PH to host 41st ASEAN Social Security Association Meetings in November

MANILA - The Philippines is set to host the 41st ASEAN Social Security Association (ASSA) Meetings from Nov. 25 to 27, aimed at strengthening social protection systems, expanding coverage to workers, and building more sustainable institutions, the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) said Tuesday.

Industry leaders and representatives from social security institutions across ASEAN member states are expected to gather to advance the region's commitment to a more comprehensive and inclusive social protection

The meeting agenda focuses on the mega trends faced by the industry, the empowering role of technology, and the implementation of comprehensive approaches to social security within the ASEAN region.

GSIS President and General Manager and Vice Chairperson of ASSA Jose Arnulfo Veloso said it is a privilege to host the conference along with the Social Security System and Philippine Social Security Association

"This event represents a unique opportunity to showcase our leadership in shaping regional social security policies and provides a platform for meaningful exchanges among ASEAN nations --an essential step towards building a future wherein the social security system across the region is inclusive and equipped to protect

MOU offering 50% grad | studies scholarship to OFWs, families forged

Party-List Rep. Marissa "Del Mar" Magsino and the University of Perpetual Help System DALTA - Las Piñas (UPHSD) on Tuesday forged a partnership that offers partial graduate studies scholarships to overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) and their families, furthering educational opportunities in business, education. nursing, and public administration.

The partnership, randum of understanding (MOU), was signed by Magsino and Dr. Eduardo C. Zialcita, UPHSD Dean of Graduate School, at the OFW Tulong at Serbisyo Center in Parañague City.

Under the partnership, the OFW Partv-list will endorse qualified students who want to take up graduate pro-

grams in business, education, nursing, and public administration at the Las Piñas campus.

All endorsed applicants holding a bachelor's degree from the Commission on Higher Education-recognized institutions will be given a 50 percent scholarship by the UPHSD once they pass the entrance exams and other requirements.

"We are grateful to UPHSD for opening the opportunity to our OFWs and their families to take up further studies," Magsino said.

NGCP completes restoration of power lines in Calabarzon

BIÑAN CITY, Laguna (PIA) - The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) has completed its restoration of transmission lines just days after the onslaught of Severe Tropical Storm Kristine.



According NGCP regional spokesperson Joyce Balancio, personnel and line crews were already deployed to conduct regular inspection of substations and transmission lines prior to Kristine gaining strength.

"Here in Calabarzon, although we felt the impact of Typhoon Kristine, we didn't have any severely affected facilities or transmission lines. The good thing is the NGCP personnel and line team were prepared for the arrival of typhoon, so we were able to deploy resources immediately " Balancio

As a result, NGCP transmission lines in Calabarzon were fully energized on Saturday, October 26 at 3:19am and ready to distribute power supply in various distribution utilities and cooperatives

"Our transmission lines are very critical and sensitive, meaning even if they don't fall down or get knocked down, just a light immediately, (CO/PIA-4A)

touch from something like debris or even a leaf from a tree can immediately disrupt our connection or electricity," Balancio added.

Based on the NG-CP's record, 39 municipalities experienced power interruptions in the region due to the typhoon, composed of four municipalities in Laguna, 11 in Quezon Province and 24 in Batan-

plained: "There are instances when NGCP issues an advisory stating that our transmission services have been restored and electricity is available for distribution utilities. However, if our distribution utilities still have affected facilities meaning they are not vet able to supply electricity to affected areas, that is where the problem arises."

To address the situation and help communities still without power supply, the NGCP said they are willing to assist local distribution utilities and cooperatives to restore their lines

MSMEs in 7 provinces, 26 municipalities may apply for recovery loan

MANILA – The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) on Monday said micro, small, and medium enterprises (MS-MEs) in seven provinces and 26 municipalities and cities affected by Severe Tropical Storm Kristine (international name Trami) may apply for recovery loans.

In an ANC interview, DTI Acting Secretary Ma. Cristina Roque

said that as of Oct. 27, almost 400 MSMEs were already affected by Kristine

"So, for now, we have the enterprise for rehabilitation fund, which is PHP2 billion, which we are now dispatching to all the MSMEs that were affected by the calamity. This fund, they can get it from the SB Corp. (Small Business Corporation), which is actually the bank

that is under DTI," Roque

"There's actually seven provinces and 26 municipalities and cities that can avail of this loan. Those are the ones that were affected by Kristine," said Roque.

Among these areas are Albay, Camarines Norte, Catanduanes, Cavite, Camarines Sur, Cotabato, Quezon, East-
