



DA-Calabarzon allots P1.3-B for farm-to-market roads in 2024

LIPA CITY, Batangas – The Department of Agriculture-Calabarzon (DA-4A) announced the impending implementation of 80 farm-to-market road development projects (FMRDP) in 2024, with a combined cost of almost PHP1.3 billion.

Romelo Reyes, chief of DA-4A's Regional Agricultural Engineering Division, told the Philippine News Agency on Friday that a better road network in the five-province region will facilitate the quicker delivery of farm and ocean produce to consumers.

This, in turn, will lead to less spoilage of perishable goods, which is a major contributor to food inflation.

MANILA, (PIA) -- President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. and First Lady Louise Arane-ta-Marcos on Sunday, November 26, led this year's "Balik Sigla, Bigay Saya" gift-giving ceremony at Malacañang Palace that provided early Christmas surprises to over 17,000 disadvantaged children.

Jointly organized by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and the Office of the President, simultaneous festivities were held across more than 250 sites nationwide. Corporate partners like Jollibee and San Miguel Corporation helped bring holiday cheer to kids from

various shelters and orphanages. Malacañang said this year's event will give gifts to 17,268 children nationwide.

Provincial Government of Cavite Conducts Orientation on Handling Former Rebels and Former Violent Extremists

The Provincial Government of Cavite, through the Office of the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Officer spearheaded the Orientation on Handling Former Rebels (FRs) and Former Violent Extremists (FVEs) focused

on their rehabilitation and reintegration. The activity also aimed to capacitate the frontline workers to effectively engage with these FRs and FVEs. The two-day event, held on November 23-24, 2023, at The Bayleaf Hotel in General

Trias City, gathered key stakeholders to strategize and collaborate on addressing the challenges associated with the reintegration process.

Attended by a diverse group of 50 participants, including representatives from the

Armed Forces of the Philippines, Philippine National Police, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), academe, local government units (LGUs), former rebels (FRs), and members of the Provincial Enhanced

Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee, the event fostered a collaborative environment to explore comprehensive solutions.

Provincial Administrator for Community Affairs Mr. Alvin Mojica, shared insights on the importance of preparedness in providing social welfare services for rebel returnees and their significant role in achieving holistic peace in the province.

The event featured informative presentations and discussions covering a spectrum of crucial topics on Legal Framework and Assistance Program. Ms. Lhyrey Vicentino from DILG provided comprehensive insights

into Executive Order No. 70, institutionalizing the whole-of-nation approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, creating a national task force to end local communist armed conflict (NTF-ELCAC), and directing the adoption of a national peace framework; the situation of rebel returnees in CALABARZON region, and the benefits and assistance available through DILG-DND JMC no. 01 Series of 2021 or the "Implementing Guidelines on the Provision of DILG-administered Package of Assistance to Former Rebels (FRs) and Former Violent Extremists (FVEs).

DOST to boost support for startups

MANILA – Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Secretary Renato Solidum Jr. said Thursday the agency will work closely with other government agencies and the private sector in line with its ambitious plan to further strengthen support for startups.

"We plan to collaborate with the DICT (Department of Infor-

mation and Communications Technology) and DTI (Department of Trade and Industry) in a strategic planning session in January to establish clear goals and targets for the next five years," Solidum told the Philippine News Agency.

The DOST, he said, aims to harmonize startup programs with DICT and DTI, improve communication plans,

promote the Startup PH website, and launch additional programs for startups and startup enablers.

"We will establish more collaboration with the private sector," he added.

According to the DOST, its attached agencies' Startup Grant Fund (SGF) Program has so far provided PHP230 million to over 60 start-

ups for research and development purposes and strengthen their intellectual property (IP).

The agency's Women Helping Women Innovating Social Enterprises (WHWISE) Program, which focuses on women-led enterprises promoting equity and inclusivity to women entrepreneurs, has helped 15 enterprises since 2021, Cont.on PAGE5

"The producers [farmers and fisherfolk] can transport their products to traders and consumers without difficulty and they will be able to get better prices and broader reach for their products," Reyes said.

He revealed that 10 projects are allocated to Cavite worth PHP181 million; 11 projects for Laguna amounting to PHP195 million; 29 projects in Batangas worth PHP467 million; nine projects in Rizal worth PHP145 million; and 21 projects in Quezon worth PHP280 million.

Meanwhile, Reyes said each District Engineering Office of

the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) reported to the DA the status of various FMRDP currently under construction.

The assessment activity ensured that Agricultural and Biosystems and Engineering Management Information System is in place to properly implement the projects.

By virtue of a memorandum of agreement (MOA), the DA has partnered with the DPWH for the FMR projects.

Under the MOA, the DA is the agency responsible for promoting agricultural development by providing and drafting policies, public invest-

ment, and services and support needed for domestic and export-oriented business enterprises.

