

DOT, PNP, PDEA to beef up security in tourist destinations

MANILA – As Philippine tourism moves towards its much-anticipated recovery, the Department of Tourism (DOT) has joined hands with the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) and the Philippine National Police (PNP) to beef up security in tourist destinations across the country.

Tourism Development Planning Undersecretary Woodrow Maquilung, Jr. represented Tourism Secretary Berna Romulo-Puyat, who was on official business, in a

ceremony at the PDEA head office, Quezon City last March 14.

Together with Undersecretary Maquilung were PDEA Director General Wilkins Villanueva and PNP chief, Gen. Dionardo B. Carlos, who co-signed the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the PDEA and PNP, respectively.

"We welcome this latest collaboration with our country's police force and drug enforcement agency in an aim to provide greater deterrence and protection

against the illicit trafficking of dangerous drugs in tourist destinations," Puyat said in her message.

Branded as Tourism Operation Protection Against Illegal Drugs or the TOP-AID, the latest partnership is a follow-through to the TOPCOP program, the tourism security force assisting in maintaining peace and order within areas of high tourism traffic. TOPCOP was established in 2011 and has trained 5,457 tourist

MANILA – President Rodrigo R. Duterte on Monday expressed confidence that the new evacuation centers currently providing temporary shelter for residents displaced by Taal Volcano's unrest would be of "great service" to all

affected Filipinos before another disaster should strike.

"Now that we are experiencing challenges brought by the recent eruptions of Taal Volcano, I am confident that the evacuation center in Mataasnakahoy would be of great service to our affected kababayans," Duterte said in a speech after inspecting the evacuation center located in the municipality of Mataasnakahoy in Batangas.

The Mataasnakahoy evacuation center is one of the three evacuation centers strategically located outside the danger zone of a Taal Volcano. The other two are in the municipalities

of Santa Teresita and Alitagtag.

Each evacuation hub can house 150 families or 600 individuals during calamities.

Duterte commended the people involved in the construction of the evacuation centers, noting that the facilities would not have been completed without their "passion" and dedication."

He said he takes pride in seeing how the government has opened a lot of establishments and inaugurated structures "that will certainly endure the test of time."

"We have likewise institutionalized

police and put up 365 Tourist Police Assistance Centers (TPAC) in strategic locations across the country.

Under the new TOP-AID MOA, the DOT, PDEA and PNP agreed to cooperate and render assistance to ensure further protection, safety, and security of tourists in DOT-identified tourist destinations.

On the part of PDEA, it agreed to deploy

appropriate manpower to TOP-AID centers in DOT-identified tourist destinations. These tourist assistance and complaint desks will focus on drug-related concerns.

PDEA will also lead an information drive on the drug-free workplace while assisting in drug clearing operations including apprehending any person engaged in illegal drug activities in

coordination with the PNP and concerned local government units.

Meanwhile, other than identifying key tourist destinations with high-tourism traffic where TOP-AID centers may be put up, the DOT will also spearhead the training of these personnel on Tourism Awareness and the signature Filipino brand of service and hospitality that is world-renowned. (PR)

long-term solutions for our kababayan even without finding a need to politicize our mandate as public servants," he said.

He also expressed hope that the government would be able to maintain the momentum towards building a "better and more resilient" nation for everyone.

"Now that I'm already at the tail-end of my term as president, we see how our shared values and vision towards progress and prosperity bear fruition. With our strength and solidarity we can overcome all the forms of trials and problems that test our character," he added.

For Duterte, it is during trying times that "the bayanihan spirit burns even brighter in the hearts of Filipinos."

The evacuation centers in Mataasnakahoy, Santa Teresita, and Alitagtag have key amenities and facilities.

Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) Secretary Eduardo del Rosario led the inauguration and turnover of Batangas' three evacuation centers to their respective local government units (LGUs) on March 21.

The construction of the evacuation center was completed just under a year after the DHSUD finalized a memorandum of agreement for a grant to build the facilities in the three Batangas towns im-

pacted by the Taal Volcano eruption in 2020, but situated outside the danger zone.

"The technical specification of these evacuation centers was based on the design of the National Housing Authority (NHA) and was duly approved by the President himself when I had presented it in the Cabinet way back 2018," del Rosario said in a media interview.

Each site has a floor area of 1,451 square meters complete with amenities like an administrative office and reception area, storage room, kitchen and mess hall, play area, health and consultation clinic, prayer room, conference room, breastfeeding area, basketball court, separate female and male comfort rooms, and rooms for couples.

It also has 40 toilets, 22 shower rooms, and nine urinal facilities that are proportionally divided and segregated for men and women.

Around 106 modular tents can also fit each open area.

The three evacuation centers are strategically located on safe grounds beyond the 14-kilometer danger zones -- Barangay Calayaan, Sta. Teresita; Barangay San Juan, Alitagtag; and Barangay Dos, Mataasnakahoy.

"It was funded through the socialized balance housing compliance

program funds in order to address the needed gaps for housing settlements and community development," del Rosario added.

