

DANGER DOWN: PRES. DUTERTE ORDERS PULL-OUT OF POLICE, MILITARY PERSONNEL DEPLOYED NEAR TAAL VOLCANO

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte last week said he wants police and military personnel tasked to maintain peace and order near the vicinity of Taal Volcano be recalled considering health concerns and possible conflict with local residents after authorities allowed them to return home.

Taal Volcano erupted on January 12, spewing large amounts of ash compelling mass evacuation of local residents from affected areas.

In a speech during the 69th Founding Anniversary Celebration of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), the President said he wants the pull-out of police and military personnel from the Taal danger zone to protect their well-being and prevent possible conflict with the local population.

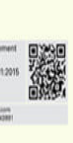

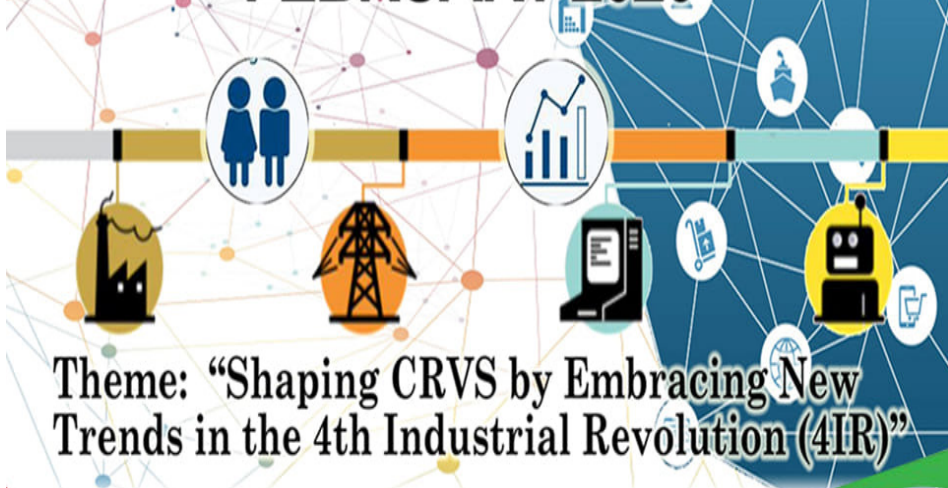

Malacañang open to review of Sangley airport deal

MANILA -- Malacañang expressed openness to the possible review of the USD10-billion Sangley Point International Airport project following claims that the development contract would be awarded to the lone and favored bidder.

"You must remember that this government has always been open to any complaint," Presidential Spokesperson Salvador Panelo said in a press conference thursday, referring to the selection of a private partner for the Sangley Point project.

"The presumption is everything is aboveboard unless you give us proof that it is not, then we come in," he added.

Panelo made the remark after The Philippine Daily Inquirer (PDI), in its Jan. 30 article, claimed that there were "indications" that the lone bidder, the tandem of Lucio Tan's MacroAsia Corp. and China Communications Construction Corp. (CCCC), for the airport deal in Cavite was "favored from the beginning."

QUEZON CITY (PIA) -- Amid the world health threat of novel Corona Virus (2019 nCoV) and its first reported case in the Philippines, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has advised all local government units (LGUs) to create their respective Corona Virus Task Forces to help contain the spread of the disease in the country.

Sotto urges for One Info Agency

SENATE President Vicente C. Sotto III has called for the creation of an inter-agency body to update the public on the medical status of the novel coronavirus (nCoV) and of government actions to control its spread.

Sotto said the people should have easy access not only to clinical concerns but other issues such as travel restrictions, market conditions, economic impacts, tourism-related announcements, and local government advisories, among others.

"Mabuting magkaroon ng isang information agency kung saan lahat ng datos na kailangan ng mamamayan ay madali nilang ma-access. Abala ang ating mga health officials sa pag-control ng pagkakat ng nCoV. Mas

makakabuti kung hahayaan natin silang mag-concentrate sa medical concerns ng mga pasyente," Sotto said to justify his call.

The Senate President said the inter-agency body shall have representatives or resource persons from the DoH for health updates, the DOT for travel information, the DTI for market concerns, the DOF for economic and business matters, the DOT for tourism guidelines and local government units for community announcements. A daily

media briefing can be held to update the public on the latest news about the virus and its effects on various industries.

Information coming from the body will serve as official statements of the government, Sotto said.

