LRT-1 Cavite extension 94% complete, on track for Q4 2024 opening

MANILA – The civil and system works of the Light Rail Transit Line 1 (LRT-1) Cavite Extension reached a progress rate of 94.1 percent in the third quarter of 2023, according to its private operator Light Rail Manila Corporation (LRMC).

In a statement Friday, the LRMC said the five new stations

under the project are on track to open by the last quarter of 2024.

This includes Redemptorist Station at 86.3 percent completion, the Manila International Airport (MIA) Station at 86.9 percent, Asia World Station (to be connected to the Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) at 72.9 percent, Ninoy Aquino

Station at 81.5 percent, and Dr. Santos Station at 90.5 percent.

"With construction activities in full swing, safety remains the top priority of LRMC for its workers and work places by carrying out programs to ensure stringent health, safety, and environmental practices among its employees and contractors," the

LRMC said.

To date, the project has accumulated 11.8 million "safe man-hours" without a lost time incident as of September.

LRMC president and CEO Juan Alfonso expressed confidence that the commercial operations of the LRT-1 Cavite Extension project will begin in less than a

year.

"The overall progress rate is a good signal to usher the country into an era of modern railway experience where passengers can take advantage of world-class amenities, user-friendly and PWD-friendly facilities, high standards of safety and security, and value-added services," Alfonso said.

The first phase of the Cavite Extension project consists of a 6.7-kilometer extension of the mainline and five stations.

These stations will be near or connected to several other transport hubs such as the MIA, the PITX and a bus terminal in Cavite as well as an interconnection with SM City Sucat. source:(PNA)

clean for generations to come.

Passport on Wheels: Bringing Convenience to Caviteños



In an era marked by technological advancements and the pursuit of greater convenience, Provincial Government of Cavite through the Office of the Public Employment

The initiative was carried out in collaboration with the Department of Foreign Affairs-Office of Consular Affairs (DFA-OCA), making the process of obtaining and renewing a passport more accessible and efficient to more than 300 Caviteños.

The Passport on Wheels offered application for new passports and renewal of existing ones. It provided a comfortable and efficient setting for applicants to submit their requirements, have their biometric data captured, and receive guidance on the pass-

port application process. Furthermore, the presence of highly-trained DFA-OCA personnel ensured that applicants received accurate information and support throughout the process, making the passport application process as seamless as possible.

The initiative received an overwhelming response from the community. Residents appreciated the convenience of having passport services readily available at their doorstep. --- JDP

DOH: P50.56-B health emergency allowance released as of Nov. 3

MANILA – The Department of Health (DOH) on Wednesday said it has released a total of PHP50.56 billion health emergency allowance (HEA) to health care workers (HCWs) as of Nov. 3, 2023.

In a statement, the DOH noted that the amount include a PHP4-billion increase due to the recent allotment from the Department of Budget and Management.

The funds have been allocated to the Center for Health Development (CHD), DOH hospitals, treatment and rehabilitation centers, and other attached agencies.

"Out of the allocated funds, 90.07 percent or PHP45,532,813,132.35, has been released to the health workers. During this period, a total of 6,789,044 claims have

been processed," the agency said.

For the calendar year 2021 to 2023, the DOH's remaining arrears amounts to PHP 62.2 billion.

Rank No. 1 Most Wanted Person – Municipal Level Nabbed in Noveleta

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, City of Imus, Cavite — Through the intelligence-driven operation of the Warrant Personnel of Noveleta Municipal Police Station, Rank No. 1 Most Wanted Person – Municipal Level was arrested at Brgy. Poblacion, Noveleta, Cavite on November 14, 2023.

The Chief of Police of Noveleta MPS, PMAJ RENE DALE CAIREL, identified the suspect as alias “Jonel” a resident of Barangay Poblacion, Noveleta, Cavite, wanted for the Violation of RA 10591.

After close monitoring and surveillance, Jonel was arrested by virtue of a Warrant of Arrest for the Violation of RA 10591 under Criminal Case No. 1014-2022, issued by Regional Trial Court, Fourth Judicial Region, Branch 16, Cavite City with recommended bail of Php 100,000.00.

The suspect is now under the custody of Noveleta Municipal Police Station for documentation and proper disposition.

Cavite Police Provincial Office remains committed to hunt down people with an existing warrant of arrest to make sure that they will face the charges filed against them in court.