He said the construction projects were part of the government's response to the Taal Volcano eruption in January 2020.

The DSHUD, he said, is already implementing the land development for resettlement sites in five municipalities intended to accommodate families severely affected by previous eruption.

The NHA earlier awarded 585 housing units to displaced families.

After visiting the Mataasnakahoy evacuation center, Duterte also led the distribution of assistance to families displaced by the Taal Volcano eruption who are currently staying at the Agoncillo Central School in Batangas.

On Monday, the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology announced that it does not see Taal Volcano erupting like in 2020 although it continues to show signs of activity.

As of March 31, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council reported that about 2,047 families or 7,237 individuals in 18 Batangas villages are affected by the ongoing unrest.

Mayor Isko Says RP Needs A ‘Crisis Manager’ For President

AKSYON DEMOKRATIKO standard-bearer Isko Moreno Domagoso said the country needs a crisis manager for president, a leader who is always at the forefront whether it is the war against Covid-19 or the people’s daily struggle against joblessness and the rising prices of food and fuel.

“So, we are in a crisis and what we need kung ako ay boboto, hindi bilang kandidato, kung ako si Francisco Domagoso na isang botante at pipili ako ng presidente, ang pipiliin ko ay isang crisis manager. A crisis manager is always there, hindi uma-absent, hindi natatakot, hinaharap ang problema, nasa frontline,” Moreno told TV and radio anchor Alvin Elchico.

“I get things done kaya nga Bilis Kilos. I get things done. Parang ina-almoranas ako sa kapagka ang isang bagay e para bang ikinikibit-balikat na lang ng mga baha-bahagi ng gobyerno because especially in a crisis, we are in a crisis. (But) I don’t know with our viewers on how they perceive, di ko alam sa ating mga manonood kung among tingin nila sa sitwasyon natin. Maaring mali ako o baka ako lang ang nakakakita nito,” Moreno said.

Moreno was answering Elchico’s question “What differentiates him from the other nine candidates vying for the top position in the land” for the “Harapan 2022” presidential interviews which was aired Monday night over ABS-CBN Channel 2.

“We are in a crisis, nasa krisis po tayo. Pandemya, pagtaas ng presyo ng mga pangunahing bilihin, hindi sapat ang sweldo para ipambili ng may mapagharimunan sa pamilya. May kaguluhan sa mundo na maaaring makaapekto rin sa atin at baka may kaguluhan malapit lang, lagpas mo lang na kaunti ng Batanes, in the future,” Moreno pointed out.

Moreno said just like the Ukrainian president who has shown courage and bravery in leading his men in defending their country against the assault of Russian forces, the Philippines should vote for a leader who will act as a crisis manager and immediately get things done just like him.

When the Covid-19 pandemic hit the country in March 2020, Moreno as city mayor was at the forefront of ensuring Manila’s survival by procuring anti-viral drugs such as Tocilizumab, Baricitinib, Remdesivir and the oral drug Molnupiravir.

Moreno later ordered the construction of the Manila Covid-19 Field Hospital in record 52 days, the building of the modern Bagong Ospital ng Maynila and the continuous delivery of food boxes for 700,000 families in the city under the local government unit’s Food Security Program (FSP).

Moreno told ABS CBN’s Elchico that if elected president, he would emulate the courage and bravery of Ukraine president Volodymyr Zelensky in his war against poverty, hunger, and equality in the country.

“You know the guy is worth emulating. I don’t know the nitty-gritty of the real situation but what matters most to us is that there is a president, the most powerful person in that country on the frontline while bullets are flying. And because of technological warfare that is available in the world, missiles pwedeng bumagsak anytime pero hindi nya inilantala yun. Ipinaramdam nya sa kanyang mga kababayan hindi

sya a-absent, hindi sya iiwas, hindi sya matatakot, haharapin nya ang mga katanungan, at haharapin nya kasama ang taong bayan sa kanilang suliranin,” Moreno explained.

“And this is the type of leader I want to be. And this is the kind of leadership na sana kayanin ko kasi yun ang gusto ko dahil buong buhay ko, pagdilal ko pa lang ng aking mata puro krisis na ang kinaharap ko. Salamat sa Diyos, salamat sa mga kakilala, kaibigan, sa nanay at tatay ko, nalagpasan ko ang lahat ng krisis na yun. Kaya kung kaya kong harapin, i-manage ang krisis na kinakaharap ng bawat Pilipino I think the pandemic crisis management of the City of Manila kayo na po ang humusga,” Moreno said.

The local chief executive said Manila’s Covid-19 response may not be perfect, but the most important thing is that the city government was able to get things done and manage the crisis well.

So, nagawa namin, naitawid natin ang tao. Hindi siya perpekto because there is no playbook in this kind of situation of pandemic. But modesty aside nairaos natin ang tao sa gutom, sa kapahamakan, at nakapaghanda. Yun naman ang kaya kung isukli sa tao. Now If that is what they need, I’m available, that I can do,” Moreno said.

