Secretary Dar is cited for his leadership and unwavering efforts to transform Philippine agriculture into a dynamic high-

"William Dar is a global leader in agriculture governance and research. As current secretary of agriculture, he is leading efforts to transform Philippine agriculture into a dynamic high-growth sector to speed up the country's recovery and poverty reduction," said Mills.

Amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the country's agriculture sector grew by 1.6 percent, during the second quarter of 2020, while other economic sectors posted negative growth.

Mills said the Asia CEO Awards 2020 board of judges also put premium in Dar's initiative in making the Department of Agriculture transparent and "erase the old-stricken image of a corrupt-driven department."

The board included: noted economist Dr. Bernie Villegas; former Pag-IBIG Fund CEO Darlene Berberabe; former president of the American Chamber of Commerce of the Philippines Don Felbaum; world-renowned architectural design and planning expert Jun Palafox; former Management Association of the Philippines president Marife Zamora: and Mills. former president of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce of

Dar was appointed by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte in August 2019. He served as acting agriculture secretary in 1998 during the Estrada administration.

He is the first Filipino to lead a global agricultural research institute, serving an unprecedented three five-year terms as director-general of the International Crops Research


