TAGAYTAY CITY, Cavite (PIA) -- The city government here placed Barangays Calabuso and Mag-asawang Ilat under lockdown after reports of confirmed cases from these areas.

This came about after a company in the city reported that eight of its employees tested positive after conducting Rapid Diagnostic Testing (RDT) for their employees. The company not only employs residents in the city but also from nearby provinces of Laguna and Batangas.

Three of the eight positive cases are residents of the city and one of the relatives of said employees also tested positive, thereby giving a total of four Probable cases pending the taking of swab samples for the Real Time-Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) for confirmation of results. They were immediately isolated in the

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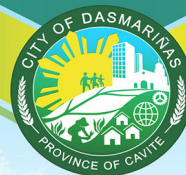

Nakikiusap ang Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) sa mga local government units (LGUs) na huwag singilin ng mahal ang mga locally stranded individuals (LSIs) para sa medical certificates na kailangan nila upang makabalik sa kanilang mga probinsya.

Ayon kay DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año, nakatanggap sila ng mga ulat na may ilang LGUs na naniningil ng P3,000 kapalit ng medical certificate. Sabi pa niya na ang

mga nasabing ulat ay iniimbestigahan na, at binigyang-diin pa nito na kung ang natanggap na impormasyon ay totoo, "ito ay sadyang hindi makatarungan sa mga stranded na indibidwal na gusto lamang umuwi sa kanilang mga probinsya."

"Huwag na po nating singilin pa ng pagkamahal-mahal ang ating mga kababayan na gusto lamang makauwi sa kanilang mga probinsya. Kung puwede ngang libre na lang dahil wala namang lab tests na gagawin. Huwag na natin

silang pahirapan as they have suffered enough kaya nga nila hinahangad na makauwi na," sabi nito.

Sinabi niya na ang DILG ay nakikiusap sa lahat ng mayors na suriin ang kanilang schedule of fees sa panahon ng COVID at singilin lamang ng kaunting bayad bilang serbisyong pampubliko.

"Gusto nang umuwi ng mga LSI dahil wala na nga po silang pantustos sa pang-araw-araw dahil sila nga po ay stranded. Kung stranded na

nga po sila tapos hihingan pa po natin sila ng napakalaking halaga ay parang wala naman po tayong malasakit," paliwanag ni Año.

Sinabi niya na ang mga LSIs ay kailangan lamang kumuha ng medical certificate at travel authority upang makabalik sa kanilang mga probinsya. Sinabi din niya na ang mga medical certificate ay kailangan i-request sa health office ng LGU, binigyang-diin pa nito na hindi kailangan sumailalim

"Itong medical certificate ay nagsasaad lamang na hindi kayo contact, suspect, o probable o confirmed COVID-19 case, at sumailalim ng 14-day quarantine base sa mga protokol ng Department of Health," aniya.

Pagkatapos makakuha ng medical certificate, ang mga LSI ay maaari nang mag-apply para sa travel authority sa help desk ng kanilang lokal na police station.

Samantala, sinabi ni DILG Undersecretary at Spokesperson Jonathan E. Malaya na habang ipinapatupad ng pambansang pamahalaan ang programang 'Balik Probinsya, Bagong Pag-asa,' prayoridad ang maayos na pagbiyahe at pagbabalik ng mga LSI.

Ayon sa National Housing Authority, hindi bababa sa isang milyong residente ng Metro Manila ang inaasahang makikilahok sa programang Balik Probinsya, Bagong Pag-asa kung saan mahigit 33,000 LSIs na ang nagparehistro.

"Inaasahan ng pamahalaan na milyon-milyong mga Pilipino ang makikinabang sa programang ito kaya inaasahan po namin ang tulong ng lahat ng mga LGUs," sabi ni Malaya.