Sotto said the body will likewise directly respond to fake information being peddled to the media by unscrupulous individuals or groups which are taking advantage of the situation to discredit government efforts.

"Ang daming kumakalat na fake news ngayon na dumadagdag lang sa public panic. During this time when our country needs to deal with

a global threat, we do not need false reports that tend to scare families. What we need now is an official body which will be the sole source of all official information on the nCoV," Sotto said.

The Senate President said the inter-department agency can later be made permanent and serve as the official government instrument for disasters and other calamities.

DOST offers scholarships to grad students from Cambodia, Lao PDR and Myanmar

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) extends its scholarship program to the Southeast Asian community through the "DOST Scholarship Offerings for ASEAN Researchers at Cambodia – Lao PDR – Myanmar (CLM)".

Under the program, graduate students from the three ASEAN member states may apply for scholarship and pursue their masters and doctorate degrees in various fields of science and engineering at partner universities (De La Salle University, University of the Philippines (UP) Diliman, UP Los Baños and UP Manila).

Current CLM scholars were welcomed by DOST Secretary Fortunato de la Peña in a get-together held on 22 January 2020 at the DOST-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) office in Taguig City. This was the second time DOST and partner university officials met with CLM scholarship recipients. The students thanked the DOST and the government and talked about their experiences as scholars in the country.

Secretary de la Peña emphasized the importance of friendship in the ASEAN and reminded scholars that they have a mission to fulfill.

Veterinary Mission for Animals Affected by Taal Volcano Eruption

Persistent on its goal to safeguard the welfare of the animals who have been affected by the eruption of Taal Volcano, the Provincial Veterinary Office (PVO) led by Dr. May Magno has initiated efforts to visit and conduct veterinary missions at Tagaytay City for the treatment of rescued animals on January 29, 2020.

The Provincial Veterinary Office, together with some veterinarians from the City Veteri-

narian Office of Tagaytay and the whole staff from Born to be Wild, a Philippine television travelogue show broadcast under GMA Network which was hosted by Dr. Nielsen Donato roamed around the vicinity of Picnic Grove in Barangay Sungay East and gave immediate health assessments and treatments to the animals. Ten goats were given vitamin supplements while four others were dewormed. Out of

sixty-four horses which were used in horseback riding in Picnic Grove, 58 were provided vitamins and were dewormed while six were given dextrose through IV line (D5 LRS) and six have undergone eye flushing using the normal saline solution.

A farm in barangay Zambal, also in Tagaytay City was also visited as veterinarians checked the medical conditions of 22 horses. They

Secretary Eduardo M. Año has directed all LGUs to be on a state of preparedness and take all pro-active steps to stop the spread of this disease. All LGUs nationwide are advised to create their respective task forces to implement DOH protocols and guidelines and extend full cooperation to the DOH and other

government agencies to meet the world health emergency," said DILG Undersecretary and Spokesperson Jonathan Malaya in a statement.

He said that the Local Task Force under the direct leadership of the governor or the mayor shall ensure that local health authorities have the necessary equipment and protective gadgets such as masks, goggles, gowns, gloves, etc. The Task Force should also cause the referral and transport of a nCoV suspect to a DOH-designated coronavirus-referral center or hospital, in coordination with DOH and police authorities.

Malaya said that local chief executives must also train their respective health workers on nCoV prevention, containment, and control, in coordination with the DOH. He also urged LGUs to conduct city and municipality-wide coronavirus prevention, containment, and control information campaigns to educate the public.

"For LGUs hosting international airports like Manila, Cebu, Davao, Kalibo, Puerto Princesa, General Santos, Zamboanga, Laoag, and Iloilo, they must immediately coordinate with the Bureau

of Immigration and airport authorities for flights coming from nCoV-affected countries so that quarantine procedures may be effected to those suspected of possible infection," he added.

The DILG also urged LGUs to fully cooperate with the DOH as they conduct contact-tracing of all individuals that came into contact with the Chinese national that tested positive of nCoV yesterday. "The mayor should immediately inform the DOH should there be reasonable basis to place an individual under quarantine. The DOH needs the support of all LGUs in this important matter and local and police authorities should extend all possible assistance in this regard," he said.

LGUs should also post public advisories about the coronavirus as well as precautionary measures that the public can take such as maintaining proper hygiene and regular handwashing. "Local health authorities doing frontline work must exercise extreme vigilance in handling suspected individuals and strictly monitor those possibly infected," he said. (PIANC)

"So if the Chinese company has complied with all the requirements unlike others then necessarily the Chinese company will be the chosen one," Panelo added.

