DOH pushes for responsible pet ownership as rabies cases in PH hit 260



bies cases in the Philippines have climbed to 260 from January to September 20 this year, the Department of Health (DOH) said Mon-

sory, the DOH reported that 95 percent of the infections were linked to animals that were unvaccinated or had unknown vaccination status

With the rising number of cases, the DOH urged the public to take preventive measures through responsible pet ownership.

Annual cination of pets is the most effective protection against rabies for both humans and animals. The Anti-Rabies Act of 2007 makes vaccination mandatory for pet owners to help eliminate rabies nationwide.

In a public advi- ment programs provide rabies vaccines for free. The first rabies vaccine is given to puppies around three months old, followed by yearly boost-

> ers for all adult pets. The DOH also reminded pet owners to register their dogs and cats with their barangay, keep pets from roaming unsupervised, and immediately seek treatment at an Animal Bite Treatment Center if bitten or scratched.

Bam Aquino to gov't: **Prioritize Libreng** Kolehiyo for underprivileged students

Senator Aguino has urged the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) to ramp up the government's scholarship programs under the Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) for underprivileged students through educational insti-

During the budget hearing of state universities and colleges (SUCs), Aquino raised concern over the declining allocation for the TES program in the past years.

From P23.4 bilion in 2024 the TES budget dropped to P21.7 billion in 2025, down by P1.7 billion. The TES budget further decreased to P20.7 billion under the 2026 National Expenditure Program

component of the Free College Law, or Republic Act 10931, the TES program provides assistance to financially disadvantaged students for other costs of education, such as food, books, and living expenses. It also covers expenses of poor but deserving students who choose to study in private colleges and uni-

Calling the decrease unacceptable. Aquino said he will move for the restoration of the TFS budget to the 2024 level in the 2026 appropriations.

The Senator also questioned the DBM's justification for citing the CHED's low utilization rate as the reason for the reduction, saying many students are looking for schol-
