Las Piñas opens 5 additional vaccination sites

Five additional vaccination sites will be opened in Las Piñas City to achieve the local government's goal of inoculating at least 6,000 persons per day against COVID-19.

The Las Piñas City Government's timeline, according to Vice-Mayor April Aguilar-Nery, is to execute its plan of establishing five more vaccination sites within the next two weeks.

It is part of the city government's "Ligtas na Las Piñeros, Lahat Bakunado" vaccination program, Nery said.

To date, a total of 40,000 frontline health workers, senior citizens, and adults with comorbidities have received their first dose of vaccines and 15 for the second dose.

Nery said the city currently has a total of 15 vaccination sites from 10 barangay covered courts,

two hospitals — the University of Perpetual Help Medical Center and the Las Piñas Doctors Hospital, and three additional sites at the SM Southmall, SM Center, and Robinsons Mall.

The vice-mayor said the city government is planning to add five more vaccination sites since Mayor Imelda Aguilar wants all city residents to be vaccinated against COVID-19.

The city also aims to inoculate 300 residents per vaccination site per day for a total of 6,000 persons per day.

Nery said the city government purchased 300 AstraZeneca and 200 Novavax vaccines to achieve the mayor's goal of inoculating all city residents.

The vice-mayor said the city recorded 309 active cases and 11,690 recoveries, so far. (PIA NCR)

1.6M new jobs to be created if economic restrictions in Charter are lifted

About 1.6 million new jobs for the country would be created and household income would be substantially increased by relaxing the economic restrictions in the 1987 Constitution.

Leandro Tan of the University of the Philippines Public Administration Research and Extension Services Foundation-Regulatory Reform Support Program for National Development (UPPAF-RESPOND) said that economic reforms could reduce the 7.1 percent unemployment rate reported in March 2021 to only 3.8%.

"The unemployment situation in the country has escalated since April 2020 while a negative net of -1.3 million remains," Tan said during the second session of the webinar series on the impact of opening the economy on jobs and labor sponsored by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG). Removing foreign equity restrictions, he said, would also yield a potential foreign direct investment (FDI) of \$16.2 billion. Tan said that infusing more FDIs into the economy would remove manufacturing, electricity, gas, water, real estate, and business services job deficits.

"Other sectors such as transportation, public administration and defense, education, and other services will be reduced by 390,000 or 33%. Even family or household incomes would rise by P197 billion or Php 8,000 per family with relaxed FDI," he added.

Tan said the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth rates showed that the Philippines was lagging behind other neighboring countries like Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, and Vietnam.

"The imposed economic lockdown brought by COVID-19 has derailed the country from the sustained GDP growth path, from 6.1 in 2019, -9.6 in 2020 down to -4.2 in the first quarter of 2021," Tan stressed.

DILG Undersecretary and Spokesman Jonathan Malaya said that the potential investment and labor impacts of economic reforms would speed up economic recovery.

"This will have a significant impact on the long-term phase of our recovery solutions to beef up investments, employment, incomes, labor workforce, and other sectors greatly affected by this health crisis," Malaya said.

Green Heat and SM City Bacoor launched the 1.3-MW roof-mounted solar power plan

More biz sourcing power from solar

Commercial establishments sourcing their electricity requirement from renewable energy like solar power is increasing in the country.

Solar power provider Green Heat Corp. general manager Robert Martin said in a press briefing Friday the company has six to 12 megawatts of solar rooftop projects this year despite the pandemic.

"It will depend on the situation especially the limitation on travel, the limitation of working on various entities which require swab test (and) vaccination that limits us actually. But they are already in the pipeline and we are on that contemplative situation," Martin said.

Green Heat di-

rector Glenn Tong added that most of the company's clients are those with high power consumption during the daytime like malls, offices, manufacturing plants, and even residential buildings.

Last Friday May 28, Green Heat and SM City Bacoor launched the 1.3-MW roof-mounted solar power plant, utilizing the 6,230 square meters rooftop of SM City Bacoor.

This made the first SM mall in Cavite to have a solar power rooftop.

Green Heat has installed a total of 3,114 solar panels at SM City Bacoor.

Martin said the installed solar rooftop can generate up to 40 percent of SM City Baco-

or's power demand.

The mall has a daily power requirement of 1.6 MW.

"As of May 27, the power plant produced about 6,500 kilowatt-hour (kWh) of clean energy and providing 700 kWh for the mall," Martin said.

On average, SM City Bacoor is expected to save PHP10.3 million by sourcing its power demand from its own solar power plant, Martin said.

He added that the facility will also reduce over 8,000 metric tons of carbon dioxide emissions.

Energy Utilization Management Bureau Director Patrick Aquino told the Philippine News Agency that the Department of Energy (DOE) engages with the stake-
