charges for violence against women and children usually done through a sworn statement by a supposed girlfriend of the suspect in the Philippines.

The Pasay City Regional Trial Court Branch officer Marcos Nicodemus quilty of two charges of violating Republic Act (RA) 10175 (Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012) and RA 3019 (Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act) and sentenced him to up to nine years imprisonment with perpetual disqualification to hold public office for falsifying the travel repreme Court (SC) to tighten the rules on the practice cords of Marsalek during the height of the pandemic.

Marsalek, 43, who is believed to be somewhere in Russia, is wanted by the International Criminal Police Organization (Interpol) for his part in the Wirecard scandal, which involved more than USD2 billion in missing funds.

To address the involvement of BI personnel in irregularities, the government has announced that it considering outsourcing the process of issuing visas following the discovery of anomalies in visas issued to Chinese travelers.

Remulla recommended to Malacanang that the processing of visas of Chinese nationals entering the Philippines be handled by third-party visa outsourcing and technology services specialist VFS Global.

The firm works with governments and diplomatic missions worldwide, with more than 3.000 application centers and operations in 149 countries.

POGOs and human trafficking

The government has also mounted a crackdown on human trafficking amid controversies over the extent of the power of immigration officers to hold an outbound Filipino from boarding a flight.

Several raids this year on large-scale Philippine Offshore Gaming Operations (POGO) which employed Filipinos and foreigners have revealed white slavery conditions.

These firms which operate in self-contained buildings in Metro Manila and nearby provinces have shown many indications of human trafficking and other related crimes, the DOJ said.

in the modernization of the BFP to ensure the safety and well-being of the Filipinos," cited Go.

"Huwag po kayong mawalan ng pag-asa, ang importante ay buhay kayo. Ang gamit po ay napapalitan, ang pera ay kikitain pero ang pera ay hindi nabibili ang buhay. A lost life is a lost life forever. Kaya pangalagaan natin and buhay na binigay sa atin ng Panginoon," he

Recently, Go also co-sponsored and is one of the authors of Senate Bill No. 2451 or the Ligtas Pinoy Centers bill, which was primarily sponsored by Senator Jinggoy Estrada. The measure, based on the Mandatory Evacuation Center bill that Go earlier filed, aims to establish permanent, wellequipped evacuation centers nationwide.

"Alam n'yo, napapanahon na po na magkaroon tayo ng maayos na evacuation center. Hindi lang po tuwing puputok ang bulkan, kundi tuwing may bagyo, sunog, lindol o ano pa mang sakuna," he added.

Go, chairperson of the Senate Committee on Health and Demography, offered to help those in need of medical care and encouraged them to get medical assistance from the Malasakit Centers located at the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in the city and at the General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital in Imus

Signed into law in 2019. RA 11463, or the Malasakit Centers Act. which was principally authored and sponsored by Go, institutionalized the Malasakit Centers program to ensure that indigent patients have convenient access to medical assistance programs by the government. There are now 159 Malasakit Centers nationwide, which have assisted around ten million

emergencies and disasters. Filipinos, according to the

Go also shared that

he has been advocating for the establishment of Super Health Centers nationwide. saying, "Makatutulong po ito sa mga kababayan natin na ilapit po ang serbisyong medikal sa kanila. Ilalagay po ito sa mga strategic areas sa buong Pilipinas."

Through the concerted efforts of lawmakers. adequate funding was allocated for the establishment of 307 Super Health Centers in 2022 and 322 more in 2023.

In the province. necessary funds were allocated to construct Super Health Centers in Bacoor City, Dasmariñas City, General Trias City, Carmona City, Tagaytay City, Imus City, Alfonso, Kawit, Magallanes, Tanza, General Mariano Alvarez, and Rosario.

Furthermore. Go cited the enactment of RA 11959, also known as the Regional Specialty Centers Act, which he principally sponsored and is one of the authors in the Senate.

For the same period, there were also 8,164,031 or 84 percent 16 deaths related to measles and rubella. compared to zero deaths for the same period last

Measles and rubella can be prevented by vaccines. Children from nine to 59 months or under five years old should be protected through vaccination to keep cases low.

Last May, the DOH implemented Measles-Rubella-bivalent Oral Polio vaccine supplemental immunization activity for a month to mitigate the impending risk of a measles out-

under five years old.

The agency was able to vaccinate of the target population.

Meantime, partial unofficial data on the coverage for two doses of measles-containing vaccine is at 45.52 percent as of September 2023.

Since quality supplemental immuni zation activity requires 90 percent coverage of the target population, the DOH urges all sectors and units of government to work together, using primary health care as a platform to reach and vaccinate every missed child./source:(PNA)