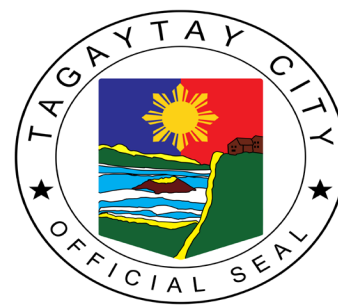

Aking hinihingi ang pang-unawa at kooperasyon ng lahat ng mga mamamayan ng Calabuso at Mag-asawang Ilat. Tanging kaligtasan ninyo lamang ang aming iniingatan.

Para sa lahat ng mamamayan ng Tagaytay. Bagama't nasa General Community Quarantine na ang ating Lungsod, aming patuloy na pinapakiusap na manatili lamang sa loob ng inyong tahanan at lumabas lamang kung mamimili ng inyong pangunahing pangangailangan. Para sa mga kababayan nating nagtrabaho gayundin sa kanilang mga employer, Aming hinihikayat na kung maaari manatili na lamang pansamantalala sa inyong pinagtatrabahuhan. 8,000 tests could be accommodated daily by next week.

"This will somehow speed up the completion of the targeted testing in the province, but then again the mass testing is not feasible," the Gov. said.

Delving on the issue on securing the confidence of the parents for the safety of their children during the resumption of classes, the governor thought of investments to be made to ensure the children's safety and the continuation of their edu-

cation.

He saw the need to set up hand washing facilities in every school. The barangay basketball covered courts will be used as alternative remote learning centers due to imminent shortage of classrooms to allow social distancing in school, and investment for free WIFI with estimated cost of Php1B with about 15, 000 computers to be installed in the province.

Also, targeted testing for the teachers and students will not be a onetime activity but should be year round to ensure

their continued health and safety and control the possible infection in the school premises.

Likewise, part of the safety protocols would be the provision of mass transportation for the students to minimize the risk of exposure to the corona virus and to any other accidents.

Governor Remulla said, "We will continue to talk to the mayors and congressmen about these concerns. Rest assured, we will continue to look for solutions to these problems." (Ruel Francisco,

DTI BARES UP TO P500,000 SMALL BUSINESS FINANCING, AT LOW INTEREST RATES IN NCR

Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Secretary Ramon Lopez said micro and small businesses in Metro Manila can borrow up to P200,000 or up to P500,000 at low interest rates once the region transitions to more relaxed general community quarantine (GCQ) on June 1.

During the Laging Handa briefing powered by the Presidential Communications and affiliate state media, Lopez said the Small Business Corporation, an attached agency of the DTI, will be extending assistance to small and micro businesses to help whether the impacts of the lockdown.

"Makakahiram po ang micro entrepreneurs from P10,000 to P200,000 and from P10,000 to P500,000 for small-sized enterprises," the DTI chief said as government allotted funds to assist small and micro businesses that are unable to operate because of the health emergency crisis.

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GOV. REMULLA LIFTS LIQUOR BAN IN CAVITE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite(PIA) -- Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla finally decided on the lifting of the Liquor Ban in the province effective June 1, 2020.

The announcement was made with the implementing guidelines for the sale and purchase of all intoxicating liquids as stated.

Only Quarantne passholders are allowed to purchase liquor within the time frame of 1pm

- 4pm daily and with limited quantity according to liquor classification.

The Q-passholder could purchase any one of the following per day: one (1) liter of hard drinks (18 proof and above) including but not limited to Emperador, Alfonso, Ginebra, and any other 'hard drinks'; two (2) liters of drinks (12 - 17 proof) that include wines, shoktong, and other champagne; a total of two (2) liters of drinks (1

- 11 proof) like beers (Red Horse, San Mig Lights, Corona, etc.) and others (6 - 330ml bottles/cans or 4 - 500ml bottles/cans).

Likewise, drinking outside the house or in plain sight of authority is still not allowed, that may also include persons found to be intoxicated along main roads and streets that would be reasonable enough for arrest and being charged according to the law.