The DPWH is the agency assigned to engineering and construction, and is responsible for planning, designing, building, and ensuring that infrastructure and facilities are maintained in accordance with established standards.

"The partnership of the DA and DPWH is very important because here, there is unity to quickly and smoothly implement the programs especially in the FMRDP," Reyes added. /source:(PNA)

New Tondo Sports Complex in Manila Underway

The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) is on track to complete the second phase of Bagong Tondo Sports Complex Project in Manila by the first quarter of 2024.

DPWH National Capital Region Director Loreta M. Malaluan, in her report to DPWH Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan, said that Phase 2 of the project is 38 percent complete, a significant improvement since it began civil works in April 2023.

The DPWH North Manila District Engineering Office under the leadership of District Engineer Gerard P. Oplencia, is fast tracking civil works to ensure the timely completion of the Phase 2 by March 2024.

The second phase of the project involves the construction of superstructures which includes column, beams and suspended slab per floors. Also included in the contract amounting P133 million are the electrical works, fire protection, plumbing and sewer works, finishing works and installation of lighting fixtures and air-conditioning.

The project's Phase 1 costing P82.02 million was implemented in 2021. It covered the construction of foundation and substructures of the building including footing, pilecap, and micropiles.

An additional P10 Million will be needed to complete the entire Tondo Sports Complex. The amount was the proposed allocation under Phase 3 covering site development.

When completed, the sports complex with a total floor area of 3,360 square meters will feature a gym, a multi-purpose open space, an indoor basketball court, and a conference room. It is seen to cater various athletic and recreational activities in the area.

"A new Tondo Sports Complex with complete facilities will be able to bring together people with shared interests, and encourage an active and healthy lifestyle to the residents," said Director Malaluan.

The event concluded with reflections and feedback from participants, emphasizing the collaborative efforts and commitment to effective recuperation. Overall, the event marked a significant step in aligning efforts among various stakeholders toward fostering a supportive environment for the successful reintegration of former rebels and violent extremists into society. ---Amy C. with a total funding of PHP53 million.

On the other hand, the Technology Business Incubation (TBI) program, which was formed to capacitate the TBI facilities of universities and colleges, has already established 54 TBI networks.

The program aims adding 27 new TBIs with a funding of PHP400 million in the next two years, according to the DOST.

Solidum said the agency will enhance the startup ecosystem via the Regional Startup Enabler for Ecosystem Development (ReSEED) Program. ReSEED has a total funding of PHP120 million to reach 16 regions.

In a news release on Thursday, the DOST said it has awarded PHP100,000 to speedboat innovator AJIS Dive and Aqua Sports Inc. on Nov. 22 to help the firm adopt in-

dustry 4.0 technologies in its operations. The award was given through the iREADY award being provided to micro, small and medium enterprises.

"As the pioneer fiberglass speed boat manufacturer in Northern Mindanao, AJIS has been using various technologies in their daily operations to produce quality boats that are now being sold in various parts of the country, such as Manila, Cebu, Palawan, Tawi-tawi, and more. Among these technologies are sensor technology, real-time location systems,

and machine-to-machine communication," it said.

AJIS received its first DOST assistance in 2019 through the Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP), to which they acquired a 2-Axis CNC Router with Rhino 3D Software -- a computer-controlled cutting machine for different types of surfaces.

The CNC Router machine enabled the firm to significantly improve the quality of their boats, especially for 17 and 36-footer speed boats and yachts, the DOST said. (PNA)

The initial 30 PWUDs were reduced to 28 participants after 2 tested positive in illegal drug substance in the



random drug testing facilitated by the Regional Forensic Unit 4A on their 3rd day.

The PRO 4A BIDA-BEST Program is a 5-day comprehensive recovery and wellness program in which the PWUDs went through physical wellness activi-

ties and productive training program.

They also underwent counseling from values coaches, lectures on Shabu and Cocaine, Marijuana, Opioids and Club Drugs, Daan Tungo sa Recovery and Pamilya at Recovery. All these topics were essential for

the clients to understand the ill-effects of drugs and give them ways to rebuild themselves through recovery and the help of their families.

Villar gives anew free castration

For the third time, Senator Cynthia A. Villar gave free castration, spaying and anti-rabies vaccines to pet dogs and cats of residents in Las Piñas and the nearby Bacoor.

Villar said she wants a continuity of this project to control the increasing number of stray dogs and cats and pre-

vent the spread of rabies, which remains to be a public health problem in the country, accounting for 200 to 300 deaths each year.

"This situation is not a problem only in Las Pinas and Bacoor. In fact, I have talked to Congressmen, congresswomen and mayors, and this is also a problem in

their areas. So I have thought of doing this in Las Pinas and Bacoor so we will no longer add to this problem of our country. This is our solution," the senator said.

She likewise cited Republic Act 9482 or Anti-Rabies Act of 2007 which provides that it is the responsibility of pet