“Other than that, if you feel ang kailangan natin pagkakaisa, at ang pagkakaisa eh maisasaing natin ay yun po ang piliin ninyo,” he said.

The Aksyon Demokratiko presidential bet warned the people about voting for someone who has no solutions for the woes affecting our country and is only there for his and his family’s personal gains.

“I think it is my moral obligation na ipaalam sa iyo na mamulat ka lang. At the end of the day ikaw rin naman ang magde-desisyon pero kasi its mixed communication na e. So, nalilito na ang tao. So, kaya ako ang parang obligasyon ko, eto ang tingin ko sa sitwasyon natin at ito ang tingin kong kailangan natin. Hindi yung lip service or high sounding words because these words cannot solve ang hapdi ng sikmura mo, kapag hinihingi ka na dahil kailangan mo ng Remdesivir, Tocilizumab, Baracitinib, Molnupiravir, at Bexovid,” Moreno said./source: Tayo si Isko FB

In the said event, Director Escolano emphasized the roles and responsibilities of all the parties in the Memorandum of Agreement which covers the implementation, operation, and maintenance of the DPWH Evacuation Center Project located in Brgy. Lantic Carmona, Cavite. The evacuation center, which was converted into a Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility with 151 isolation rooms, is being utilized to accommodate COVID-19 patients in the region.

Likewise, Atty. Roy M. Loyola, the Municipal Mayor of Carmona conveyed his deep appreciation and acceptance of the National Government’s provision of the disaster-resilient facility.

Furthermore, Mr. Rommel DL Peneyra, Municipal DRRM Officer, toured Director Escolano and her party to Carmona’s Haven of Peace located in Mayor’s Boulevard, Brgy. Maduya, Carmona, Cavite. The facility composed of a Viewing Chapel, Crematorium, and Columbarium and is fully operational since February 2022 and renders free services to the constituents of Carmona. Moreover, they also visited the ongoing construction of Carmona’s state-of-the-art Command Center which will house the DRRM Office and the Bureau of Fire Protection. They also visited the completed 3-storey Multi-Purpose Building which serves as office of the Traffic Management Office and storage/warehouse for prepositioned items of the DSWD Regional Office. COVID-19 Home isolation kits were shown to Dir Escolano as proof of the LGU’s commitment to take care of its constituents during the pandemic situation.

The evacuation center could accommodate an estimated 800 individuals.

The first two years of an “Isko Moreno presidency” will focus on building facilities that will provide the minimum basic needs of the people – stable jobs and livelihood, decent housing, fully-equipped hospitals, modern school buildings – especially in far-flung provinces with low human development index (HDI).

To further hasten human and economic growth, Moreno also vowed to strengthen physical, economic and digital linkages among growth centers and the rural economies, by building bridges across major islands of the Philippine archipelago, and build a national fiber optic backbone to boost the country’s communication capability and interconnectivity, among others.

Moreno said such infrastructure investments will create millions of jobs and other livelihood opportunities for our people, and lead to the formation of more micro, small and medium industries (MSMEs), thus further creating more job opportunities. #

DOH CALABARZON AUGMENTS MEDICALSUPPLIES FOR TAAL EVACUEES AND RESPONDERS



The Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) yesterday augmented its resources in response to the recent phreatomagmatic activities of Taal volcano in the Province of Batangas.

Regional Director Ariel I. Valencia visited several evacuation centers (ECs) in the province, particularly in Laurel and Agoncillo, to personally check the situation of the evacuees and respond to their needs.

“Napakahalaga na nakikita natin ang sitwasyon ng mga evacu-

ees para malaman natin ano ano pa ang mga kailangan nila at matugunan agad ito,” Director Valencia said.

The regional office provides losartan, amlodipine, antihistamine, paracetamol, oral rehydration and vitamins, medical supplies, including surgical face masks, alcohol, and ‘buntis kits’ to municipal health centers in most affected areas of the Taal volcano eruption.

During the regional director’s visit to the evacuation centers in Laurel and Agoncillo, he reminded evacuees of the strict adherence to the minimum public health standards to prevent and control COVID-19.

“Patuloy po natin pinaalalahanan ang mga residente higit sa lahat ang mga evacuees na tayo ay nasa pandemya pa rin at kailangan nating sumunod sa mga health protocols gaya ng social distancing, pagsuot ng face mask at paghuhugas ng kamay.”

“Patuloy ang mga aktibidad ng bulkan kaya mag-ingat po ang lahat, manatiling nakaantabay sa mga anunsyo at sumunod sa mga utos ng ating lokal na pamahalaan para sa ating kaligtasan at ka-

ligtasang ng mga mahal natin sa buhay” Valencia emphasized.

As of March 28, 2022, there are 17 active evacuation centers in the towns of Laurel and Agoncillo sheltering 3, 905 individuals, while 516 individuals are staying outside Evacuation centers.

“Naka-mobilize at patuloy ang paghahatid ng preventive health measures ng Batangas DOH-Provincial Health Team Office upang makaiwas sa mapaminsalang pagkawala ng buhay at ari-arian dulot ng pag-