MacroAsia-CCCC consortium was among the seven groups that expressed their intent to bid by acquiring joint venture documents that were issued on Oct. 11, 2019.

The six other groups that dropped out of the race were Metro Pacific Investments Corp., Prime Asset Ventures, Philippine Airport Ground Solutions Inc., Langham Properties Inc., Mosveldt Law Offices, and Megawide Construction Corp.

Panelo said any "valid" complaints are welcome since it would pave the way for the possible conduct of an investigation into issues surrounding the Sangley Point International Airport project.

"We encourage people to complain so that we will know what the anomalies there are. If they have a valid complaint, why not and they should," he said.

The Sangley Point International Airport project, a 1,500-hectare master-planned international airport hub, is being undertaken by the Cavite government under the Public-Private Partnership Code.

The project will feature for runways, airside and landside facilities that can accommodate more than 100 million passengers annually.

DOLE urges OFWs to take precautionary measures against the novel coronavirus

QUEZON CITY, (PIA)-- In the midst of the global alert novel corona virus, the labor department urged all overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) to take the necessary precaution and to immediately report suspected cases of OFWs with symptoms to hospitals and to the Philippine Overseas Labor Offices (PO-LOs) for assistance.

Labor Secretary Silvestre Bello III, through Labor Advisory No. 03 Series of 2020, assured OFWs that the labor department, through the POLOs, is closely monitoring all cases linked to the viral pneumonia infections in Wuhan, Hubei Province in mainland China.

Citing the World Health Organization, reminded OFWs to prevent the spread of the disease by avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infections, wash hands frequently or use alcohol-basfled hand rub, and avoid close contact with farm or wild animals.

He also advised OFWs to avoid visiting crowded places and hospitals, wear a mask if necessary, practice cough etiquette, and consult a doctor immediately if they are developing symptoms, such as fever or respiratory problems.

Bello encouraged all OFWs to monitor advisories issued by their host governments, wash hands frequently and guidance. (DOLE/PIA)

BAGUIO CITY (PIA) -- The city government and the Baguio Flower Festival Foundation Inc. formally kicked off the 25th Panagbenga or the Baguio Flower Festival on Saturday morning (Feb.1) sans traditional opening parade which was postponed amid the threat of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (nCoV).

An ecumenical prayer was delivered asking for successful the conduct of the Panagbenga and its different activities in the city and the protection of the city of Baguio and the rest of the world from nCoV.

"We ask you Lord to deliver us from all evil, spare us from destructive calamities and from crimes and most especially, deliver and protect us from the threats from the deadly coronavirus," Catholic priest Fr. Rosito Pedro said in his prayer.

In his Islamic prayer, Uztadh Rohalas Muripaga called on Allah to make the Panagbenga better as an instrument of unity regardless of faith and diversity and protect the people from calamities and diseases and keep safe from the nCoV.

Councilor Vladimir Cayabas, in his ugayam, also prayed that the city and its residents will be safe from the virus as they appreciate the simple celebration of the Panagbenga.

guy bars him and he has to do it physically, alam ang physical contact can sometimes result in an ugly situation. Then it becomes a conflict now.”

The President said government security personnel may end up being charged with such situations. He also expressed concern on the prolonged exposure of the police and soldiers to ash spewed by the volcano that leaves them vulnerable to respiratory diseases.

“At saka ngayon by this time ‘yung nauna na doon, I’m sure that they inhaled about one sack of ash already. Sabihin ko na sa ano Army pati na — pa-withdraw na lang. Withdraw na lang ninyo ‘yung Army kasi kawawa. They are also human beings and they suffer,” he said.

With the withdrawal of the police and military personnel, President Duterte said he is leaving it to the local government of Batangas and the local police there to take charge of the situation to maintain order and impose restrictions on Taal’s danger zones.

As Taal Volcano exhibited a decreasing tendency of eruption, authorities lowered its alert status from Level 4 to Level 3, allowing thousands of evacuees displaced by the eruption to return to their homes.

Residents of all towns under lockdown were given the option to return to their respective residences and place of work. The towns of Agoncillo and Laurel, however, will remain under lockdown since some of the barangays of the two towns are within the seven-kilometer danger zone of the volcano. PND
