The items were found to be distributed locally by a group of Chinese nationals led by a certain Anna Ty and Willy Zhang.

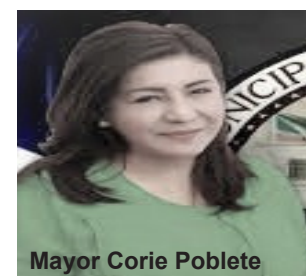
Members of the Philippine Coast Guard and the National Bureau of Investigation also joined the inspection team.

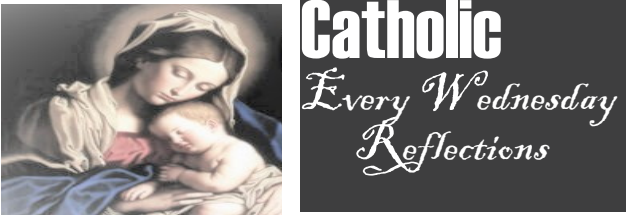

Loving through “Holy Hate”

Wednesday .November 3, 2021

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, “If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple.” Luke 14:25–26

After this startling opening line from our Lord, Jesus concludes today’s Gospel by saying, “In the same way, everyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple.” Thus, at first read it appears that we are called to deter only renounce all we possess but also to hate those within our own family. But is this truly what our Lord means? Let’s begin with the idea of “hating” those within our family and even our own life.

Obviously the word “hate” in this Gospel passage is not the same as the sin of hate and anger. In commenting on this passage, one Church Father explains that there are some cases when the best way to love another is through a form of hate. That is, if another were to act as an obstacle to God, working to deter us from the will of our Lord, then our “hatred” for the actions they do must be firmly expressed. But this is love. A refusal to turn from God, by rejecting another’s disordered actions, is a way of sharing the Gospel with them. Let’s take an extreme example.

Imagine that you lived at a time and circumstance where being a Christian was a crime. You were arrested and commanded to publicly renounce your faith. Instead, you renounced that command with every strength of your soul. In this case, you exercise a form of holy “hate” for the persecution the person is imposing upon you. But that is also an act of love toward them as you fully reject their action by renouncing their command.

Or consider also how you hate even your “own life.” Let’s say that you fall into serious sin, over and over. The appropriate response is not only to repent but also to have a form of holy hatred for the habit into which you have fallen. This is a true hatred for yourself in the sense that it is a hatred for that which you have become by your sin. But this holy hatred has the ultimate goal of passionately overcoming your sin and is therefore a true act of love for yourself.

DOT rolls out free swab tests for domestic tourists

MANILA – Qualified domestic tourists may get a free swab test at the Philippine Children’s Medical Center (PCMC) starting November 1, the Tourism Promotions Board (TPB) announced Saturday.

The TPB said it would roll out the fully subsidized reverse transcription-polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) tests at the PCMC as part of its extensive efforts to promote the country as a safe tourism destination and to help speed up the industry’s recovery.

“As travel restrictions

continue to ease up, we aim to encourage more tourists to visit their destination of choice by providing a full subsidy on RT-PCR testing. This program helps ensure the safety of tourists, tourism workers, and local stakeholders in various destinations,” Tourism Secretary Berna Romulo-Puyat said.

In a separate advisory, the TPB said travelers who have already submitted their application no longer need to send another one so long as their departure date falls on November 1 and

onwards.

The partnership with PCMC was first rolled out in December 2020, covering 50 percent of the hospital’s PHP1,500 swab test.

The TPB said the full subsidy could benefit 12,000 more qualified tourists until the end of 2021, with its daily cap of 350 approved applicants.

From January to June 2021 alone, more than 15,000 tourists were able to get the discounted PHP750 swab test at PCMC, much cheaper

than other laboratories that offer nasal swab tests.

Previously, the TPB also partnered with the University of the Philippines - Philippine General Hospital in subsidizing 50 percent of the hospital’s swab testing, which accounted for 17,320 tourists from Dec. 18, 2020 to July 7, 2021.

To avail of the free PCMC swab test, tourists with complete documents are advised to visit the TPB’s website for application procedures and requirements.

DOST boosts coffee industry in Calabarzon

MANILA – The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) in Calabarzon and the Cavite State University (CvSU) are collaborating to boost the coffee industry in the region.

In a taped report aired on Friday, DOST Secretary Fortunato de la Peña said the two are working to develop tissue culture growth chamber for coffee seedlings.

Together with the National Coffee Research, Development, and Extension Center, they developed a tissue

culture growth chamber to produce disease-free seedlings in even shorter periods of time.

“Through the growth chamber innovation, tissue-cultured embryos are subjected to a tightly controlled environment, thus decreasing the chance of plant contamination and mortality rate. With its promising appeal to the market, the technology is foreseen to open more opportunities for the government and private organizations to put up income-generating tissue culture laboratories,” he said.

He added that this technology facility will have a significant impact on the coffee and macapuno industry.

The DOST-Metals Industry Research and Development Center (MIRDC) fabricated and tested the mobile hub, he said.

CvSu has been a partner of DOST-Calabarzon in the premiere operation of the DOSTRUCK.

Meanwhile, the agency has also installed a new vacuum freeze drying facility for the Calabarzon Food Solutions Hub (CFOSH), which is also stationed in Magallanes, Cavite, de la Peña said. (PNA)

De la Peña also reported that DOST-Calabarzon and CvSU recently launched the DOSTRUCK or DOST Technology in the Region for the Upscaling of Community Knowledge.

DOSTRUCK is a food safety compliant and mobile food processing hub currently stationed in Magallanes, Cavite.

CAVITE PNP WEEKLONG ANTI-CRIME DRIVE OPS



Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City- Cavite Police Provincial Office spearheaded by PCOL MARLON R SANTOS, Provincial Director arrested 261 persons and recorded recorded 39,729 Quarantine violators on its intensified weeklong anti-crime drive operation conducted from October 25-31, 2021 with significant results.

In the campaign against illegal drugs, 162 persons were arrested in a buy bust operation conducted by police operatives and confiscated seven (7) pieces medium heat sealed, 395 pieces small heat sealed transparent plastic sachet containing white crystalline suspected as shabu, thirty-two (32) pieces small HSPTS and two (2) pieces ziplock plastic sachet containing dried leaves suspected as marijuana and other drug paraphernalia’s.

In the campaign against wanted persons, sixty-eight (68) individuals were arrested by virtue of warrant of arrest, twenty (20) of which are included in the list of Most Wanted Persons (Regional, Provincial, City & Municipal Level) while forty-eight (48) others were involve in various crimes.

In the campaign against illegal gambling, seventy-three (73) individuals were arrested and confiscated cash money amounting to Php 43,723.00 in different denomination as bet money and other gambling paraphernalia’s. Cavite Police also collared twenty-six (26) suspects for involvement in various crime incidents.

Out of 39,729 Quarantine violators recorded, 3,155 for not wearing face mask; 5,070 for improper wearing face mask; 15,278 for not wearing face shield; 6,491 for improper wearing face shield; 1,740 violated the curfew hours and 732 violated the social distancing. Cavite Police gave warning to 39,396 violators, 244 paid fines and 13 were arrested.

“These accomplishments particularly in the arrest of people involved in illegal drugs, illegal gambling, wanted persons and other crimes were the results of active involvement of all local chief executives and the community in our anti-criminality campaign in accomplishing our mission to enforce the law, prevent and control crimes, and maintain peace and order in the province of Cavite.” PCOL SANTOS added.(Cavite PIO)
